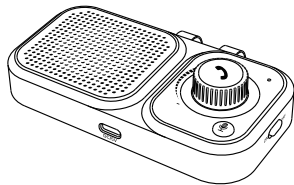


Wireless In-Car Speakerphone

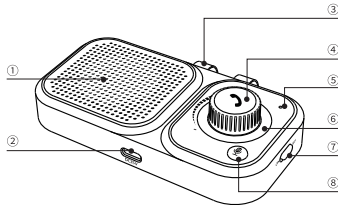

Product Description

BT17 is a Wireless handsfree kit that supports handsfree profile phones. It is designed for easy handsfree operation with superior performance.

Product Overview



- ① Speaker
- ② USB-C Charging Port
- ③ Integrated Visor Clip
- ④ Multi-function button

- ⑤ Microphone
- ⑥ Indicator Lights

Charging

1. Connect the charger's plug to the Charger Port (2) of the product. Connect the charger to an external power source.

Charge Indicator (6) Status:

Steady Red: Charging Flashing yellow: Low Battery

Lights out: Battery Full

2. When fully charged, disconnect the charger.

Get it ready for Pairing

1. Turn on your speakerphone

Press the On/Off switch, BT17 will be power on with light flashing in yellow as a voice of "ready to pair"




2. Pairing to your Wireless Mobile Phone

Activate Wireless from your mobile phone, search Wireless device with the name of "BT17" and connect, as a voice of "Wireless connected", after successful pairing the yellow light stops flashing

3. Pairing to your second phone

The speakerphone has advanced Multiuse, which allows to match two mobile phone at the same time. After the first mobile phone pairing successfully, please turn off the connected mobile phone's Wireless function, and then repeat step "2" to connect the second mobile phone. With successful connection, turn on the first mobile Wireless function and click BT17 to reconnect to get the simultaneously connection to 2 mobiles phones

Basic Operations

Button	Function	Operation
	Power on/Power off	toggle down/up
	VOL +/VOL -	Rotate
	Play/Pause	Short press once
	Take a call	Short press once
	End a call	Press once
	Reject a call	Press and hold for 2s
	Recall last incoming/outgoing call	Quickly press twice
	Wake-up siri	Press and hold for 3s
	Exit Siri	Press once

Advanced Functions

AUTO Power OFF & Automatic Reconnection

After this speakerphone disconnects with the phone for 3 minutes, it will turn off automatically. When the speaker is powered on again, it will automatically reconnect to your phone when you get back in your car.

Switch talking between Wireless Speakerphone and Cell Phone

When during talking using this Wireless Speakerphone and if you want to transfer the talking to cell phone, please long press the Multi-function button for 3 seconds to switch.

- 6.To get a HD sound quality, when using this speakerphone for calls, please keep it away from phone or microwave, Phone signal and microwave will interfere Bluetooth signal.

- 8.Never use the device where electronic or wireless communication is prohibited.
