HOW TO CHARGE

For the first time use, please fully charge the product. Charging: The signal light is on and the power button is lit.

Full-power: The signal light is off.

Charging time: 2 hours

INSTRUCTION

HEADPHONE STATUS

LED Indicator

Power-on status: the indicator light is always on for 3 seconds.

Pairing status: the indicator light flashes alternately in white and green.

Connect the device: the indicator light is on.

Low-power status: the white light flashes 5 times every 1 minute.

POWER ON/OFF

Power on: Long press the power button 2 seconds and hear the prompt that it is turned on.

Power off: Long press the power button 3 seconds and hear the prompt that it is turned off.

WARNINGS

When charging the headset to avoid damage to the battery, it is recommended that you use a 5V/2A charging head to charge. The power of the charging head should not exceed 24W.

Avoid using car charger/light charging power bank or 3-prong headset with unground power cord. This transmitter must not be co-located or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter.

The power consumption is too fast and the signal is poor.

HOW TO CONNECT

1. Long press the power button 2S and hear the prompt that it is turned on;
2. Open the Bluetooth interface of the mobile phone, search for "iKF-Rona", click to connect;
3. After the first pairing and connection is successful, the headset will automatically connect to the last mobile phone when the power is turned on. If the headset is turned on, and there is no need to repeat pairing.

BUTTON CONTROLS

Listen to music with headset

Play/Pause: Single tap the power button;

Volume down: Single tap the "+" button;

Volume up: Single tap the "-" button;

Next Track: Long press the "+" button 2 seconds;

Previous Track: Long press the "-" button 2 seconds ;

Voice assistant: Double-tap the power button.

*When the volume is adjusted to the maximum, a beep will appear.

Noise reduction mode

Tap the mode button cycle through "ANC Mode/Transparent Mode/AirWind Noise Mode"

Adaptive noise reduction

Turn on/off: Double-tap the mode button;

Mode Switching

Long press the mode button, jump switch movie mode-game mode-music mode;

2 prompt tones—enter the movie mode.

3 prompt tones—enter the game mode.

1 prompt tone—enter the music mode;

WIRELESS CONNECTION

The audio cable port is inserted into the headphones, the cable is connected to the device you want to connect, the Bluetooth function is automatically turned off.

TIPS

1. Make sure the headset and the connected device are within the correct connection range and there are not too many obstacles that interfere with the signal;
2. It is normal for the headset to be disconnected occasionally, just like WiFi, occasionally the connection is unstable. It may be due to interference in signal transmission. Please wait a moment or change the location to resolve;
3. When the headset cannot be connected to the device, please check whether the headset has power or is connected to other devices;
4. Please fully charge the Headphone once a month; if the Headphone is not used for a long time, the battery of the Headphones may be damaged;
5. The sound insulation and sound leakage of headphones are related to the way of wearing the headphones and the volume of the headphones;
6. You can adjust the wearing angle and degree of ear wrapping of the headphones in time according to the actual comfort of use. Please close the earband foam part of the headphones as much as possible;
7. Please use a standard-compliant charging head to charge the headset;
8. Do not wear the product for bathing, or use it in the rain, and do not soak the product in water. After each normal use, it is recommended to dry the sweat or stains on the headphone with a dry cloth, paper towel, etc., and then store it.
