

Setting Up Your iPhone

Compatibility
This device is compatible with iPhone 8 series or later phones running iOS 14.5 or later with Two-Factor Authentication turned on.

1. Turn on Two-Factor Authentication for your Apple ID

On your iPhone, Go to **Settings > your name > Password & Security > Turn On Two-Factor Authentication**. Then follow the onscreen instructions.

2. Connect to a stable Wi-Fi or cellular network

Open the **Find My** app and sign in using your Apple ID. Answer your security questions. Then follow the onscreen instructions to accept the prompt to update account security. Then tap **Update Account Security** and follow the onscreen instructions.

3. Turn on Find My

A. Go to **Settings**
B. Go to **Find My** and turn on **Find My iPhone**
C. Tap **Find My iPhone** and turn on **Find My iPhone**

3. Turn on Bluetooth

4. Connect to a stable Wi-Fi or cellular network

5. Turn on Location Services

Go to **Settings > Privacy & Security > Location Services > Turn on Location Services**

Getting Started

Power on
Press the key's power button twice, and a beep will sound to indicate that it is turned on.

Power off
To turn off the power, press the power button **2 times** and then **long press** the power button **2 times** after hearing two beeps. The "key" is turned off if the key has not been paired within 10 minutes, a beep will be heard and the key will turn off.

Turn on the power to continue pairing

Factory reset
Press the power button **3 times** in a row **4 short presses** and **1 long press**; after hearing a beep, the "key" returns to factory setting

Pairing Your Key

I. Ensure your iPhone is set up (see "Setting Up Your iPhone" above) and your key is powered on.

2. Open the Find My app

3. In the **Items** tab, tap **Add New Item**

4. Tap **Find My iPhone** and search for your key.

5. Once your key is detected, tap **Connect**

6. Follow the onscreen steps to name it and register it to your Apple ID.

7. If your key appears in **Items**, first forget the device, perform a factory reset on the key (see "Getting Started > Factory reset" above), then repeat steps 1-6.

* Do not leave Find My app while pairing key.

Locating Your Key

Locate your key via the **map** tab.

1. Open the Find My app

2. Tap the **Items** tab

3. Select your key in the **Items** list

4. Tap the **map** icon to view the location of your key and get directions in the Maps app.

Play sound alert

1. Open the Find My app

2. Tap the **Items** tab

3. Select your key in the **Items** list and tap **Play Sound**

* The sound alert will only play if your iPhone is within the Bluetooth range of your iPhone (approx. 100ft).

Set up Notify When Left Behind

If your key is not in the Bluetooth range of your iPhone, Find My app will let you know when your key has been lost (if you set up a name, the name will be displayed; otherwise it will show key).

1. Open the Find My app

2. Tap the **Items** tab

3. Select your key in the **Items** list and scroll down

4. Under **Notifications**, tap **Notify When Left Behind**

Changing the Name of Your Key

1. Open the Find My app and tap the **Items** tab.

2. Tap the **Items** tab

3. Scroll down and tap **Rename Item**

4. Select a name in the list or select **Custom Name**

5. Enter a custom name, tap a name and select an emoji.

6. Tap **Done**

Charging Your Key

Removing the key from your Apple ID will allow it to be activated and used by another person.

1. Ensure that your key is connected to your iPhone.

2. Open the Find My app

3. In the **Items** tab, tap the key

4. Tap **Remove** and confirm to remove.

* If not connected when removing your key from your Apple ID, it will no longer be discoverable and you will need to perform a factory reset before making a new connection (see "Getting Started > Factory reset" above).

Unwanted Tracking Notification

If your key is separated from your iPhone and is detected moving with another person with an Apple device over time, that person will receive a tracking alert message.

Safety Warnings

1. Do not expose the device to temperatures below -10°C (14°F) or above 50°C (122°F).

2. Do not expose the device to an open flame, submerge it in water, or expose it to rain as this will damage the device.

3. Always check for damage to the device, cables, or other accessories before using the device. If damaged, do not use the device.

1. How long will the battery last when fully charged?

iPhone 8 series or later will display the remaining battery level of the device.

3. How long does it take to fully charge the battery?
iPhone 8 series: 1.5 hours.
