Thanks for choosing our product.


This product is a smart wireless microphone that provides professional-grade recording output. Plug and play, no app required. Multiple uses: It can be used in online live broadcast video Vlog shooting, program interview, recording, video teaching and other occasions.

The wireless Microphone consists of two parts, one is Microphone Transmitter, the other one is receiver. (See as below picture)

\*Some mobile phone apps do not support external microphones, which will cause silent recording. In this case, please replace the app and continue to use the product.




(Microphone transmitter)

⑦ Receiver indicator ⑧ The port of receiver


\*The microphone is equipped with a built-in battery, which can be used only after being charged. The power of the receiver is supplied by phone (⑧) The port is for phone charging.

### How to use

Step 1: Connect the receiver to the phone interface.

Step 2: Press switch key of microphone, the indicator light turns green, and then power is turned on.

Step 3: After successful automatic pairing, the green light at the receiving end is always on and the green light at the transmitting end is always on. Then open the phone camera, live App or other Apps, and then to use the microphone to receive sound.



\*Connect receiver to phone  
\*Press microphone switch key  
\*Use microphone  
Note: oppo / vivo / iqoo / realm brand mobile phones can be used normally only when they go to the settings (search "OTG" - turn on OTG power supply)

#### Microphone Transmitter

Function	Button	LED
Power on	Button 3S startup	blinking alternately red and green
Power off	Press 3S shutdown	All the lights went out
Unconnected		blinking alternately red and green
Connected		Green light always on
Switch the noise reduction level	Press the key to switch cycle up to 3 levels, cycle in turn.	Level1: the green light blinks once Level2: the green light blinks 3 times Level3: the green light blinks 3 times in the noise reduction level before the last switch off
Reverberation	Press the button three times to turn on or off the reverb function	The green and red lights blinks once then the green light is always on
Silent mode	Press the twice to turn on or off the mute function	The green light blinks
Charging		Red light is always on
Fully charged		All the lights went out
Low battery		The light blinks every 10s

Power on	Automatically power on after plugging in the mobile phone port	The light blinks
