(1) Product operation instructions
1. Charging
1) When charging the earphones in the charging compartment, the charging compartment lights up blue and the fully charged light turns off. (Do not put it in the charging compartment when it is wet or there is a lot of dust.)
2) Connect the charging compartment to the power supply with a charging cable,

and both the headphones and the charging compartment will be charged simultaneously.
3) When charging the charging compartment, the blue light flashes, and when the charging compartment is fully charged, the blue light remains on.
2. Switching on/off
1) Power on: Remove the headphones from the charging compartment and automatically turn them on or press and
