

Attention

Please read this manual carefully before use and keep it for future reference.


- 1.The projector is non dustproof or waterproof.




BT Air Remote




Bluetooth remote controller pairing

Setting - Projector setting, enter to setup projection mode, Installation mode, Digital scaling, Manual trapezoid.

Projection Setting

Setting - BT setting, BT "ON", click Refresh device and choose objective device to pair.

BT Setting

Setting - BT setting, BT "ON", click Refresh device and choose objective device to pair.

Language Setting

Setting - Language Setting, enter to setup language and select input method.

Date And Time Setting

Setting - Date And Time Setting, enter to Date, Time and Use 24-hour format.

Screen saver

Setting - Other Setting - Screen saver, Screen saver time setting (The projection will enter screensaver mode at the set time without any operation or playback), screensaver mode can be released by pressing the power button.

Other Setting

Setting - Other Setting, enter to get Screen saver, Timed shutdown and Restore factory settings.

System information

Setting - System information, enter to UI version, Resolution, Running memory and Storage space.

HDMI™ Signal

After connecting projector to other output device, enter HDMI or Audio/Video.

Wireless Screen

Ensure that Android devices(phone,pad,etc)are in the same local wireless LAN with these devices

Operations on Devices:
Home Screen→My Apps→ScreenCast→Open ScreenCast service
→Turn on the phone mirroring→Connection.
