


(Power on prompt tone :"Pairing")</p> <p>Method 2: With a single earphone outside the charging box, long press the "control button" for 3 seconds to turn it on. (Power on prompt tone :"du")</p> <p>Power off</p> <p>Method 1: Put the headset into the charging box, automatically shutdown and charge.</p> <p>Method 2: if there is no connection with the device, it will automatically shutdown after 3 minutes. (Shutdown tone : power off")</p> <p>Method 3: When the earphone is not connected, long press the touch button of either earphone for 5 seconds, and the left and right earphones will be turned off at the same time. (Shutdown tone : power off")</p>	<p>First Pairing</p> <p>Step 1: Please turn on the bluetooth function on your cellphone/laptop.</p> <p>Step 2: Open the charging case, take the headphones out, the red and white lights flash on headphones.</p> <p>Step 3: Select "HJ-09" on your phone/laptop and connect the device, the red and white lights off when you connect successfully. (The headphones will automatically turn off if not connected the device within 3 minutes.)</p> <p>Reset Headphones</p> <p>If only one headphone connects to phone or the headphones can not pair together, Please try the reset steps:</p> <p>Step 1: Take the headphones out from charging case.</p> <p>Step 2: Press the control button 5 times.</p>
