


# R16 -kid

## User Manual



**1. Thanks for choosing Paitanry kid tablet, hope it can bring you convenience and happiness.**

**2. Power on your device: Long press the power key around 3-5 seconds, then following on screen instruction guides you through basic setting options:**




**2.1 Tap to choose the system language from the list and tap START.**

**2.2 Set up an available Wi-Fi network then tap Next, or tap Skip.**

**2.3 Set Date & time then tap Next.**

**2.4 Read Google Services and tap Accept to continue steps.**

**2.5 Tap FINISH to complete setup steps and you will enter the Iwawa APP directly.**



3. There are tow modes in Iwawa:

3.1 Parenting mode:

3.1.1 All applications could be downloaded in Google Play Store. The device system is Android 13.0, please download the compatible APPs.

3.1.2 The device default ROM is 64GB, when storage is insufficient , there are 2 options:

1. add expanded memory card.
2. format the tablet. Please kindly note that formatting will delete all applications' data.

3.1.3 Connect your device with other Bluetooth devices:

1.Go to Settings > Connected devices > Connection preferences > Bluetooth.

2.Tap to turn on Bluetooth.



3.Tap Pair new device or devices display in available list automatically.

4.Select a device from the list.

3.1.4 Quick settings: dragging the status bar downward on from any screen, you can modify the screen brightness, WiFi, Bluetooth.

3.1.5 Power saving mode: conserve energy and extend battery's working time.

3.1.6 Eye protection mode: Protect & care your eyes, reduce the blue light. Make your eyes feel more comfortable.

3.1.7 When battery percentage is less than 10%, please charge your device as soon as possible to avoid shutting down.

### 3.2 Iwawa Setting:

After logging into Iwawa, please set your own password (default password is 0000) to manage the APP.

The password is the only way to exit the kid mode.



## Security Control

Separating contents which are not suitable for children and protecting kids' physical and psychological growth, parents can filter the contents which need to be blocked.

### 1. Applications Filter

Select appropriate applications for kids, and block inappropriate contents like bloody and violent content. Only selected applications will be showed up in children's desktop.



### 2. Websites Filtering

When children use the Internet browser, it will automatically block the websites without parental permission.




## Content and Management

Provide children with rich applications resources, and use tools to manage applications, video, music and other content.


### 1. Applications Recommendation


## Behavior Restrictions

### 1. Child Lock

Without permission of parents, children will not be able to exit the child desktop.

### 2. Time Limit



A tablet can set up more than one account. Each child can have their own separate desktop.




