

Remote control function

Turn on the lights.

Turn off the lamp.

Brightness+: long press or short press the button to obtain higher brightness.

Brightness -: long press or short press the button to obtain lower brightness.

Color temperature + : long press or short press the button to obtain a higher color temperature.

Color temperature - : long press or short press the button to obtain a lower color temperature.

6500K white light is the brightest.

Short press the night light mode.

Press and hold for 3 seconds, the night switch LED turns on and off.

Timing: The light flashes 1 time and turns off after 15 minutes.

The light flashes twice and turns off after 30 minutes.

The light flashes 3 times, cancel the delay to turn off the light.

A Lamp head 4000K brightest.

B Lamp head 4000K brightest.

A and B Lamp head 4000K brightest.
