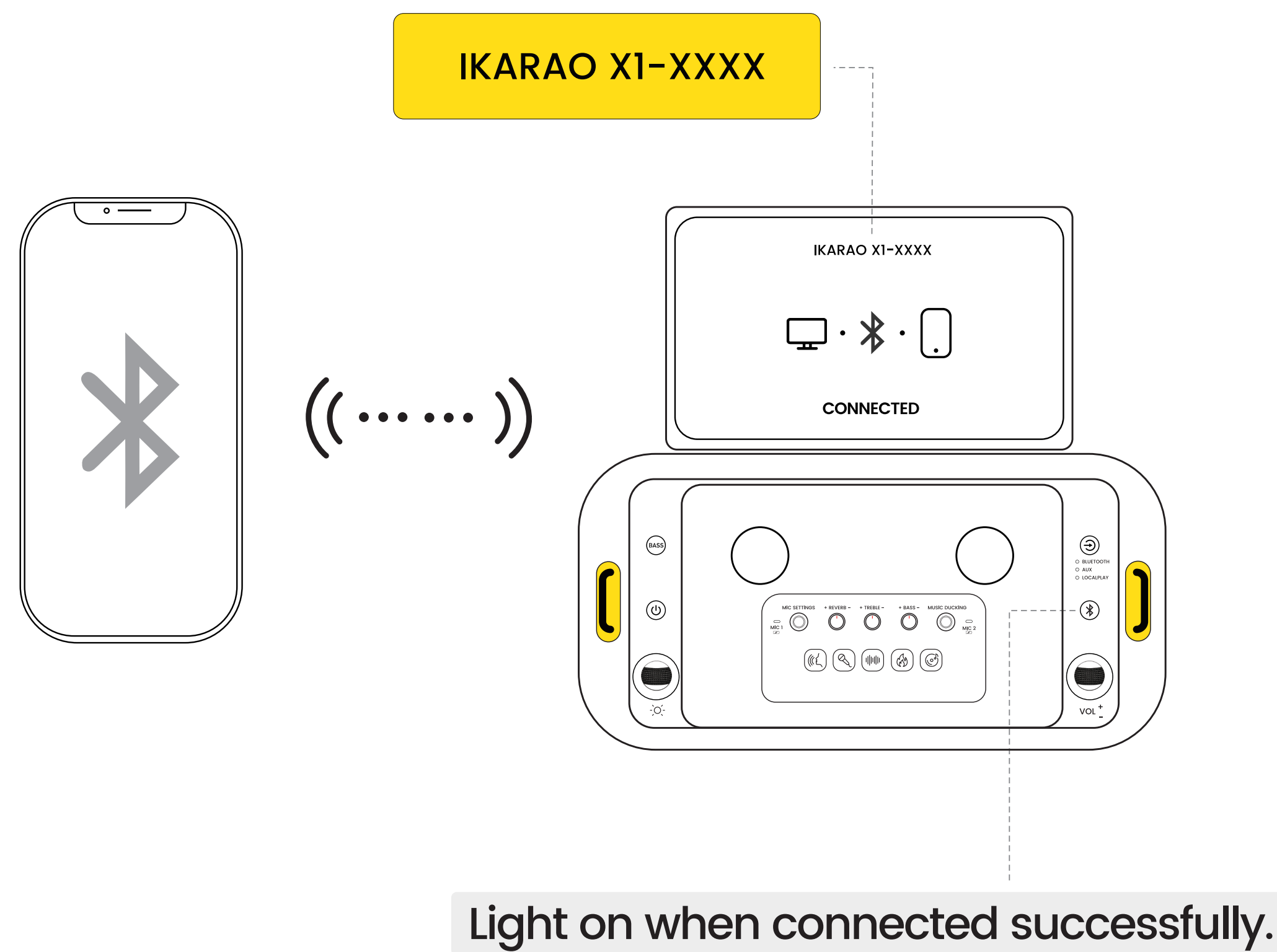
BLUETOOTH AUDIO



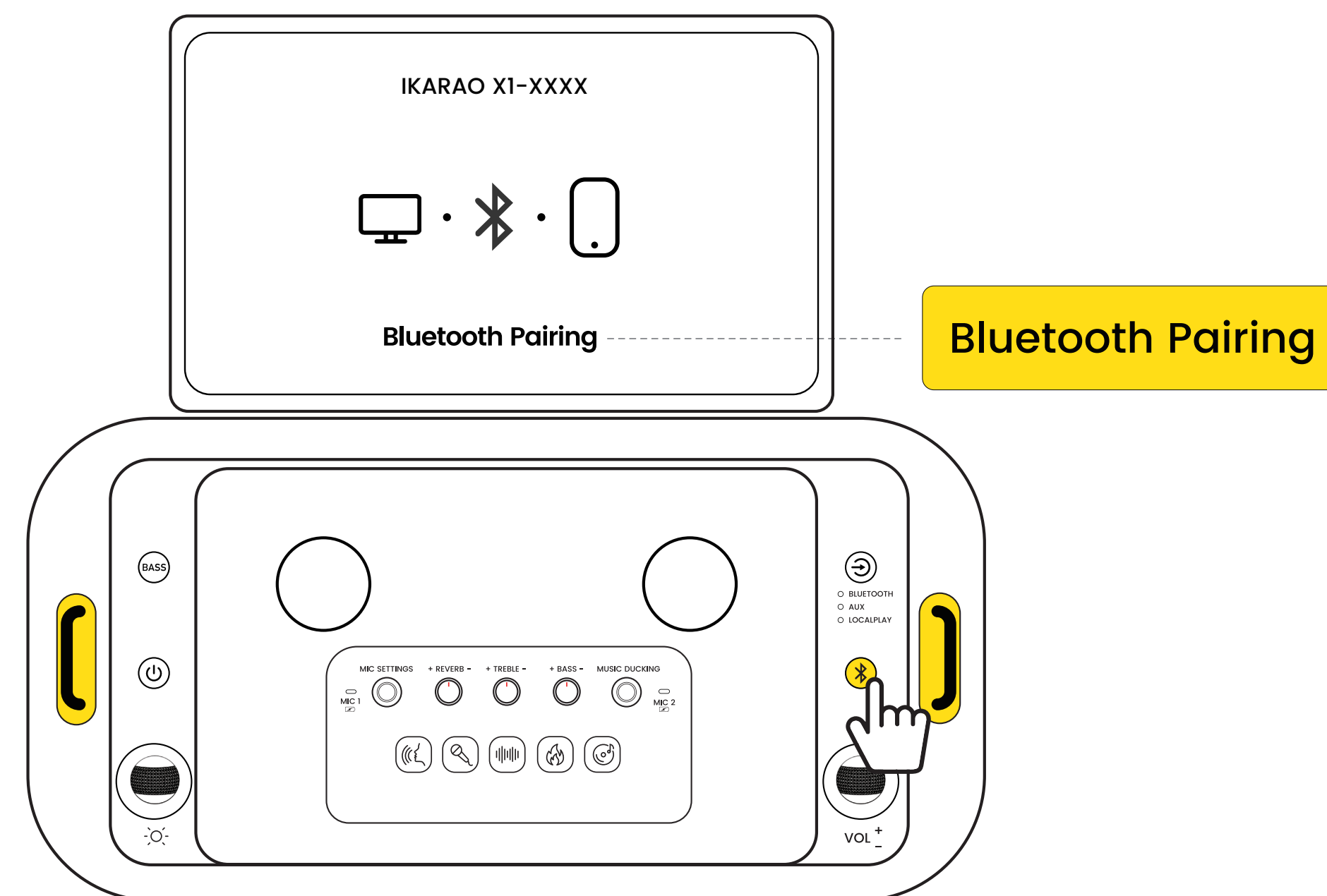
- 1 Press the **Bluetooth** button on the screen or press the playback mode button to switch into Bluetooth mode.

Bluetooth indicator light flashes fast.

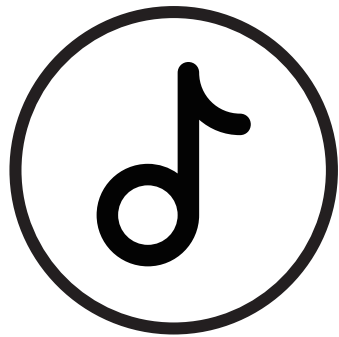
- 2 Open the Bluetooth settings on your device and pair with 'IKARAO X1-XXXX'



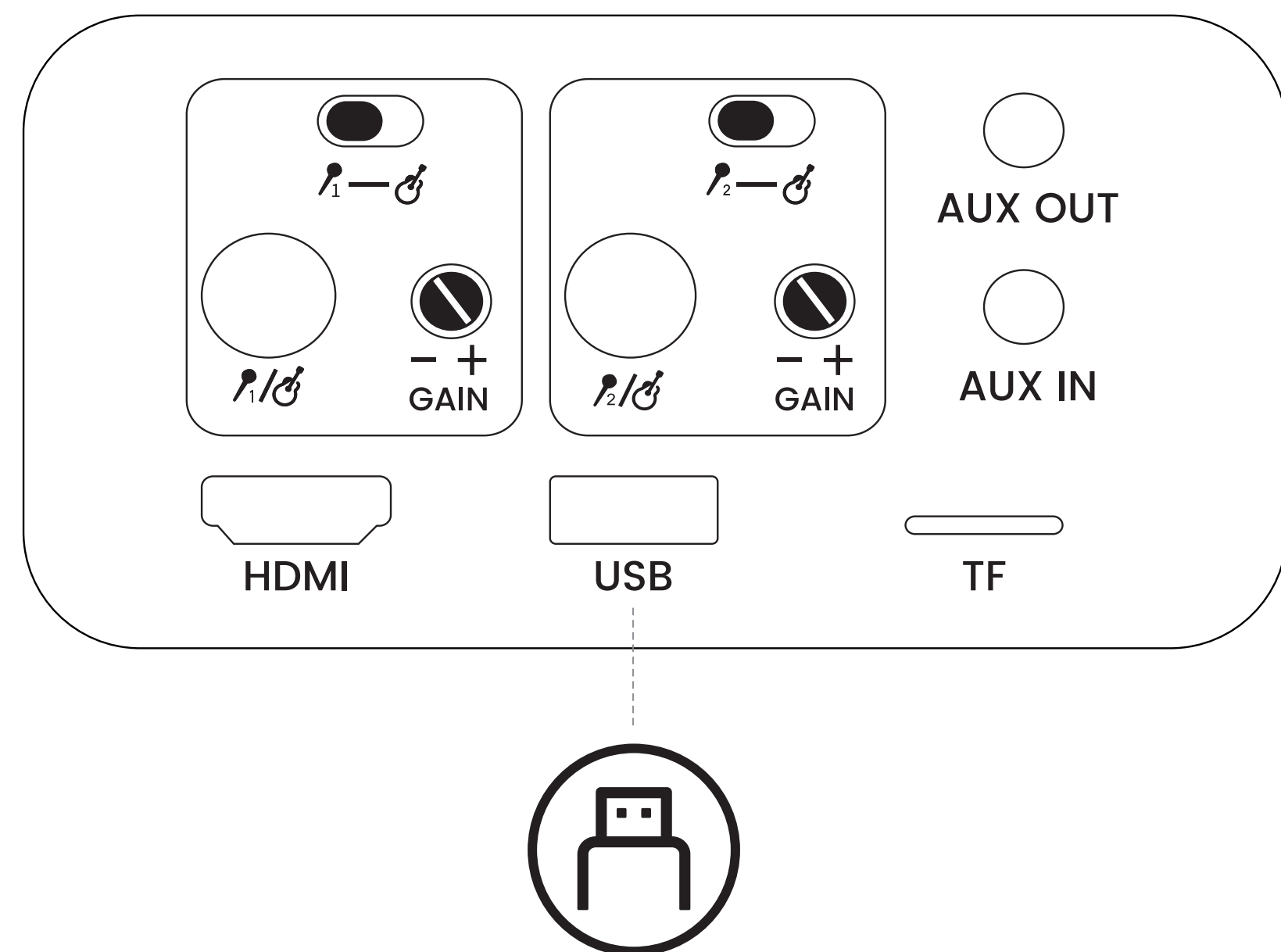
- 3 Press the Bluetooth button to disconnect



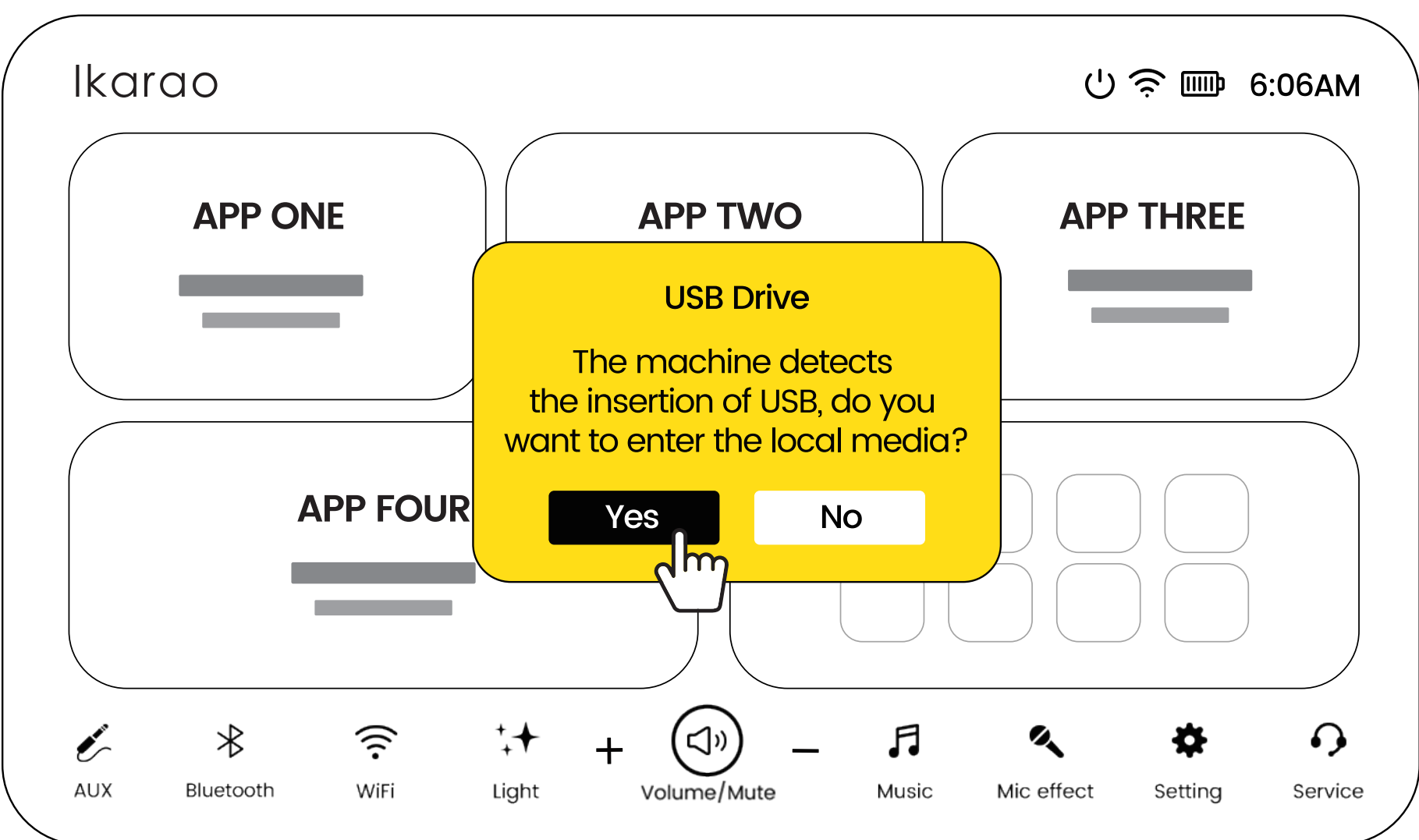
LOCAL AUDIO



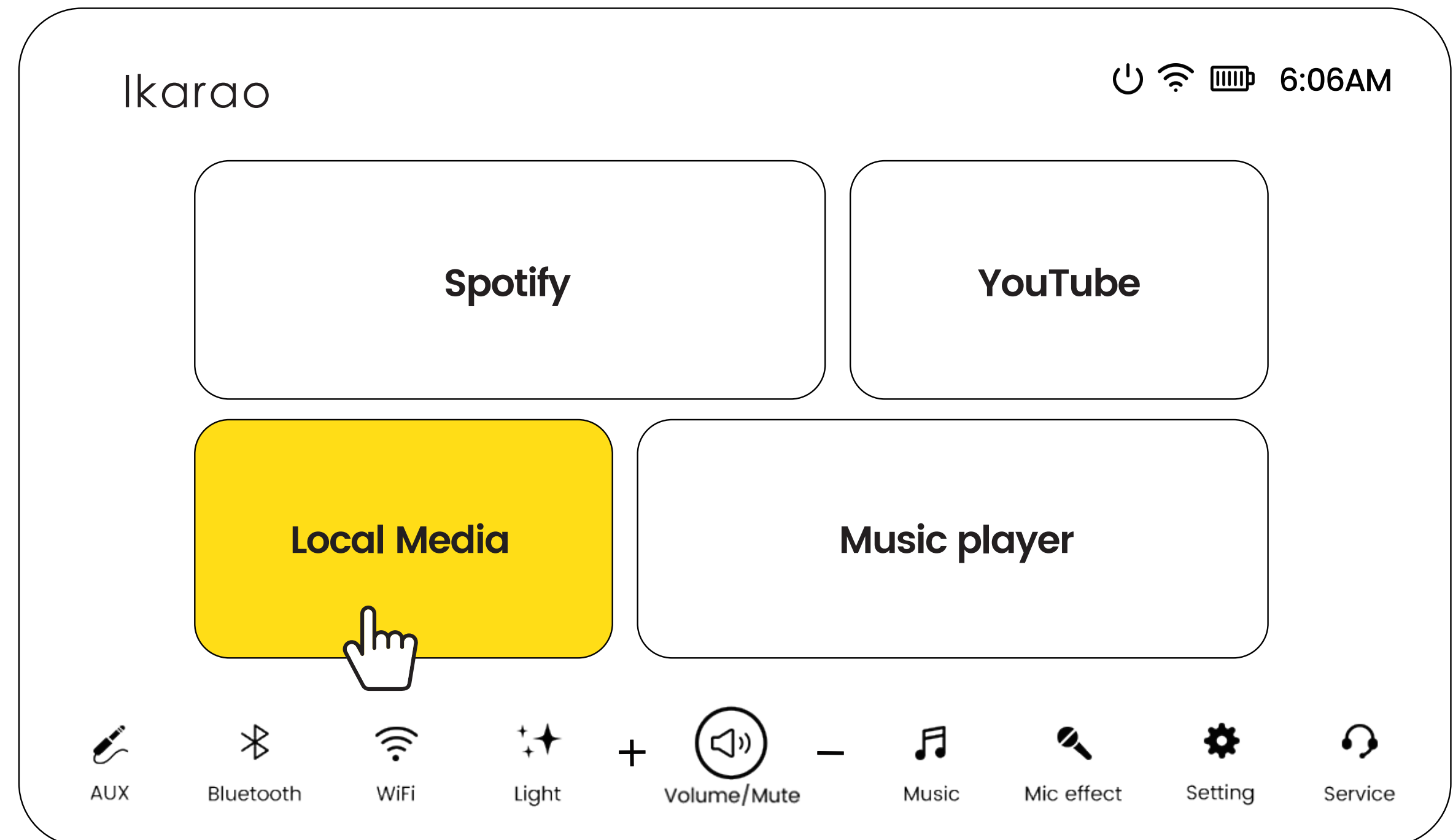
1 Insert a USB with audio/video files

re-enter the local media player by selecting **LOCAL MEDIA** .

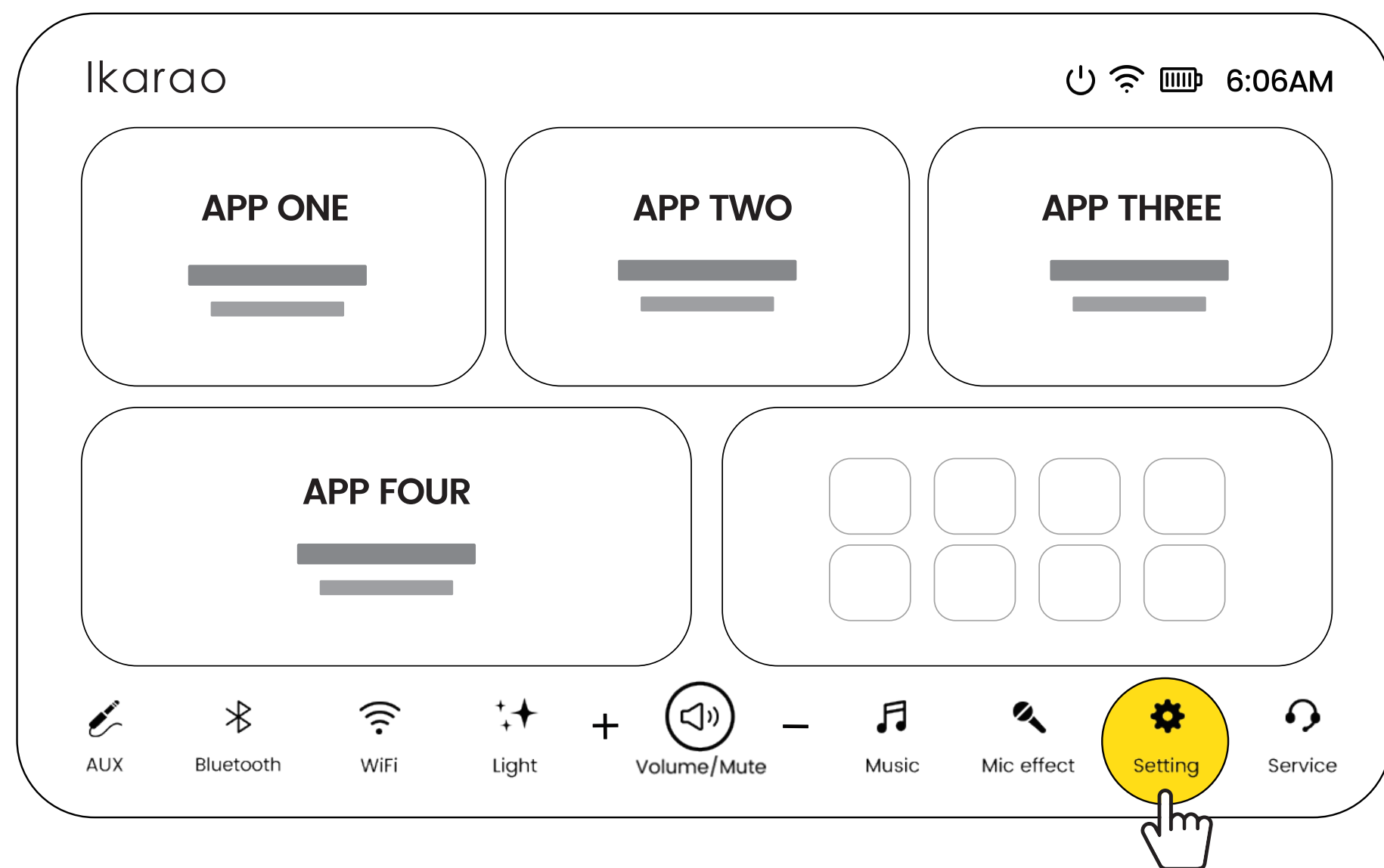


NOTE: Local Media Player auto-loads .LRC lyrics from the same directory as audio files.

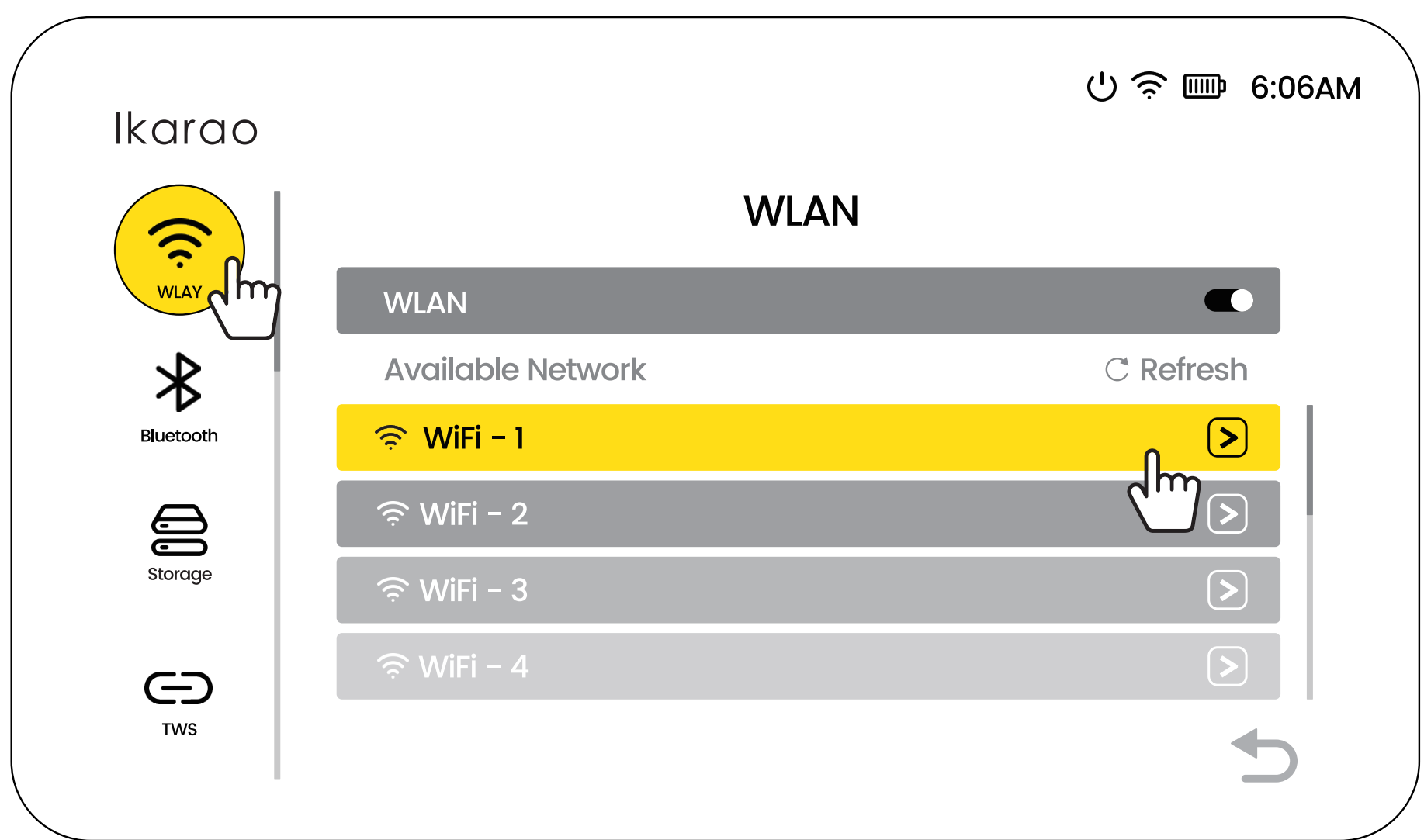

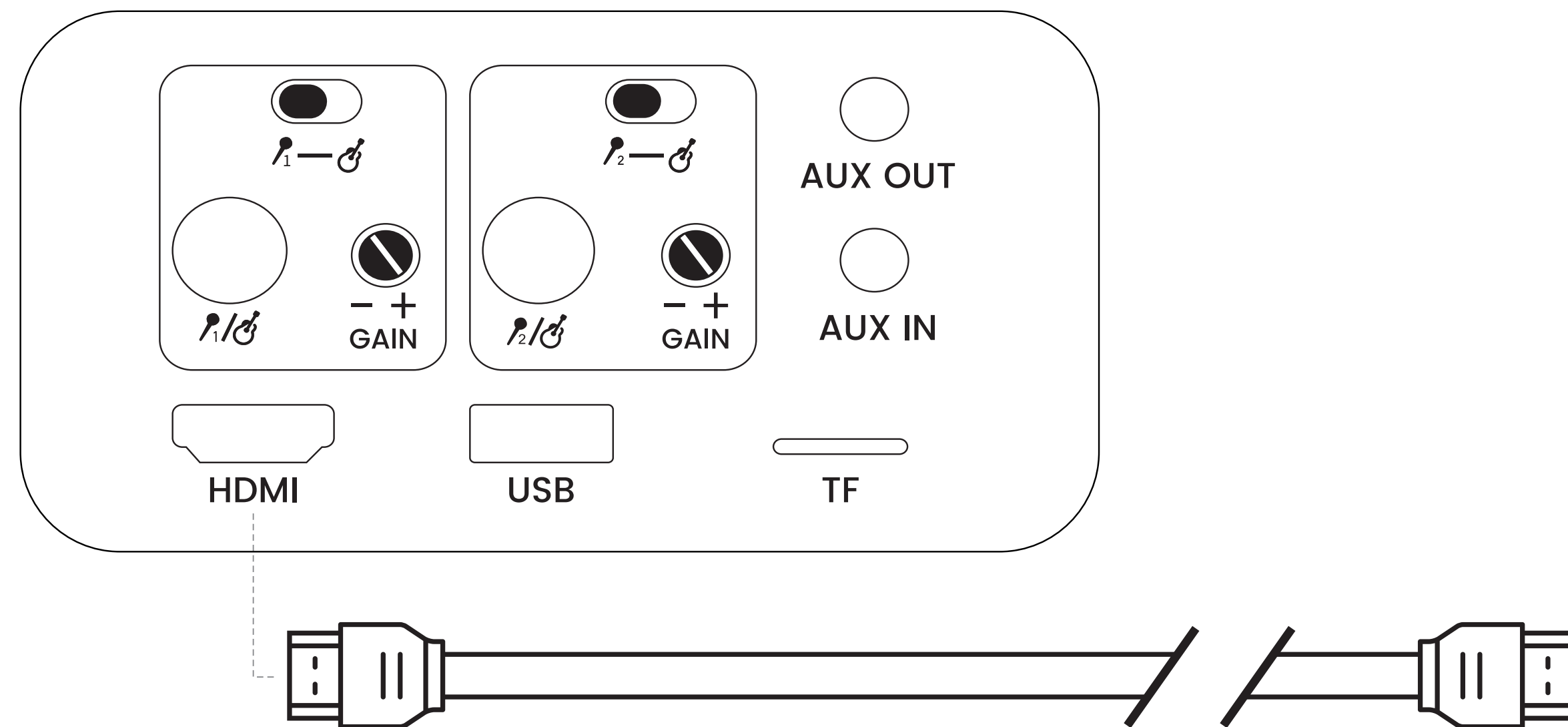


NOTE: After connecting to Wi-Fi, use pre-installed apps to play music.

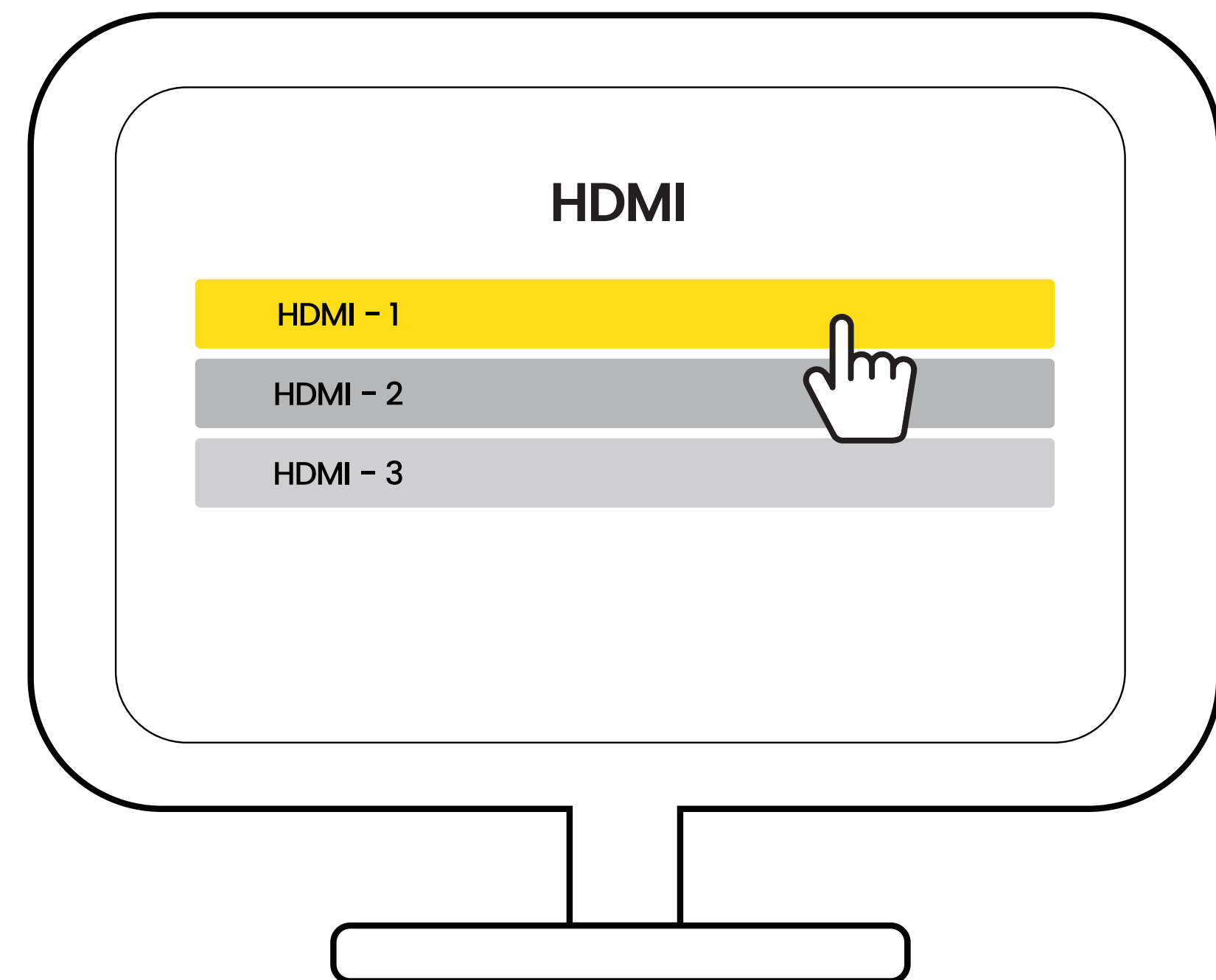
HDMI



1 Connect using HDMI cable



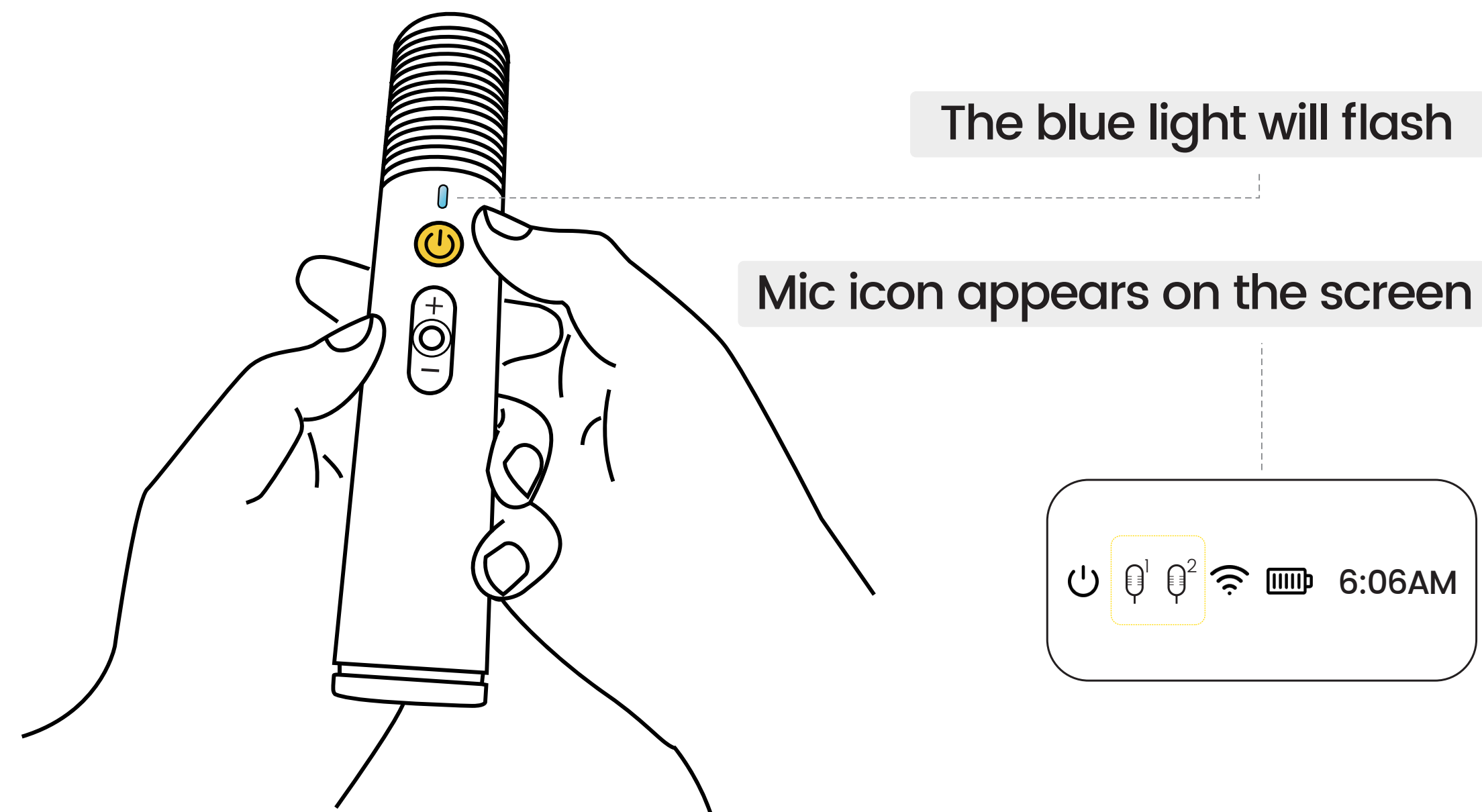
2 Select the HDMI input source to confirm connection



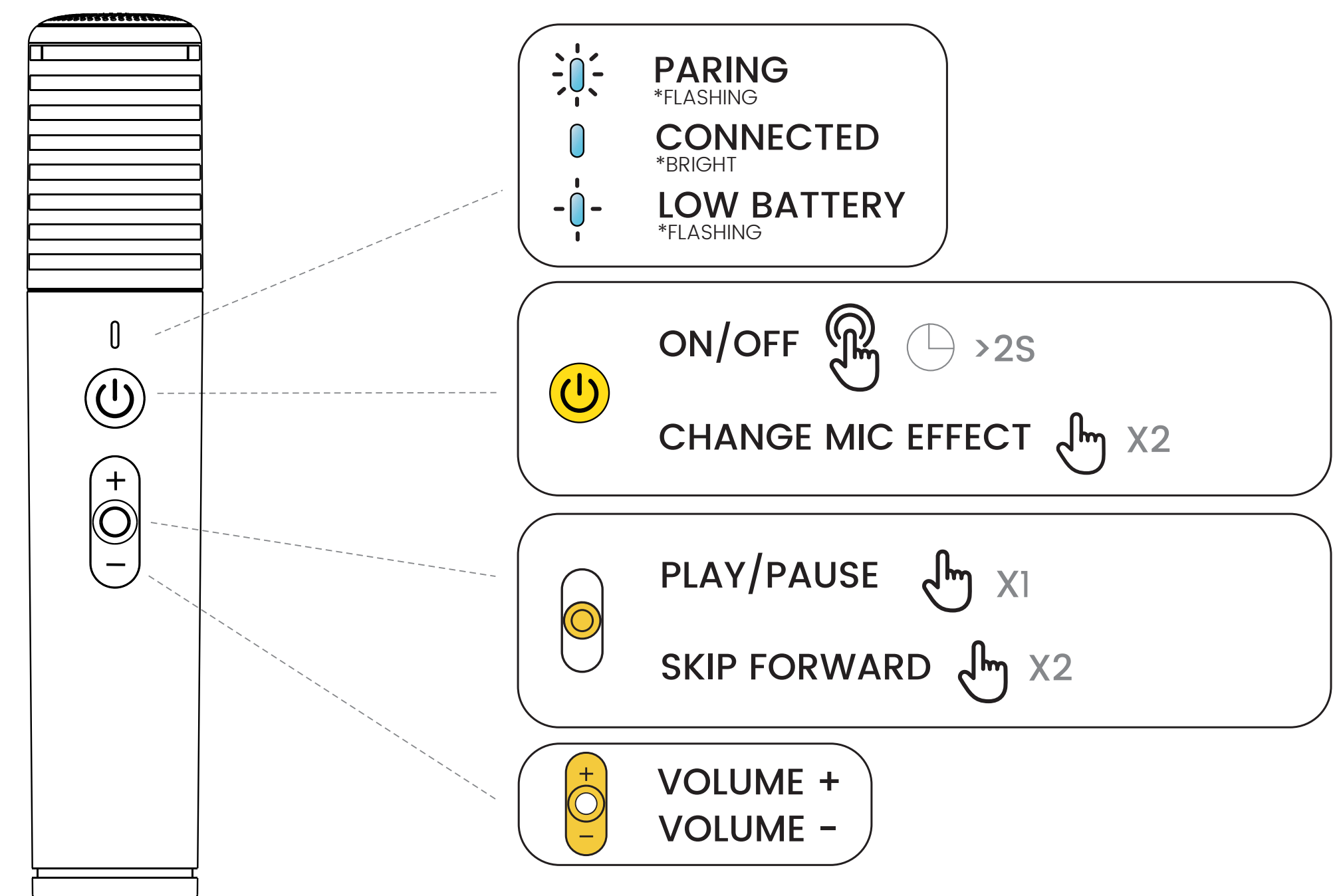
MICROPHONES



- 1 Hold the power button for 2 seconds to turn on.
Then the mic auto-pairs with the speaker.



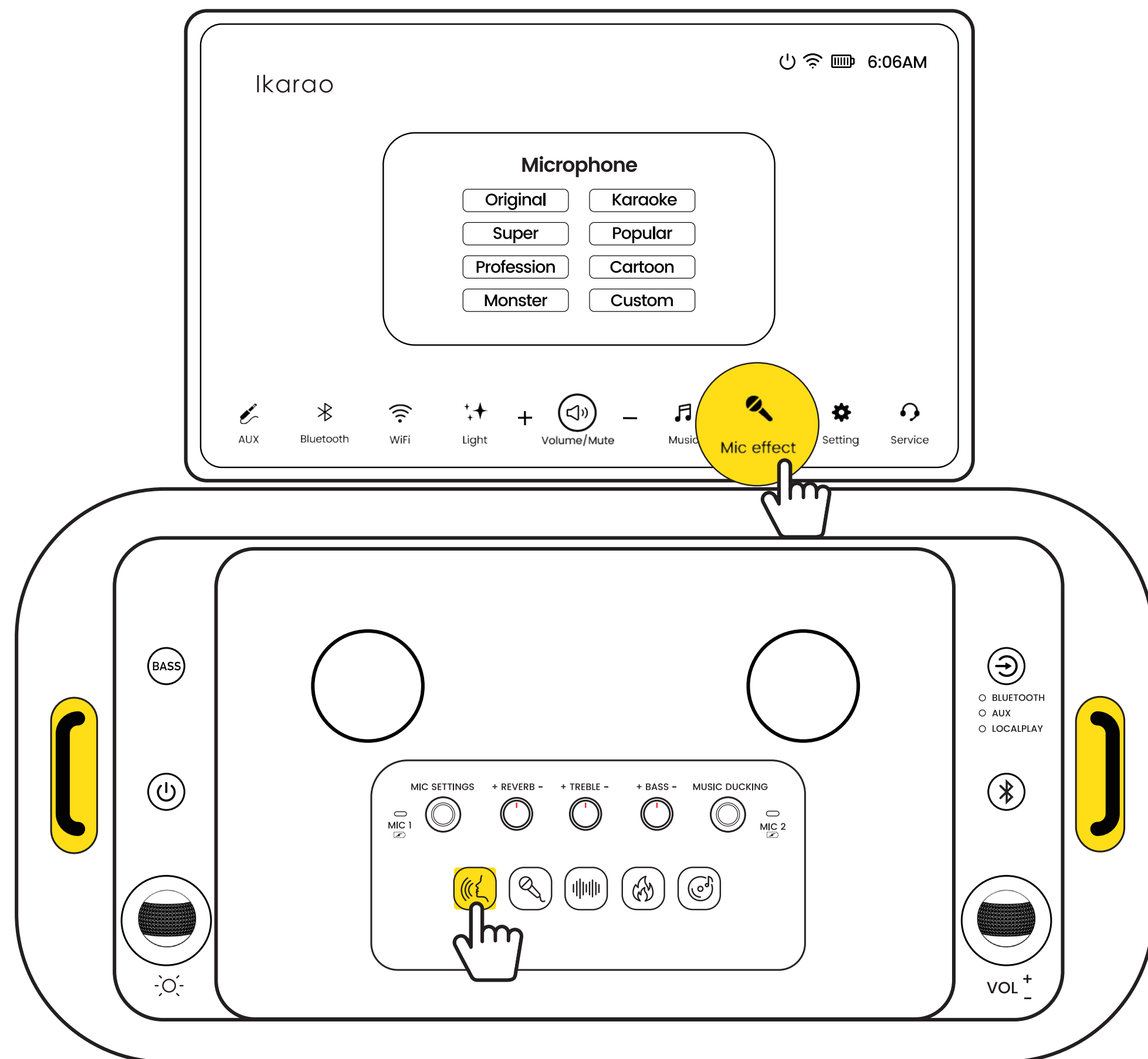
- 2 Use buttons to switch effects, adjust volume, and play/pause.



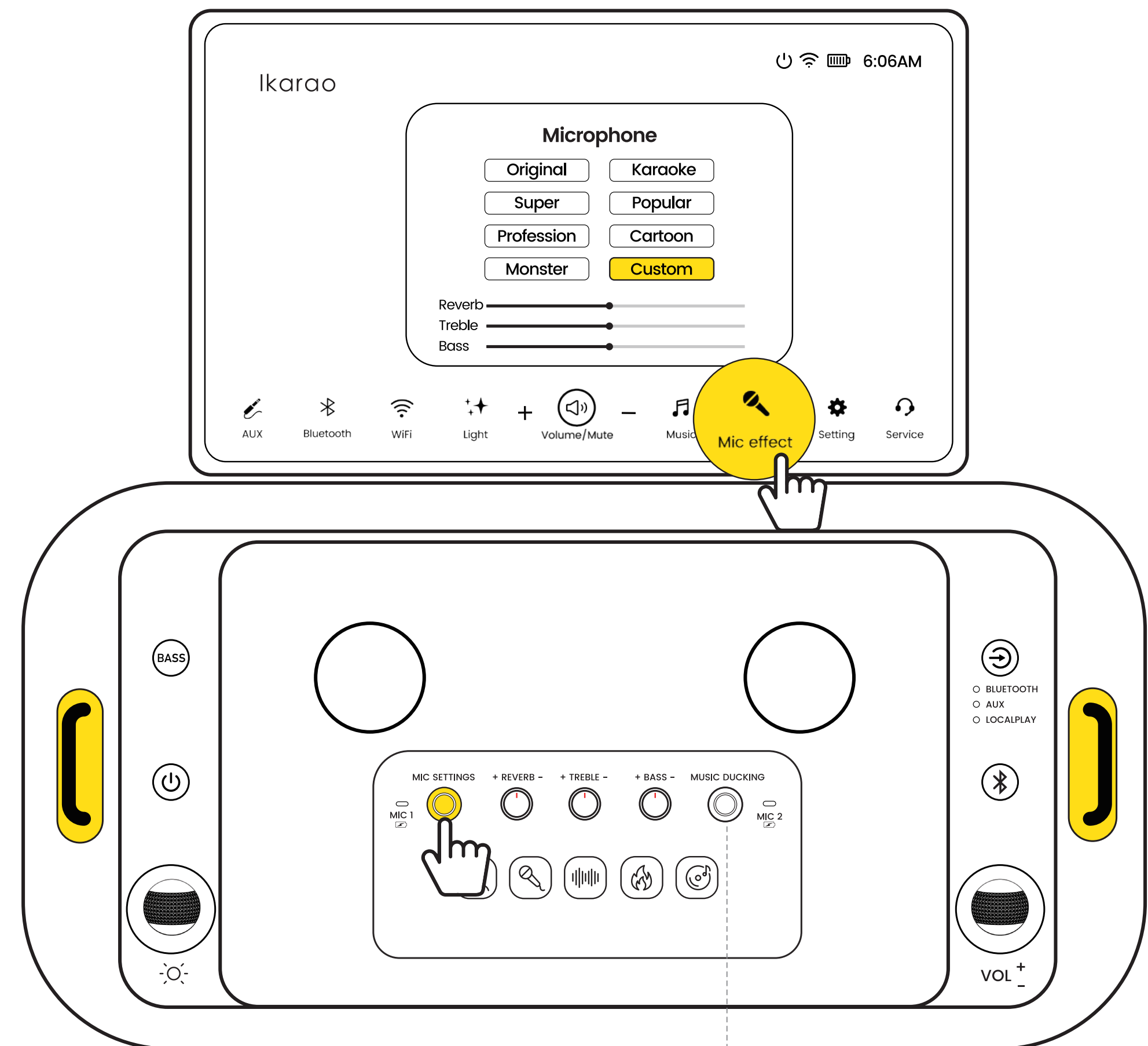
NOTE: Don't point the mic at the speaker to avoid interference.

Two operation of mic will differ due to the version difference.(change mic effect*1, skip forward >2S)

- 4 Switch microphone sound via speaker buttons or **Mic Effect** in the software.



- 5 Click **Mic Settings** or **Custom** to enter custom sound mode and adjust Reverb, Treble, and Bass to your preference.

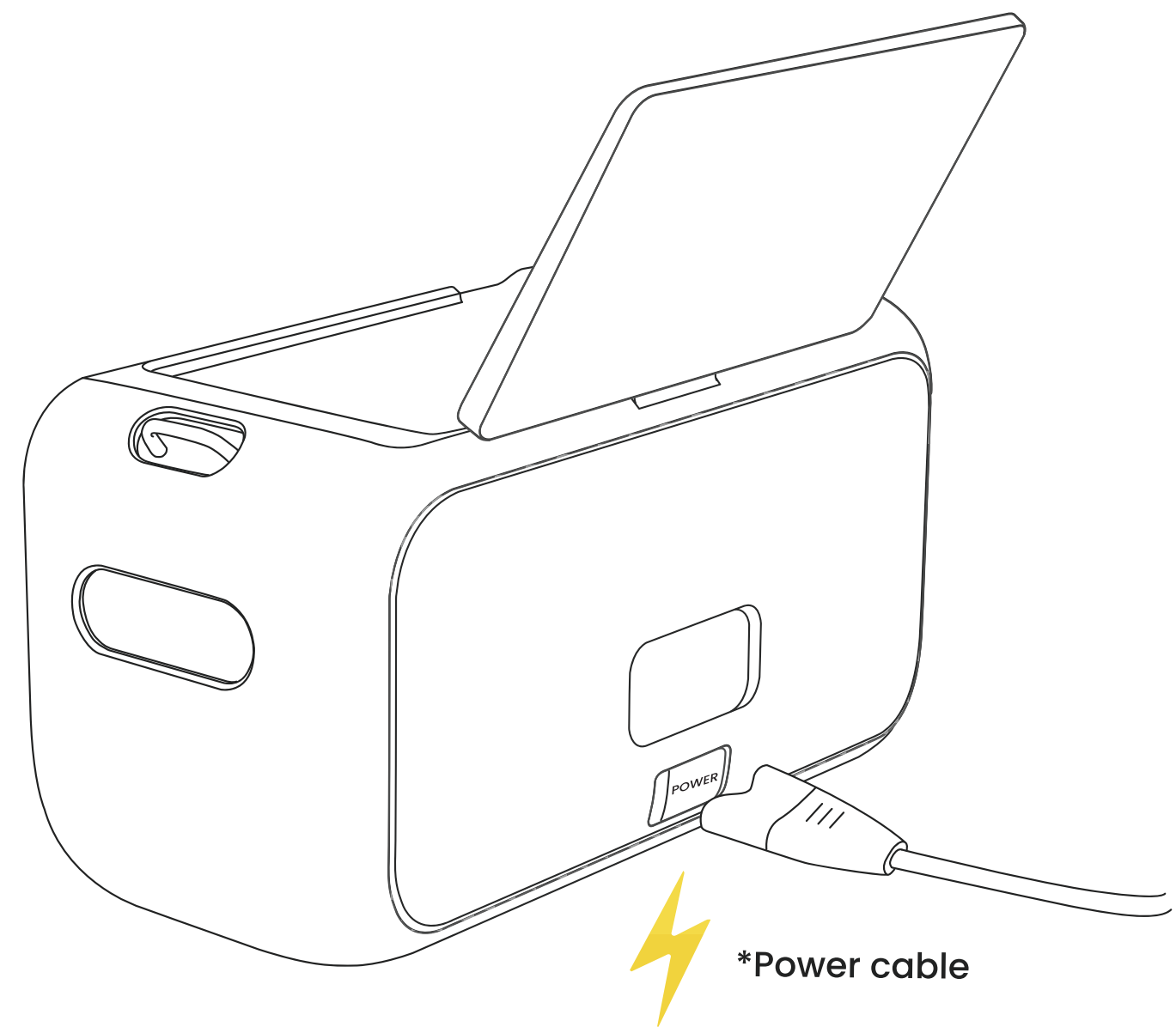


Enable vocal priority by clicking the **Music Ducking** button during speech.

MICROPHONES CHARGING

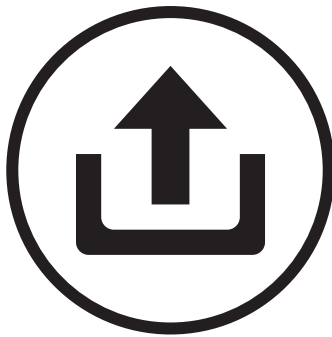


Tap the microphone into the storage to begin charging.

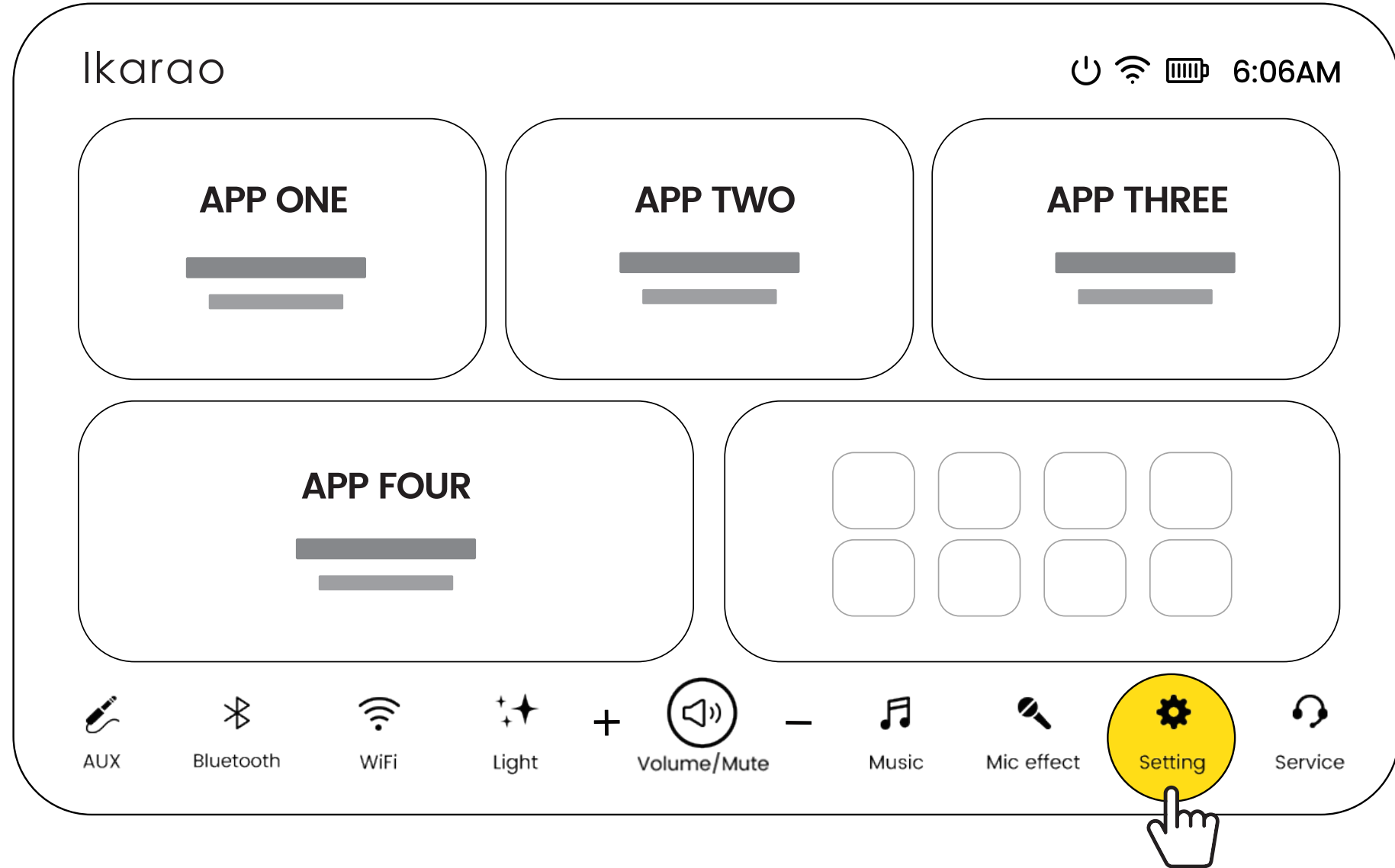
NOTE: Microphone has a 30-hour usage duration with a 5-hour full charge time.



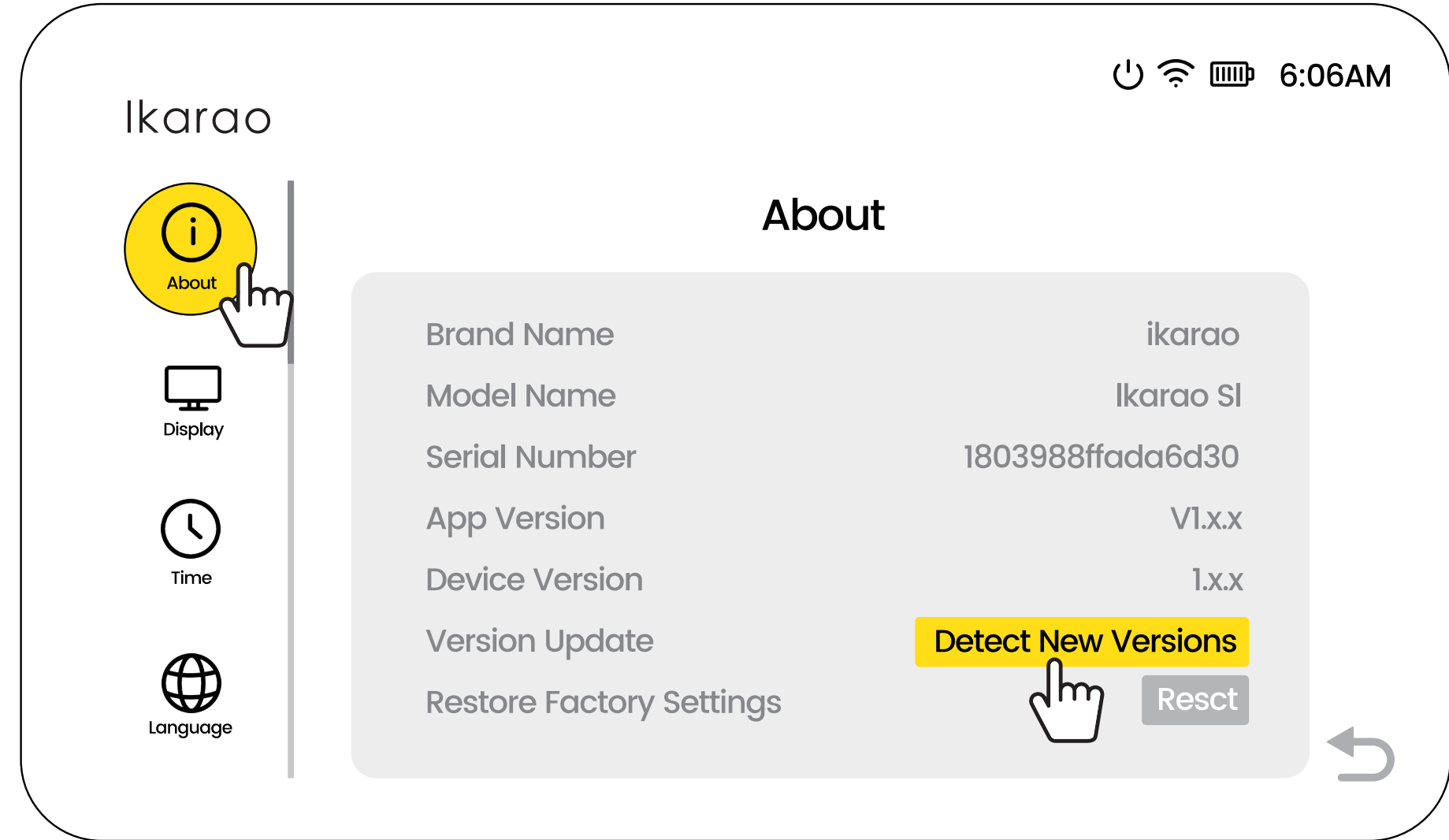

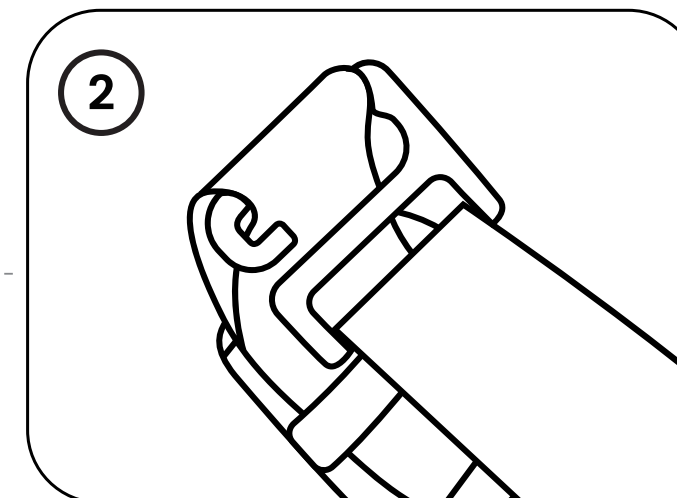
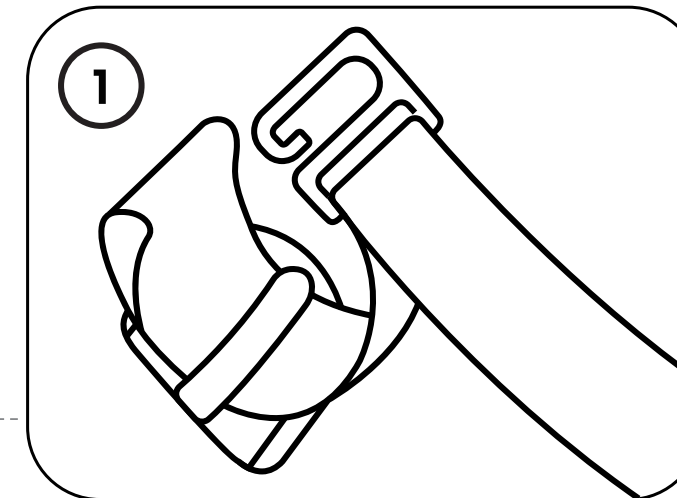
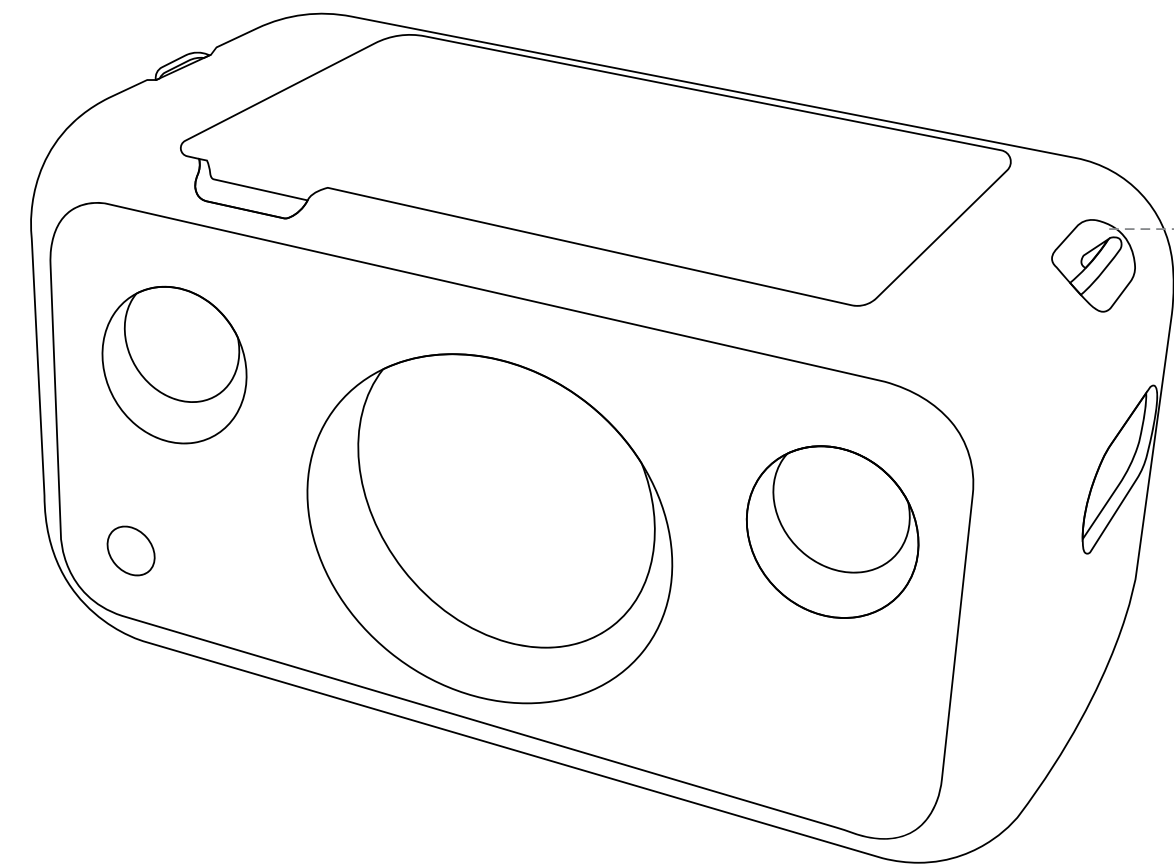
USE CARRYING STRAP

1 Take out Carrying Strap

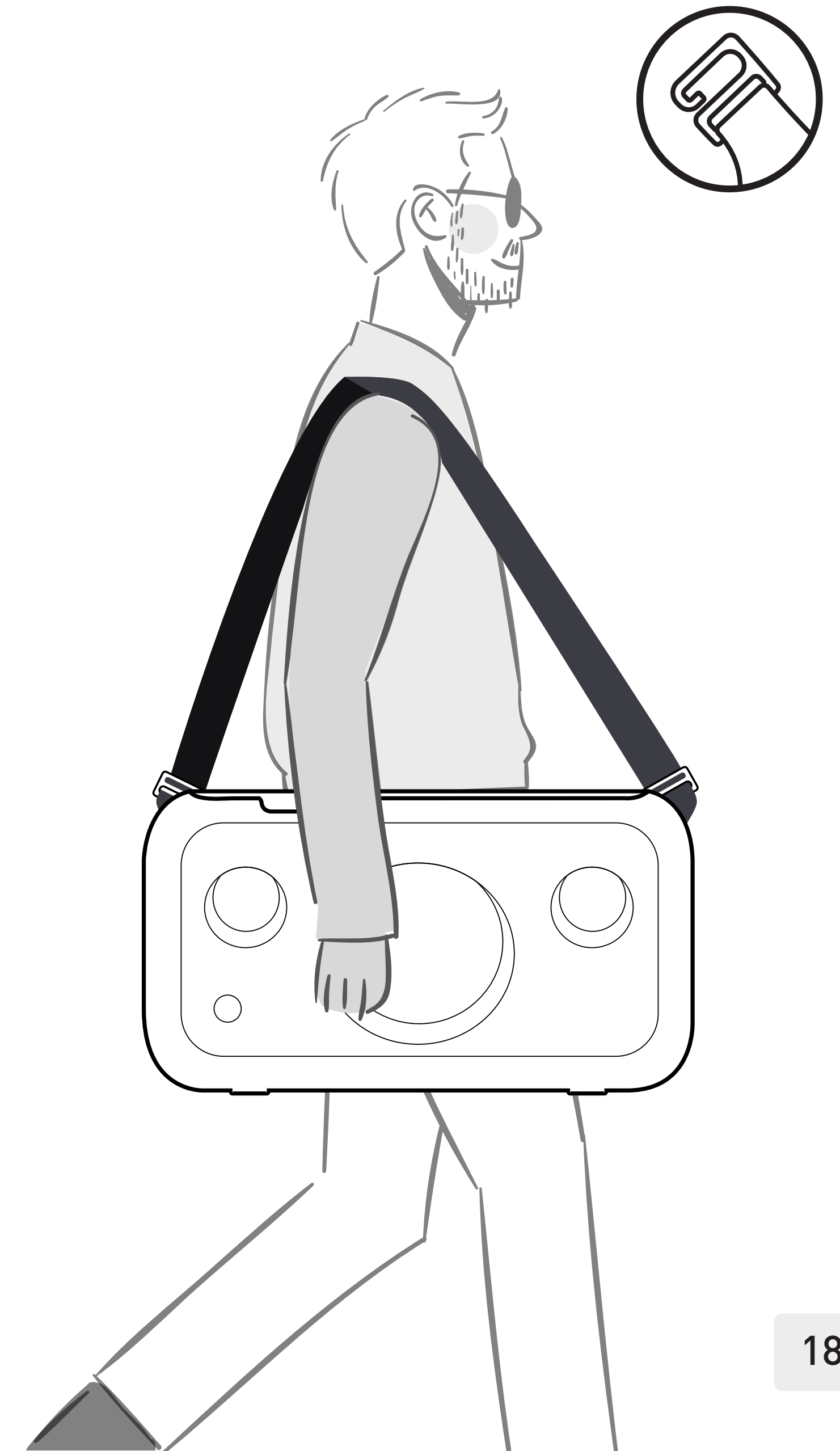


Carrying Strap

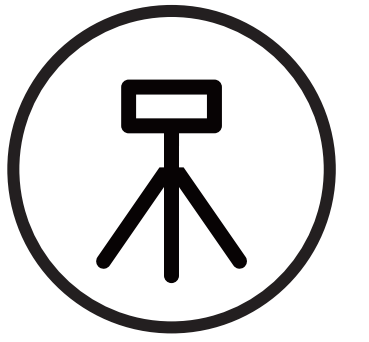
2 Buckle up Carrying Strap



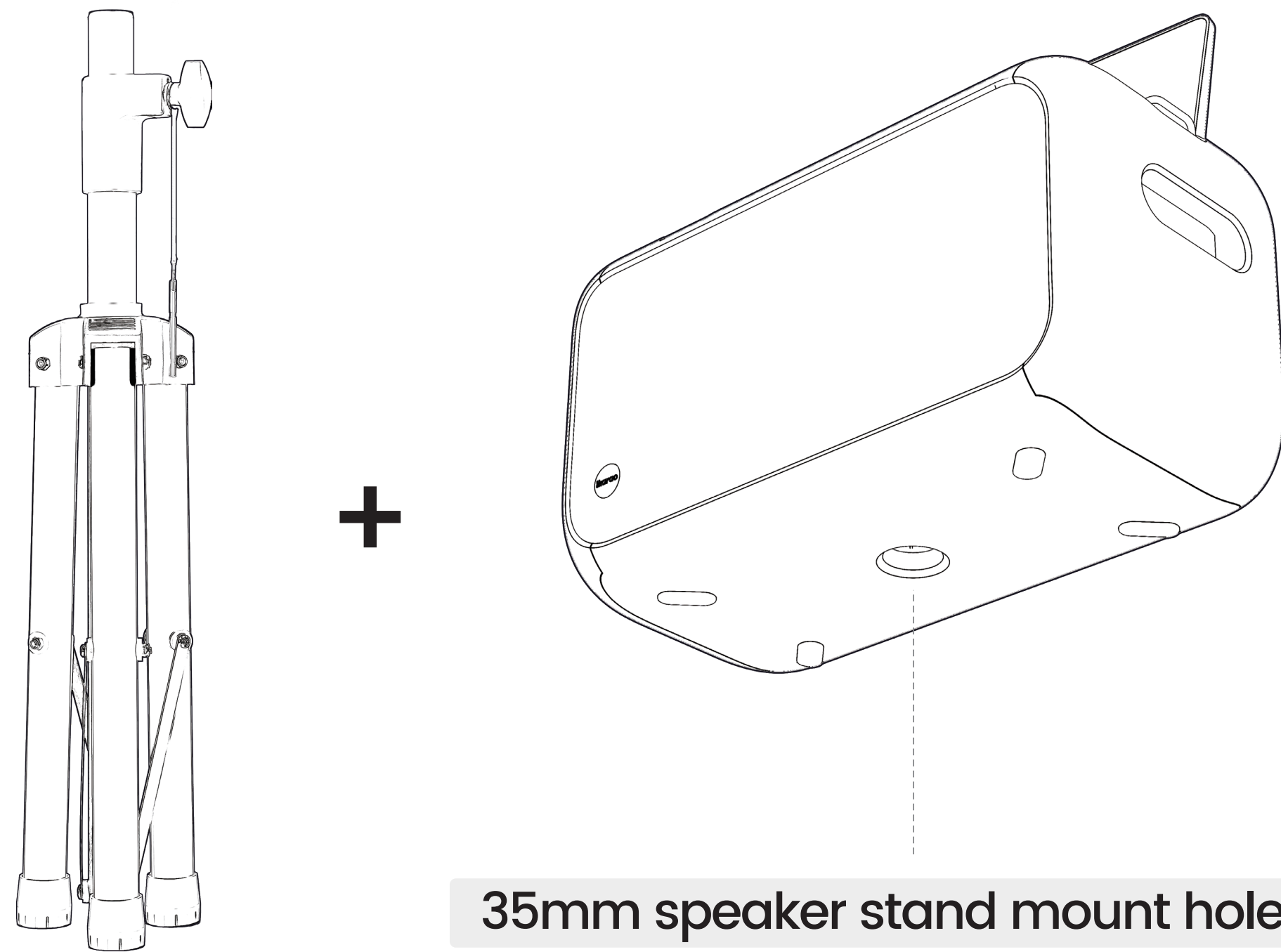
NOTE: Please fasten the strap to ensure your speaker can be carried safely.



USE SPEAKER TRIPOD STAND



- 1 Extend the speaker stand and find the 35mm mount hole on the bottom of the Break X1
