





Press the (Bluetooth) button on the screen or press the playback mode button to switch into Bluetooth mode.

Open the Bluetooth settings on your device and pair with 'IKARAO SI-XXXX'




3 Press the Bluetooth button to disconnect




LOCAL AUDIO

2 Click **Yes** on the screen prompt to enter the local media player




If you accidentally click NO,

COCAL MEDIA from the left sidebar.




NOTE: Local Media Player auto-loads .LRC lyrics from the same directory as audio files.





MICROPHONES




Hold the power button for 2 seconds to turn on

SPEAKER CHARGING



1 Charge speaker with Type-C cable





NOTE: Cable included, no adapter. Use a 22W+ adapter for fast 3-hour charging.

MICROPHONES CHARGING





Place mics in magnetic charging slot

NOTE:


- Microphone has a 20-hour usage duration with a 5-hour full charge time.

SOFTWARE UPDATE








NOTE: Ensure speaker power is above 50% or plugged in.




