
1. Functional features

This product is a high performance LED bulb supporting remote control, wireless remote control, control light switch and timing off, adjust brightness, color temperature. No additional wiring, simple installation, easy operation, safe and stable. The intelligent lighting of lamps is realized, which is suitable for different scene requirements without other changes.

2.4G high frequency wireless remote control, with low power consumption, long transmission distance, strong anti-interference ability, high air communication rate characteristics. The remote control is stylish and beautiful in appearance, practical and simple in function, and comes with power off memory (that is, when it is turned off or turned on again after power off, the bulb will automatically retain the light state before shutdown). And has a small night light, and other specific scene one-click direct function.

Can directly replace the traditional lamps, widely used in living room, kitchen, living room, hotel, club, meeting room and other places.

3. Basic function operations

3.1 Code: The remote control can only be used after code operation with the LED bulb light, the method is as follows:

Install the LED bulb, confirm that the power connection is complete, cut off the power 10 seconds after the power to reconnect the power, in the power on instant (within 5 seconds), press the remote control on the key, the bulb will flash, indicating that the code is successful.

Note: One remote control can control a maximum of 15 bulbs, but a bulb can only accept a maximum of three remote control matches.
