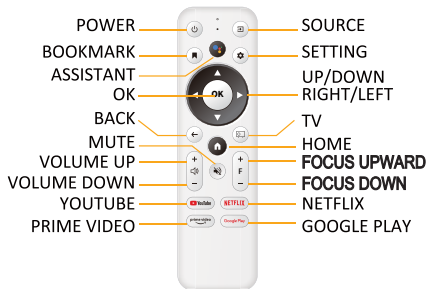

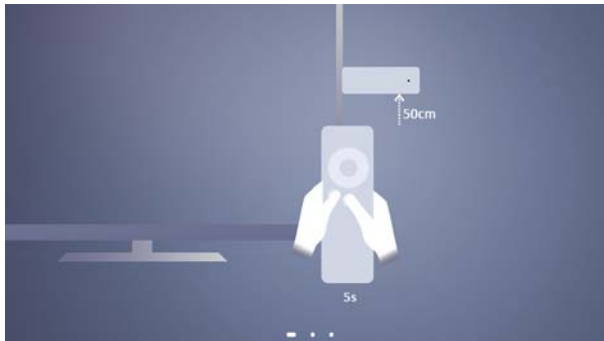
Please insert the TV stick into the slot before power on.

# Quick Start

At the first time to boot up the projector, please put the batteries into RCU and make sure the TV Stick inserted into the Projector, and then get the RCU close to the projector, the TV Stick will be paired with the RCU automatically.

If pair failed please press “BACK”  and “HOME”  to start pairing manually and the **blue LED** on when accomplished .

The projector will present TV Stick input as default after booting up, you may select other input source manually.



# Quick Setting

Select the TV-STICK language.



Set up your TV with an Android phone or tablet.

Or set up step by step using remote control.

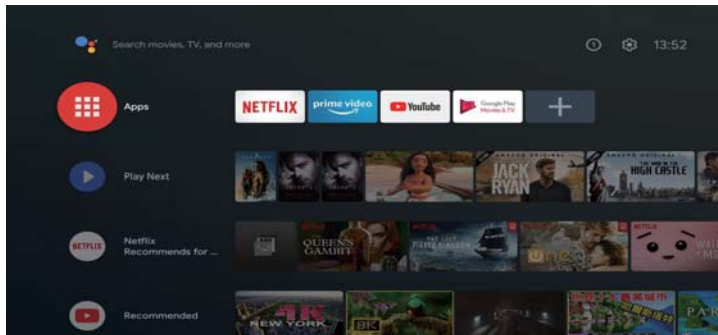


## Quick Setting

Get all apps and games on Google play.

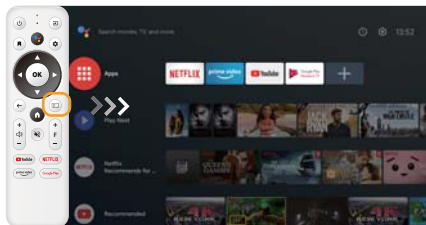


# Quick Setting

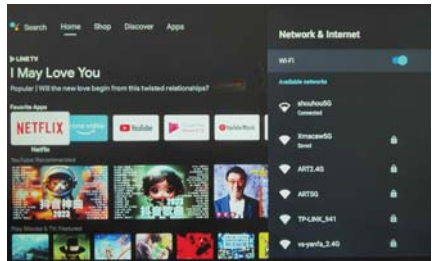
## WIFI Specification:
