Air purifier

HEPA filter elements filter most particulate pollutants in the air, such as PM2. 5.

Dust particles, pet hair, pollen, cigarette smoke and odor, etc., so as to achieve the purpose of air purification.

D. Use your air purifier

Note: The power adapter is at the bottom of the package. Before use, make sure that the filter element is free of plastic bags. Do not place the back close to the wall so as not to affect the purification efficiency

E. Panel Introduction



On/Off Button Turns the air purfler on/off. Tap Uto turn on your purifier, long press Utor 5 seconds Note: Indicator 🛜 Blinks when connecting/disconnected from Smart Life-Smart Living, lights up whon connected to Smart Life-Smart Living

F. How to operate this machine

Connect the power supply to complete the self-test after a beep, and the power indicator is in standby state

1.Start the machine and first enter the first gear mode, Press 1 low-end / 2mid-range /3High-grade/Sleep Cyclic variation adjustment of wind speed 2.In The ambient light is off in the sleep gear, and the wind speed runs at a lower gear

3.(A) Automatically adjust the wind speed based on the detected air quality Good air quality corresponds to gear 1F; Light air pollution corresponds to

2F gear; Heavy air pollution corresponds to gear 3F

PM2.5<75UGWei You

75UG ≤ PM2.5 < 150UG Light air pollution

PM2.5≥150UG Heavy air pollution

4. Can cycle between 2H.5H.8H

Press and hold for 3 seconds and then enter after hearing a beep. The same is true when the child is unlocked. The current state is fixed after the child is locked. If any key is touched by mistake, it will be reminded by a beep twice. In the startup state, the filter screen timing starts to be consumed. The initial time is 2000 hours . The service life of the filter screen is displayed as 10 gears, and each gear is 200 hours. When the remaining time of the filter screen is 200 hours, the last gear will flash, and when the service life of the filter screen is full, all service life lamps will flash together;Touch Screen life percentage can be displayed in real time on the screen 7.When the screen life percentage reaches F0, flicker, Press and hold after replacing the filter screen Five seconds later, three drops are heard, the screen displays F99 and the screen life 10th gear lights up, reset is complete

G. Matters needing attention



1. Non-professional maintenance personnel are prohibited fromdismantling and refitting the air purifier.

2. Prohibit the use of power beyond the specification.

3. Do not get the air purifier wet

4. Do not wipe the air purifier with alcohol or organic solvent.

5. Avoid starting machines around heavy smoke and soot.

6. Do not spray insecticides in or on the unit.


7. Do not run the unit if the power cord is damaged.

9. Tip:Don't block the PM2.5 sensor



1. Please pay attention to ventilation when using the air purifierand gas appliances at the same time.



2.Inspect the power plug regularlyfor any damage.

—The function key doesnt work.—Short circuit.

-Thepower cord or plug becomes abnormally hot.

—There is a burning smell or unusual sound and vibration.—

H.Maintenance

The unit needs regular maintenance to ensure that the air purifier is atoptimal performance. Regularly wipe the air inlet and outlet with a soft, damp cloth. Allow unit to dry completely before turning back on.

Instructions of cleaning filter:

1. Turn off the unit and unplug the power cord.

2.open the filter cover and remove the filter.

3.use a soft brush or vacuum cleaner to clean the filter.

4.Tip:you can place the filter in direct sunlight for 1-3 hours.Do not allow the filter to get wet.

Note: Above actions only help to maintain filters' performance.

Reset Filter Indicator:

When the filter needs to be replaced, the filter indicatorlight will flash

1.Turn off the device and unplug the power cord from the left side of thedevice

2. Open the purifier cover from the notches on both sides and remove

3.Install the new filter (remove the protective plastic bag)and reset

4. Press and hold the filter button for 5 seconds until you hear 3 beeps tocomplete the reset of the filter indicator



Open the filter from the back to replace it

Add essential oil

Pull out the protective covers at both ends of the essential oil part, open the upper cover and add 4-5 drops of essential oil,

and then reinstall the air outlet grille at the top of the machine.
