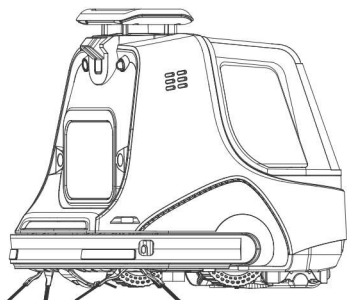

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Safety Instructions

About Safety

1. This device is not suitable to be used by children under 8 years old and people with physical or emotional disabilities. If to use, please operate the device under the supervision of the guardian. Please don't let the child sit on the robot and play the robot as a toy.
2. Please remove obstacles before using the robot. Such as power cord and other items. Please fold the edge of the carpet under the carpet. And also do not let the curtain and tablecloth touch the floor.
3. If there are environment like stairs, please test the robot to see if it can detect the edge of the falling area without dropping.
4. Please follow the instructions to operate the robot.
5. Make sure the power supply voltage matches the voltage marked on the charging base.
6. Use only in indoor and home environments. Do not use in outdoor, commercial and industrial environment.
7. Only use the original rechargeable battery and charging base provided by the manufacturer. Non-rechargeable batteries are strictly forbidden to use. Battery specifications please refer to the technical parameters.

8. Do not flush the robot directly with water.
9. Do not wipe the robot with watery cloth.
10. Do not use on wet or watery floor.
11. Do not use in open fire and fragile environment.
12. Do not let the hair, cloth and fingers come close to the product's openings or operating parts.
13. Do not let the robot to suck any material that might block the device, such as stones, waste paper, etc.
14. Prohibit robot from absorbing any flammable materials, such as gasoline and toner for printer or photocopier.
15. Do not allow the product to absorb any products that are burning, such as cigarettes, matches, ashes and other products that may cause a fire.

Safety Instructions

16. Do not place the product on the sucking mouth. Do not use the robot if sucking mouth blocked. Clean up dust, hair, cotton, etc., to ensure the air at the sucking mouth flows smoothly.
17. Prohibit using the damaged charging base.
18. Use the power cord carefully to avoid damage. Do not use the power cord to drag and pull the product or its charging base. Do not allow the product to run on the power cord and keep the power cord away from heat source.
19. If the power cord is damaged, to avoid the danger, it must be replaced by the qualified maintenance staff.
20. Make sure the dust bin and filter are properly installed before using.
21. Do not use the robot in an infant sleeping room.
22. Do not use the robot when the product cannot work properly due to drop, damage, water, or outdoor use. And please let the robot repaired by the manufacturer and its service department.
23. If do not use the product for a long time, disconnect the power supply.

About Maintenance

24. Before cleaning and maintaining the product, please turn off the power switch first.
25. Before cleaning and maintaining the product, please pull the power cord out of power socket.

About Disposal

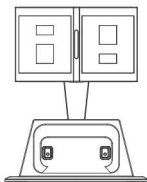
26. Before disposing of the product, please remove the product from the charging base, turn the power switch off and remove the battery.
27. Before disposing of batteries, you must follow local laws and regulations.
28. Even if the product is severely damaged, it is forbidden to incinerate the product and the battery may cause an explosion.

Product Operation

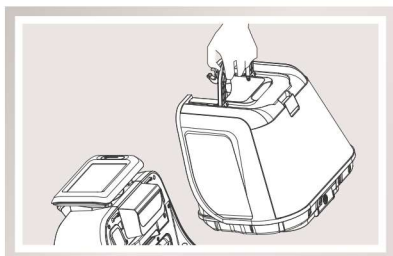
Preparation Before Using

- Take the robot out from pack box and take the dustbin out, lifts the dustbin, presses the dustbin switch, and tears off the sticker on cover.
- Put the dustbin back on the host.

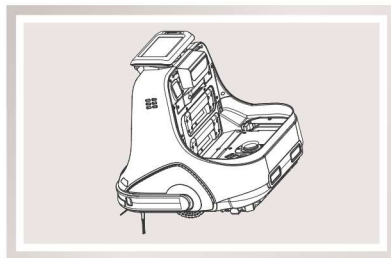
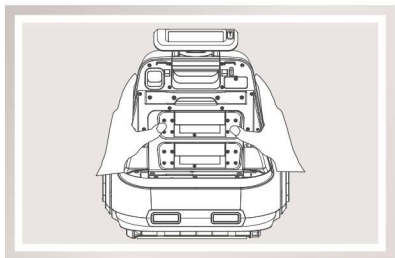


Install the Battery

Lift up the bin, put the battery into the battery slot according to the direction and press both sides of the battery with your hand at the same time to hear a "click". When you hear the "click" sound, the battery is successfully installed.

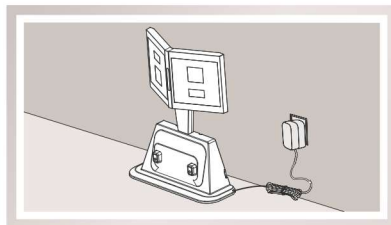
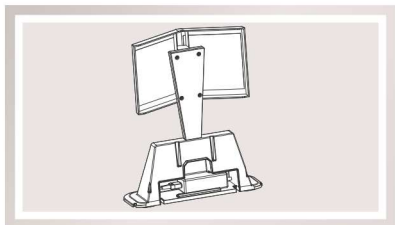

Charging Mode

- Connect the adapter and charging station.
- Place the charging station flat against the wall, the surrounding area is open and should not be covered by objects.
- Connect the power.



- Press the host switch button.




Tips:

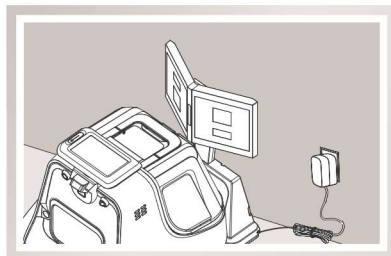
After finished cleaning, it is recommended not to turn off the robot; keep the robot in charging station so that it can better perform in next time.

Product Operation

Charging

1 Auto charge

Press the recharge button  on the robot panel or APP, the device will automatically search for the charging base to charge.



Tips:

During daily use, pay attention to cleaning the charging pin of the charging station, otherwise the charging effect will be affected.




Tips:

1. In daily use, please place the robot on the charging station, and ensure that the charging station is connected to the power supply and the host power switch is on.
2. If the robot is not used for a long time, please fully charge the machine, turn off the power, and store it in a dry and ventilated place.


Switch/Pause

2 Switch

- Make sure the power is on
- Press the button  on robot& APP to start cleaning.




Tips:

If the robot is in sleep mode, press  again to wake up the robot to enter function selection mode, press the button again then the machine will start working automatically.

Product Operation

3 Pause

- Press the button  on robot& APP to pause cleaning.




Tips:

The machine can be re-operated after the machine has been paused.



Mode Selection

1 Energy Saving

Press the energy saving button  on the robot.

2 Standard Mode

Press the standard button  on the robot.


3 Strong Mode

Press the power button  on the robot.

4 Max

Press the MAX button  on the robot.

5 Customize

Press the customize button  to customize the side brush, roller brush, volume, suction value.

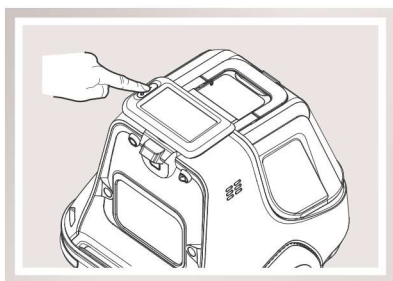

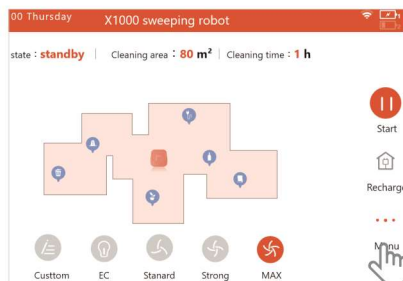

Make sure your phone is connected to an available WiFi network indoors and has a good signal quality.

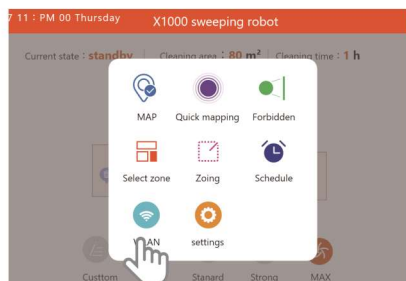

- 5 Click OK, the device will prompt "WIFI connecting".

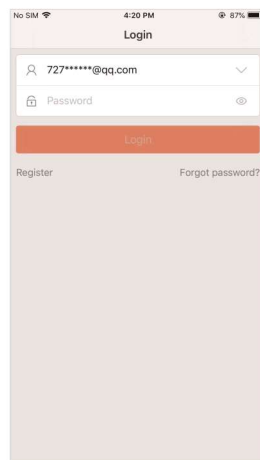

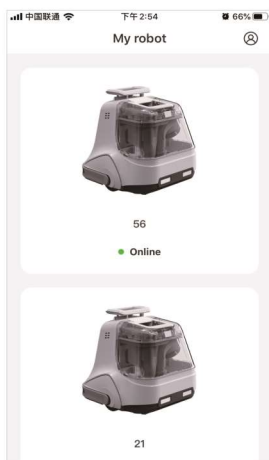
Unconnected APP

Click to select the device you want to control in the device list to enter the device control page.



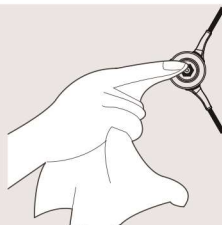

When cleaning and maintaining the device and accessories, please turn off the device and unplug the power supply of the charging station.

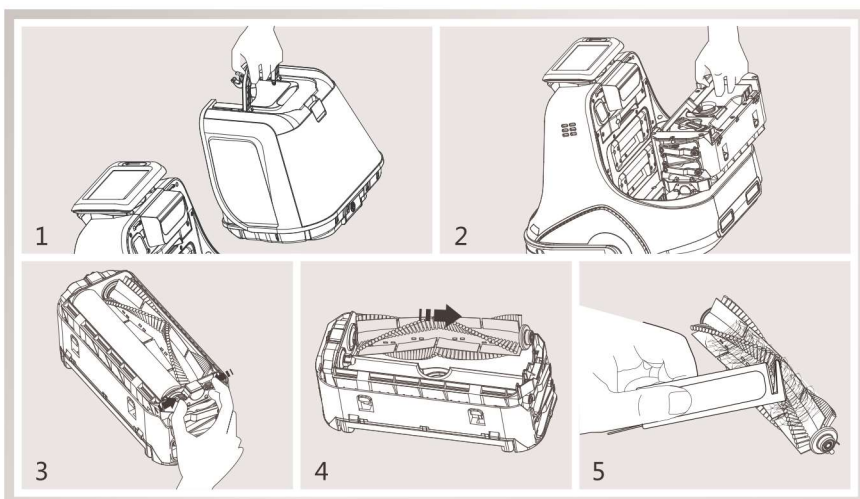
Side Brush Maintenance

Roller Brush Maintenance

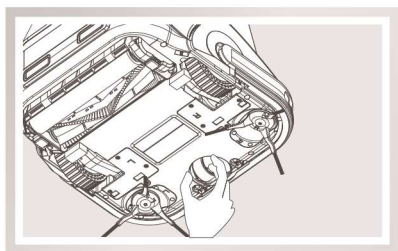

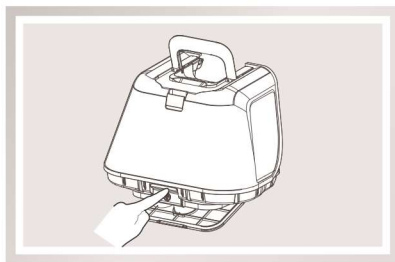
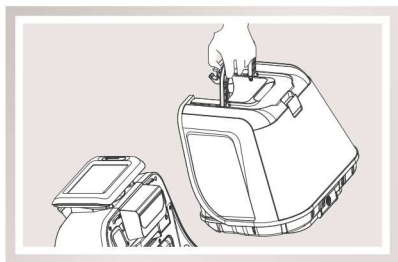
Multi-directional Castor Maintenance

Remove the castor and clean it to reduce the entanglement of hair and other particles.

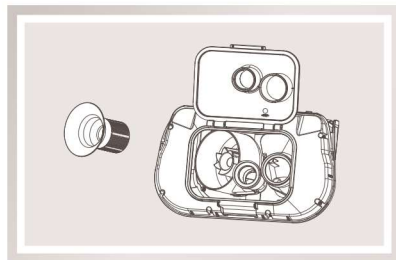
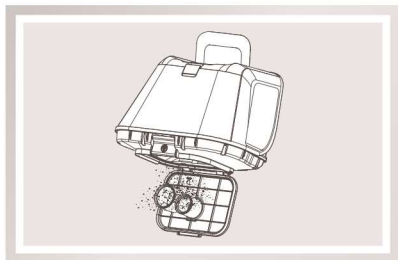


Dust Bin and Filters Maintenance

- 1 Please clean the dustbin in time after each use.
- 2 Remove the dustbin, press the button on the dustbin, after the bottom cover of dustbin pops up automatically, empty the dust inside.
- 3 Remove the filter from the dustbin, wash the filter with clean water, and make sure it is completely dry when reinstalling the filter.

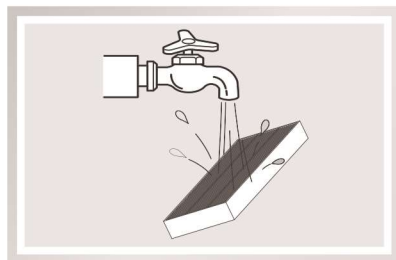
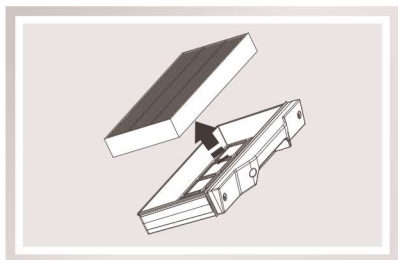
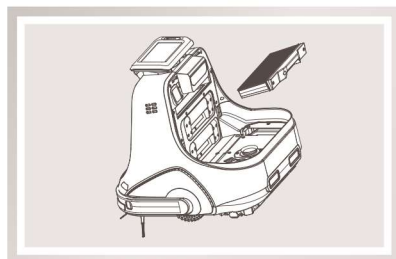
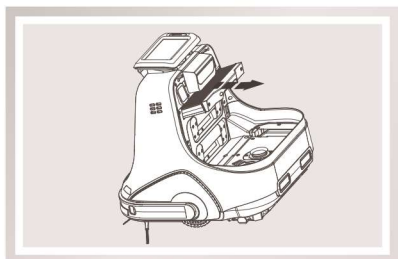

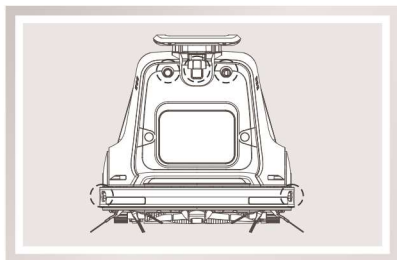
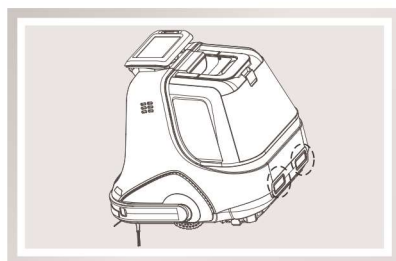
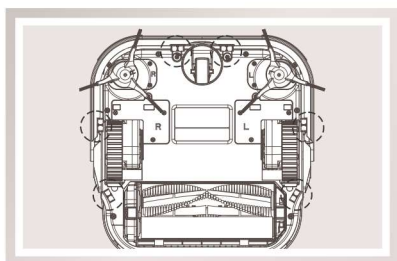
Cliff Sensors and Charging Pins Cleaning

Gently wipe the sensor and battery connector with a cleaning tool, as shown in the picture:

Clean the charging pins in time when there is dust on the cover.
