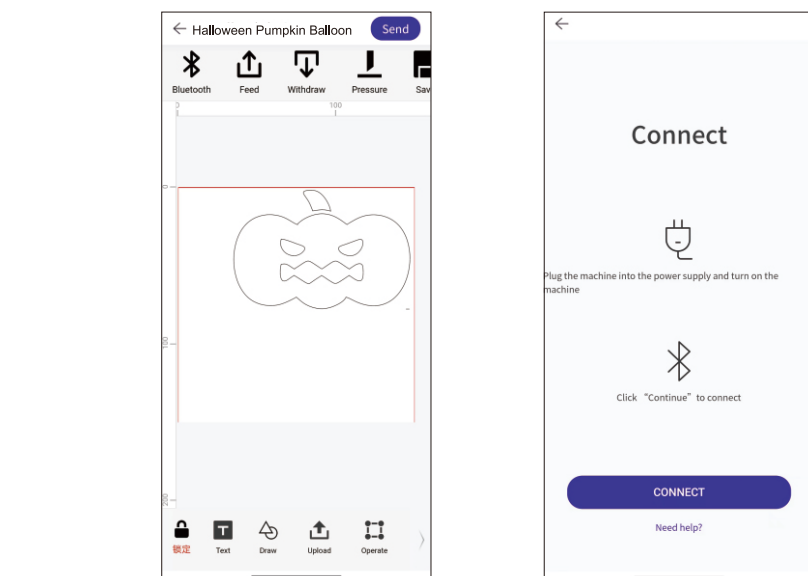
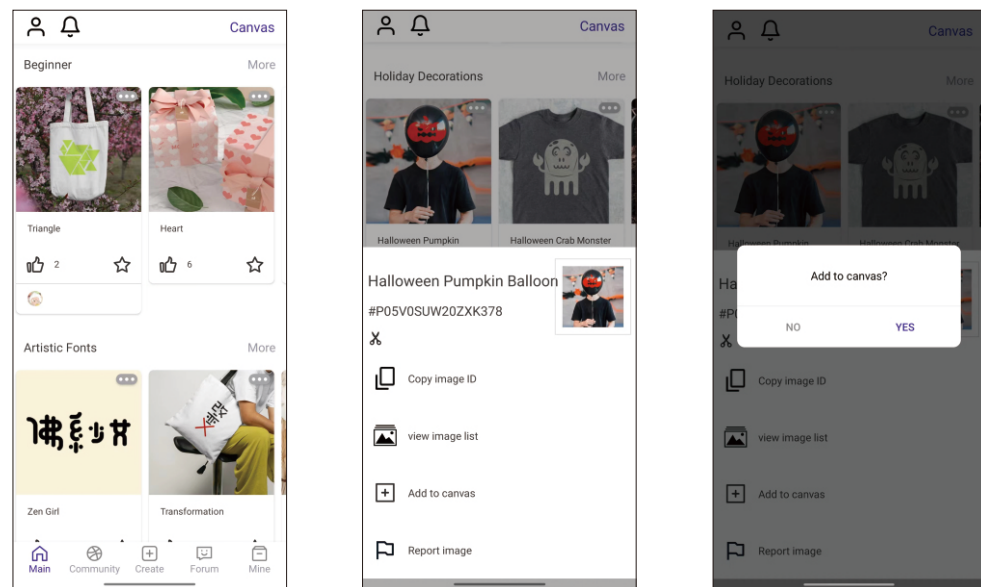
一、Smart Mini requires a Bluetooth connection to a smartphone for operation.

1.Download the Smart Mini app from your phone's app store and complete registration as per the app's instructions.



2.Ensure the machine is plugged into a power outlet; the breathing light will start flashing, indicating successful startup.

3.From the app's main interface, select the cutting project, click to add it to the canvas, and connect the machine's Bluetooth to the canvas.



4.You can now use your Smart Mini.

Using other adapters may pose risks.
