Game Mode:

- Default mode optimized for gaming.
- Tap 3 times on either side to enable 'Game Mode'.

Gestures and Controls:

- Volume Up: Tap, then tap and hold on the right side.
- Volume Down: Tap, then tap and hold on the left side.
- Pause/Play: Tap once to pause or play your audio.
- Additional gestures can be customized through the SOUNDSCAPE app.

Parts of the SANWEAR:

- Ear Tips: Different sizes for optimal fit and comfort.
- Microphone: Built-in microphone for calls and voice commands.
- Sport Hooks: Secure fit during physical activities.
- Charging Pads: Magnetic charging pads for easy and efficient charging.

Adjust the ear tips and sport hooks for the best fitment for your ears.

Light Indicators

Exterior Case Light:

- Pulsing White: Full Charge
- Pulsing Red: Charging

Interior Case Light:

- White: 67-100% Charged
- Blue: 34-66% Charged
- Red: 1-33% Charged

In-Ear Monitor:

- Flash Red + White: Pairing
- Flashing Red: Battery < 20%
- Pulsing Red: Charging
- White: Full Charge

Download the SOUNDSCAPE app to unlock the full potential of your SANWEAR-GT headphones.

Customize your audio experience, enable additional gestures, and access firmware updates through the app.
