恢复出厂设置

常见问题



Power on manually: long press the MFB button about 2 seconds to turn on the earphone. Power on automatically: take the earphone out of the

Turn on the earphone to enter pairing mode. Bluetooth device will search pairing name. Then press pairing name to connect. (If the pairing name can't be found, please turn off your phone's Bluetooth and reconnect). After the first successful connection, the earphone will automatically pairing in next time.

Connect two devices

Connect two devices: First connect the first phone, then turn off the bluetooth of the first phone, then connect the second phone, turn on the first phone bluetooth, the earphone automatically connect the first phone, so that one earphone can be connected to two phones. Reconnect two phones: When the earphone has been connected to two phones, turn on the two phones and the earphone at the same time, the earphone will connect back to the last connected phone, and then connect back to another phone.






- Play/Pause music: Double touch MFB button. Previous Track: Triple touch left MFB button.
- Next Track: Triple touch right MFB button.

Game/Music mode: 4 touch MFB button.

- Volume +: Touch the right MFB button. Volume -: Touch the left MFB button.
- (Answer/Hang up call: Double touch MFB button. Reject Call: Touch MFB button for 2 seconds.
- Voice Assistant: Touch left MFB button for 2 seconds.

Charging instructions Earphones charging:



Charging case charging: Plug the Type-C cable into the

Type-C port of the case. The case indicator light blinks white slowly when charging, the indicator light is steady on white when fully charged.



Unconnected by overtime

The earphone on the pre-pairing status, not connected with device and connecting unsuccessfully in 5 mins, it will turn off automatically.

Bluetooth disconnection

After connecting successfully, if turn off the bluetooth of the phone or exceeds the effective Bluetooth connection distance (no-obstacles environment 10m), the Bluetooth will be disconnected. If the device is not successfully connected within 5 minutes, it will turn off automatically

Restore factory settings

When there is no interconnection between the left and right ears or the device cannot be paired, the following steps can be followed to reset:

Delete the pairing name on the phone first. 2) Take the left ear out off case and touch the MFB button 5 times, the left ear will reset. Putting the left ear back into the case, take the right ear out off case and touch the MFB button 5 times, the left ear will reset. Put the right ear back into the case.

(3) Take out the left and right ears from the case again, Please follow the "Pairing" steps to reconnect.

Common problem

Earphone cannot be turned on: Please check if the earphones have sufficient power. and then charge the earphone for 30 minutes before

- Mobile phone cannot connect to earphones:
- · Make sure your device's Bluetooth is enabled. Make sure the earphone is paired with your device.
- Make sure the earphones are within their normal operating range.
- No sound from earphones: · Make sure the earphones have been turned on and fully
- · Make sure if the volume of the earphones is appropriate. Make sure if the earphones are properly connected to the phone
- Make sure the earphones are within their normal operating range.


