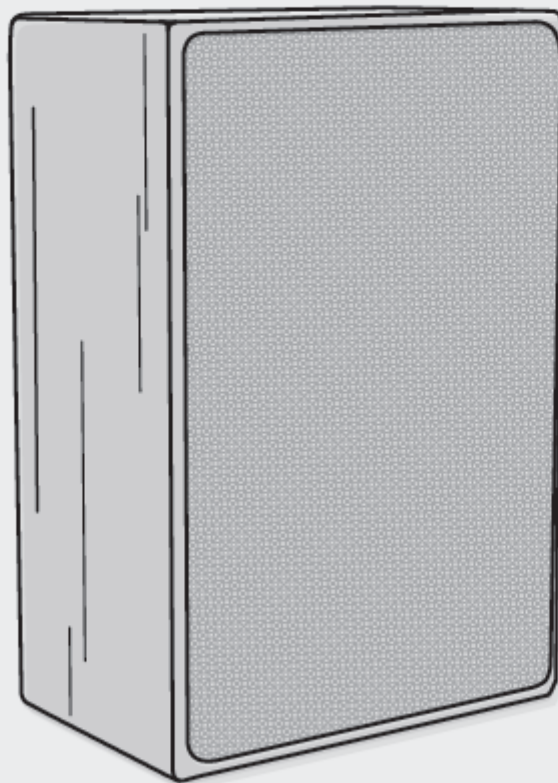

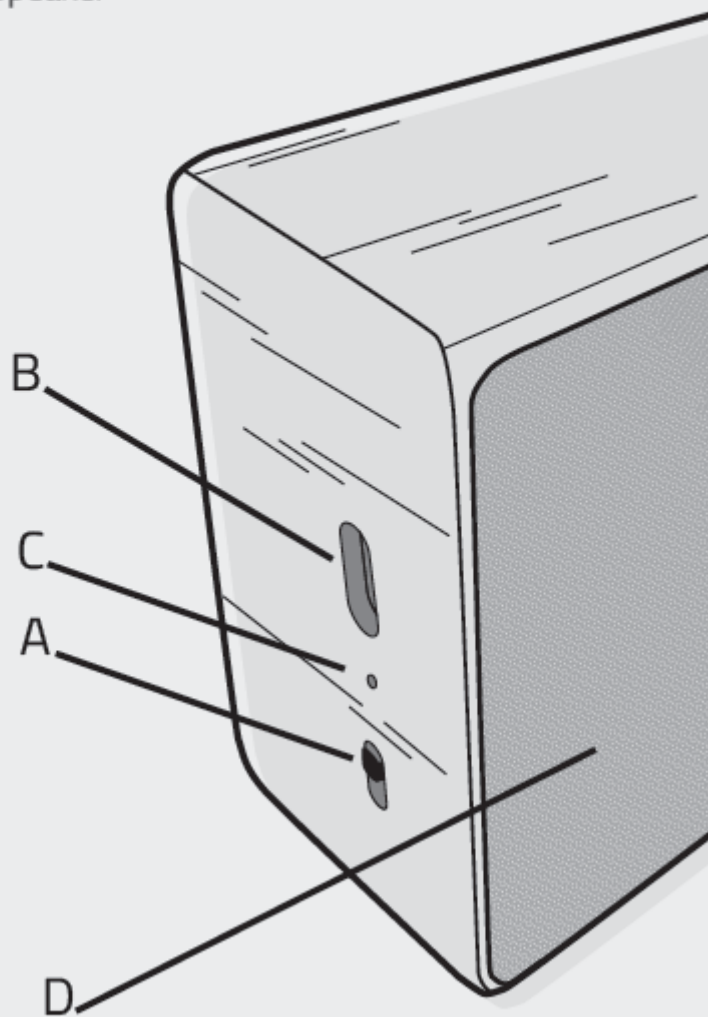

1. Buttons

- A. Switch to turn the device on and off.
- B. TYPE C port: Loudspeaker battery charging port.
- C. LED indicator
- D. Speaker



2. Bluetooth Connection

If this is the first time you are using the loudspeaker, you will need to link it to your mobile device by activating the loudspeaker's Bluetooth mode. Access the Bluetooth mode of your mobile device and search among the available devices for the following: 1249. Select that device, and then the loudspeaker and mobile device will be connected. Once they are connected, the speaker will emit a sound confirming that the connection has taken place. After this first connection, the speaker will automatically connect to your device in subsequent uses.

3. Functions

A. Turning on and off:

To turn on the appliance, slide the on/off button to the ON position and you will hear a confirmation sound. To turn the speaker off, move the button to the OFF position.

NOTE: Pause, play or skip song functions must be activated from your mobile device.

B. Charging

To charge the loudspeaker, connect the USB cable to the computer or to the power supply via an adapter. The other end of the cable must be connected to the Type C port.

4. Warnings

- A. Do not expose the loudspeaker to direct sunlight or close to heat sources.
- B. Keep away from rain or extreme humidity conditions.
- C. Do not use damp cloths to clean them, clean them only with dry cloths.
- D. This product has a lithium battery. Do not dispose of it in a conventional garbage container.
- E. Avoid dropping the device as this could damage it.
- F. In the event the device stops working, we recommend you consult a specialist for repair.
- G. To avoid the risk of short circuit, do not insert metal objects into the loudspeaker slots.

5. Troubleshooting.

Errors	Solutions
The Bluetooth pilot does not turn on.	Recharge the loudspeaker, the battery may be running low. Once recharged, turn it on again.
Audio playback is interrupted intermittently.	Check that the loudspeaker and your mobile device are not too far apart, or that there is no obstacle between the two.
The audio is distorted / the volume is too low.	Recharge the loudspeaker battery and/or check the volume of your mobile device.
Difficulty linking loudspeaker and mobile device.	Turn off loudspeaker and turn it on again. If there are too many Bluetooth devices available, turn them off and try again.
