

Functions

Function	Instructions
Power on/off	Turn the power button to the ON position. The red light at the bottom will flash once and then go out. After the connection is completed, the red light will stay on. The product has a memory function. When it is turned on, it will default to the last mode used.
2.4G wireless reception	The mouse has built-in rechargeable battery, slide the switch to "ON" to turn the device on, insert the mouse receiver into the computer, and ready for use. BT1: Short press the mode button to switch to BT1, the green light of BT1 flashes, long press the mode button for about 2 seconds to enter the quick pairing, select LW-17-BT1 to connect, and the green light goes out after the connection is successful. BT2: Short press the mode button again to switch to BT2, the blue light of BT2 flashes, long press the mode button for about 2 seconds to enter the quick pairing, select LW-17-BT2 and click to connect, and the green light goes out after the connection is successful.
BT mode	

Indicator Light	When charging red light turns on, when fully charged turns off
DPI Button	The resolution ratio is changed with each click on the button between 800-1200-1600DPI
Side key	Up Side key : forward Down Side key : backward After creating a browsing record, press the corresponding key to move forward/backward on the page. This operation only supports local files or operations within the same web page. It is not supported if you go to other links or web pages.
