

Music Wearable Devices Manual

Matters needing attention

1. Please keep away from acidic, alkaline, and pointed items for use and storage
2. Please keep the equipment dry
3. Please keep the equipment clean and add desiccant after use
4. Please take out the headphones before washing
5. Do not disassemble, modify, or modify the equipment separately
6. Do not throw or drop

Charge

Insert the USB port of the micro into the headphones. At this time, the LED light will turn red. When the LED light turns blue, it indicates that the Wireless headphones are fully charged. Please unplug the data cable.

Power on

Press the power button for 2-3 seconds, and the Wireless earphone LED lights will alternately flash red and blue.

Shutdown

In the power on state, press the power on button for 2-3 seconds. When the LED flashes red for 3 times, the red light goes out and the Wireless headphones are turned off. Wireless connection instructions:

Power on and Wireless connection

1. Press the power on button for 2-3 seconds, and the LED lights will alternately flash red and blue. Turn on the mobile phone Blue function and search for the Blue name "Y60" to pair. If the pairing is successful, the blue LED will slowly flash.

Auto pairing

After the first pairing is successful, the next time Wireless headphones and mobile Blue function are used, they will automatically connect without the need to search for a new connection.

Pause and Play

When playing music, pressing the power button once is the pause function, and pressing it again is the play function. When a phone call is made, pressing the power button once is the answer function, and when a phone call is made, pressing the power button once is the end function. Press the "fast forward" button to switch to the next song, and press the "fast rewind" button to switch to the previous song. Long press the "Fast Forward" button to decrease the volume, and long press the "fast rewind" button to increase the volume
