SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Attention! This manual contains important safety measures and correct usage information for the product to prevent accidents. Please read the manual carefully before using the device.

Do not expose to moisture, dust, or high temperatures.

Avoid drops or strong impacts, and do not make violent movements on the screen, as this may cause abnormalities or damage to the screen.

Please select an appropriate volume. If using earphones, the volume should not be too high; if distortion occurs, lower the volume.

Please charge the product under the following conditions:

When the battery icon shows no charge.

The system shuts down automatically and cannot complete startup.

The operation buttons do not respond.

When the device is charging, do not disconnect it suddenly, as this may cause errors.

In cases where the memory is erased due to product damage, repairs, or other reasons, the company is not responsible for its content.

Do not disassemble the product, and do not use alcohol, solvents, or benzene to clean the unit.

The USB is used for data transmission and charging.



USAGE METHOD

Before first use, ensure the device battery is fully charged.

Simply connect the USB interface to charge.

Note: This tablet with a battery uses a standard adapter (Input: 9.0V).

During charging, the battery icon will animate. When charging is complete,

it will indicate 100% and stop animating.

To prolong the product's service life, it is recommended to use up all the battery power before recharging.

Observations:

If you do not use the tablet for an extended period, to avoid damage, please charge and turn it on once a month.

The device should be on standby for normal charging time, as screen usage during operation may cause longer charging time.

To turn on the tablet: Press and hold the button for two seconds.

To turn off the tablet: Press and hold the button for two seconds, then select the "Power Off" option.

To lock: Press the button.

To reset: Press and hold the button for 6 seconds.

To use the device without Wi-Fi: Switch to Airplane Mode.

Go to Settings > Wireless & Networks > Airplane Mode.

To view notifications appearing at the top-left of the screen: Swipe them down.

MAIN INTERFACE DESCRIPTIONOn the home screen, you can:



Manage main interface software icons: Long-press an icon for 3 seconds, then drag it to any part of the interface.

Delete icons: Long-press an icon for 3 seconds, drag it to the trash icon, and release when the trash turns red to delete the icon.

Change the wallpaper: Tap and hold the screen to bring up a dialog box

"Select Wallpaper".

Touch Panel Usage:

Below the main touchscreen area is the status bar, where three main buttons serve as shortcuts.

No matter which interface you are on, you can return to the home screen by pressing the function key.

In different applications, you can return to the previous menu interface. Or, in different applications, tapping the menu key in the upper-right corner of the touchscreen will bring up the settings interface.
