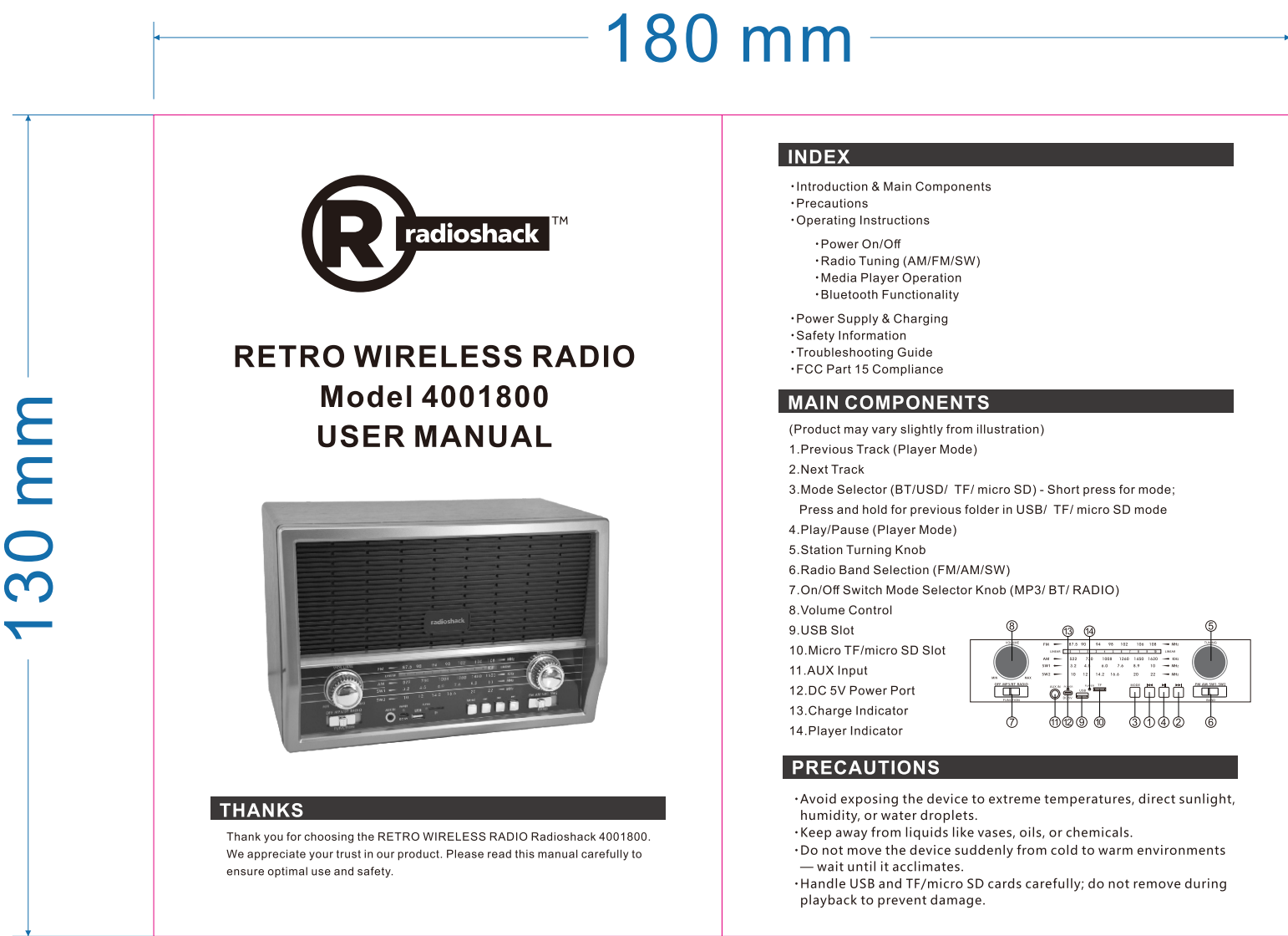


# 双面印刷



## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. ON/OFF Switch**
  - Slide to turn the unit ON or OFF.
  - Select the desired mode: MP3/BT or Radio.
- 2. AM/FM/SW Button**
  - Slide the band switch to select your desired band.
  - FM and SW use a built-in ferrite antenna—rotate for better reception.
- 3. Media Player**
  - Slide the MP3/BT button to switch to media mode.
  - Insert an USB drive or TF/micro SD card with compatible audio files; playback starts automatically.
  - Use NEXT/F.F and PREV/REW buttons to navigate songs.
  - Long press for fast forward or rewind.
  - Adjust volume with the VOLUME knob.
  - Note: Do not remove the USB drive or TF/micro SD during playback.
- 4. Bluetooth Function**
  - Switch to Bluetooth mode by pressing the MODE button until listen "Bluetooth Waiting for pairing" voice prompt.
  - Enable Bluetooth on your device, search, and connect to the device named "4001800"
  - Once connected, the prompt "Bluetooth Connecting" confirms pairing.

## POWER OPERATION

- DC Operation**
- Connect the power adapter to the device and plug into an outlet matching the indicated voltage.
  - For battery recharge, Insert the DC plug into the socket; charging takes about 8 hours.
  - The unit can be used during charging.
  - When the device stops working or the sound disappears, charging is needed.
- Safety Information**
- Avoid exposure to moisture, rain, and direct sunlight.
  - Do not expose to heat sources or high temperatures.
  - Ensure all connections are secure before powering on.
  - Place in well-ventilated areas; avoid placing near curtains, carpets, or in built-in installations.
  - This device contains dangerous voltage — handle with care.

## TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Symptom	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power switch off or faulty power supply	Turn on switch; check power connection, full charge the battery
No sound	Volume too low	Increase the volume
Poor radio reception	Bad antenna orientation	Rotate set for better reception
Bluetooth not pairing	Device not in pairing mode	Enable Bluetooth and pair again; reset device if necessary
Media won't play	Incorrect insertion or unsupported format	Check card insertion and formats supported
Device not responding	connection issue	Power cycle device, reconnect Bluetooth, forget the speaker from Bluetooth list and reconnect again
