**如何使用**

**蓝牙处于断开状态(AUX非插入):**

- 1.长按MFB按钮2秒,直到听到“开机,正在配对”的提示音。
- 2.蓝牙超出距离后,5分钟之内回到有效距离,自动回连。

**关机**

- 1.长按MFB按钮2秒,直到听到“关机”提示音。
- 2.蓝牙状态下无连接时,5分钟后无音频信号接入自动关机;AUX模式下,5分钟后无音频信号接入,自动关机;

**音量+/-**

- 1.顺时针方向增大音量;逆时针方向降低音量
- 2.第一次开机时,默认音量为50%

**充电**

- 1.插入Type-C充电线
- 2.电源状态灯Type-C充电线与DC5V端口连接时,充电时LED灯指示器会变成红色。

**连接的蓝牙和AUX状态下MFB按钮的功能**

- 1.在蓝牙状态下,按一次MFB按钮可以控制音响的播放/暂停功能
- 2.AUX模式下按暂停键为静音
- 3.蓝牙状态下,按MFB键(开机状态)三次,断开蓝牙连接,可以听到“已断连”提示音

**蓝牙/AUX模式切换**

- 1.蓝牙模式插入AUX线,进入AUX模式
- 2.在AUX模式时拔出AUX线,进入蓝牙模式

**如何使用**

**蓝牙处于断开状态(AUX非插入):**

- 1.当蓝牙处于配对状态时,你可以用设备搜索蓝牙名称[Cassette mini]并进行相应的连接,直到成功听到“已连接”提示音。
- 2.如果你想断开蓝牙,当蓝牙处于连接状态(AUX未插入)时,你可以在设备上点击断开操作,直到听到“已断开”的提示音。

**实现TWS串联功能**

- 1.两台音箱同时开机后,双击任意一台音箱的开机键(另一台音箱无需操作),设备将会自动配对,成功后伴随“Duet”提示音。
- 2.当两台音箱连接时,蓝牙清单列表仅会出现一个配对名[Cassette mini]。
- 3.当您无需串联时,三击开机键断开两台音箱连接,伴随提示音“已断开”。

**故障对策**

**没有声音**

- 1.请确认音乐播放器正在工作,音响已确认开机
- 2.请确保您的设备和音响的音乐音量都在可听的水平
- 3.请确保蓝牙已配对,或AUX在两端都正确插入。两种方式的LED灯指示器变成蓝色

**备注**

- 没有电话功能,当有电话来临时,自动停止播放音乐。

How to use

Power on

Press and hold the MFB button for 2 seconds until you hear a “Power on pairing” tone.

Power off

Press and hold the MFB button for 2 seconds until you hear the “Power off” tone.

When there is no connection in the Bluetooth state, it will automatically shut down after 5 minutes;

In the AUX mode, after 5 minutes no audio signal access, it will automatically shut down.

Volume +/-

1. Turn up the volume clockwise; Turn down the volume counterclockwise.

2. For the first time, the default volume is 50%.

Charging

Power status When the Type-C charging cable is connected to the DC 5V port, the LED indicator

will turn red when charging

Function of connected MFB button in Bluetooth and AUX state

1. In the Bluetooth state, press the MFB button once to control the playback/pause function of the stereo.

2. In the AUX status: Press the MFB key is mute status
