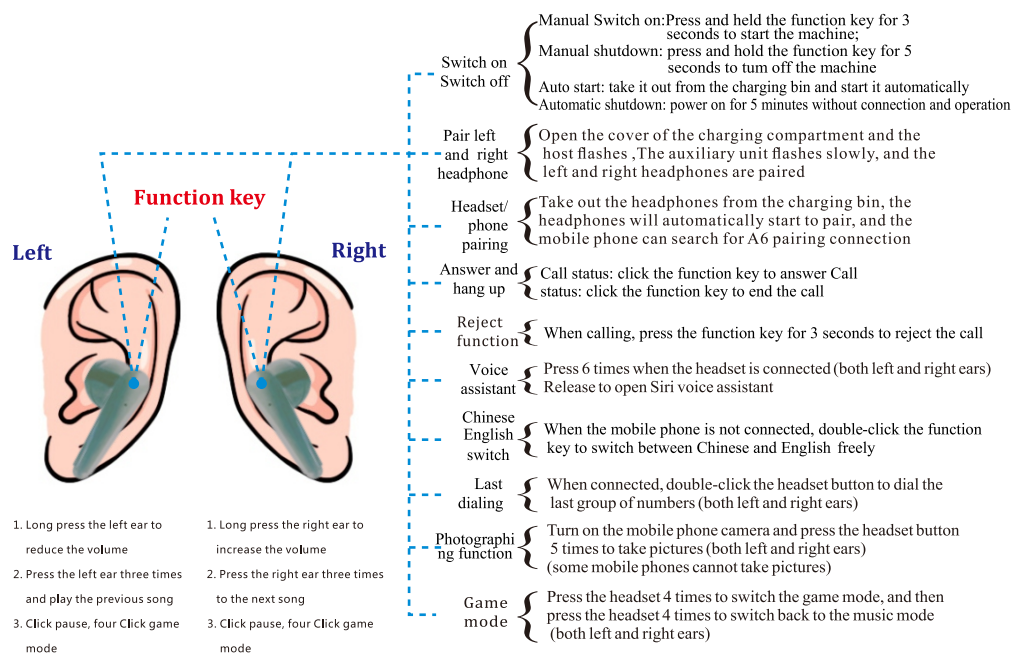

Switch on / off

1. Automatic power on: take out the earphone from the charging chamber to automatically power on.
2. Manual power on: if it is not taken out, press and hold the function key for 3 seconds to start the machine
3. Automatic shutdown: if the headset is not connected within 5 minutes after power on, no operation will occur Power off.
4. Manual shutdown: In the music pause state, long press the function key for 5 seconds to shut down.

Pair

Open the charging bin. After the left and right headphones flash twice and turn to slow flash, the host flashes quickly and the auxiliary flashes slowly. After the left and right headphones are paired, the mobile phone can search for A6 pairing connection.

Answer a call

After the headset and mobile phone are paired successfully, click one of the ears when there is an external call You can answer by pressing the function key.

Reject function

If you don't want to answer the call, long press one of the headset function keys for 3 seconds to reject.

Voice assistant

When the headset is connected, press the function key 6 times (both left and right ears) to open Siri voice assistant.

Last dialing

In the music pause state, double-click the headset button to dial the last group of numbers.

Volume control

1. During listening to music, you can increase the music volume by long pressing the function key of the right headset, as shown in the figure.
2. During listening to music, you can adjust and reduce the music volume by long pressing the function key of the left earphone, as shown in the figure.

Choose last/next music

1. In listening to songs, you can switch to the previous song by three clicking the function key of the left headset, as shown in the figure.
2. In listening to songs, you can switch to the next song by three clicking the function key of the right headset, as shown in the figure.

Chinese English conversion

When the phone is not connected, double-click the function key to freely switch between Chinese and English.

Headset charging

Put the headset into the charging bin and close the cover of the charging bin. At this time, the indicator lights on both sides are on for a long time, and the red light is charging. When the headset is fully charged and the charging indicator is off, it is fully charged.

Charging bin charging

When the charging bin is out of power, the charging indicator flashes slowly, that is, it is necessary to charge the charging bin. When charging, the charging indicator flashes slowly, and the long red light is full.
