Quick Operation Guide

1. Boot to prepare

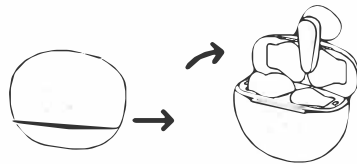


02 Take out the headset



01 Open the charging compartment

2. Turn on the headset



Open the charging compartment, the indicator lights of the headset flash alternately, and automatically pair with each other

3. Headphone pairing

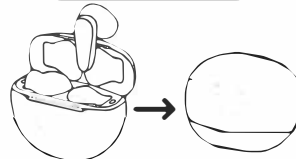


01 Find the W13 from the bluetooth list and click connect



02 The indicator light of the headset flashes during pairing. After the connection is successful, the indicator light will go out and the sound of successful connection will be broadcast.

4. Headphones off



Put the earphone back into the charging compartment and close the cover, it will automatically shut down and charge. The charging compartment on the box, at this time, the display of the charging box lights up Display battery

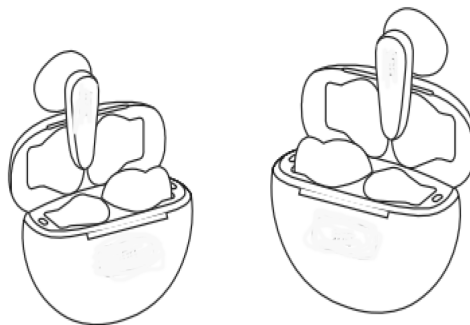

Connect to Bluetooth device

1. Open the charging box, the indicator lights of the earphones flash alternately, and they are automatically paired with each other.
 2. After the pairing is successful, the single indicator light of the headset flashes, turn on the mobile phone or other bluetooth device to search for the bluetooth name, search for the bluetooth headset name W13, and click connect.
 3. After the headset is connected to a mobile phone or a Bluetooth device, the headset indicator will turn off.
- Headphone Operation Function Description

1. When there is a call, touch the left and right earphones to answer the call; touch for one second to reject the call.
2. When playing music, double-click the left ear for the next song, and double-click the earphone for the previous song.
3. When the mobile phone is not connected, triple-click to switch between Chinese and English; after connecting to the mobile phone, triple-click the left ear volume to decrease, and triple-click the right ear volume to increase.
4. Switch between five-click game mode and music mode.
5. Press and hold for 5 seconds to switch the machine.

Headphone battery display

1. When there is no incoming call, press and hold any earphone for 1 second.

After the battery is displayed for 5 seconds, it will automatically turn off.

Description of charging case

1. The earphones are automatically charged in the charging box, and the charging box is attached to the box.
At this time, the display of the charging box lights up to show the power level; the left ear charging shows L, and the right ear charging shows R; it automatically turns off after 10 seconds.
2. Open the charging box, the charging box displays the power.
3. When charging the charging box, the power display is always on.
