Multiple Calendar Views

See your events in a day, week, month, or schedule view by selecting a view in the top left-hand corner of your Calendar. Customize your schedule view in Settings to configure the number of days displayed at a time.



Color Coding

Create categories to organize events by person (ie. Mom's Calendar) or by category (ie. Soccer Practice). Assign labels and colors to each category. Tap an event to reassign its category.



Customizable Lists

Create, view, and customize Shopping, To-do, and Other lists (ie. Packing List). Organize your lists by assigning each list a color. Start by tapping the lists button on the home screen.



Chore Chart

Manage daily chore and task progress for the whole household. Start by tapping the Chore view.

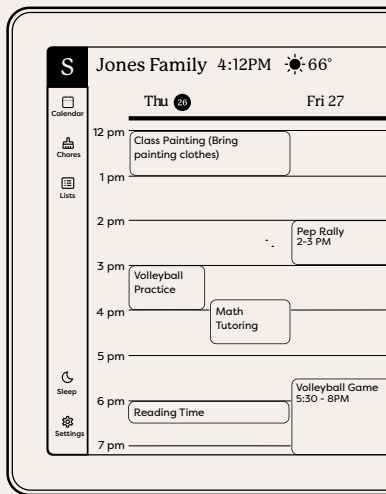

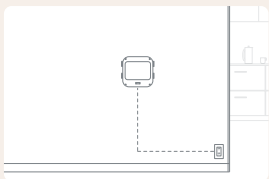


Setup Instructions

Choose a Good Spot for Your Calendar

1. Choose a spot for your mount that is near your outlet.

2. For families with older children or adults, the top of the mount should be positioned at 60" (152cm). For families with younger children, we recommend 48" (122cm).

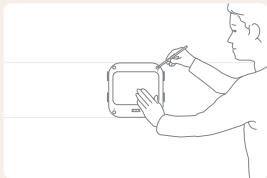


Prepare

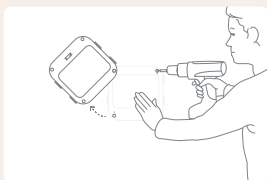
1. Tape the mounting guide to your wall where you want the display mounted, in your preferred orientation. Use the installation guide to align with the center of the sheet.
2. Drill through the guide at the **Hole 1** marker using a 5/16" drill bit then remove the guide from the wall.
3. Insert the wall anchor in the hole you made then attach the mounting bracket with an included screw in **Hole 1**.



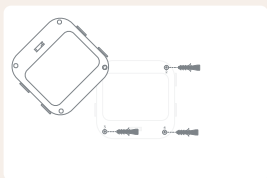
4. Adjust alignment with the built-in level and use a pencil to mark the remaining 3 holes.



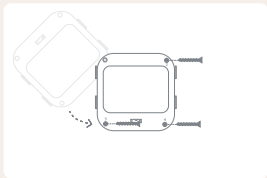
5. Drill holes where the remaining 3 holes should go.



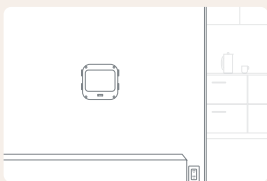
6. Insert the remaining 3 wall anchors in **Holes 2-4**.



7. Install the remaining 3 screws in **Holes 2-4**.



8. Your bracket is now successfully installed.

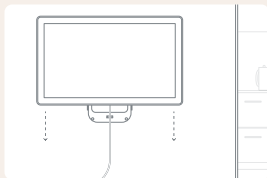
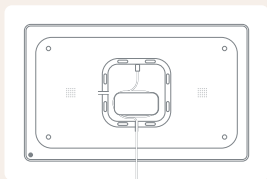

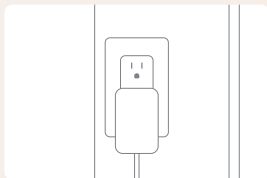


Mount

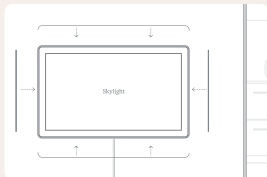
1. Connect the power cable in the back of the device (wind any extra length around cable holder on back of display if needed).
2. Hang back of display over mounting bracket and slide in for safe connection.



- Plug in power adapter
3. to outlet.



4. Attach top frame and side frame segments by allowing magnets to pull in to place.



5. Your Calendar Max is now installed.

Connect to WiFi

1. **Select Your Network**

A list of available WiFi networks will appear on the right side of the screen. Tap to choose your network from the list. Swipe up if the list is long. If your network does not appear, wait for 30 seconds and check once more.

2. **Enter Your Password**

If your WiFi requires a password, a prompt will appear. Type in your password using the onscreen keyboard.

Activate

1. **Create Your Calendar's Email Address**

Download the app or visit **ourskylight.com/finalstep** to make an account and activate your Calendar. Make sure you select Calendar for device type.

2. **Use Your Activation Code**

Once you have created your Calendar's email address, our system will give you a 6-digit code. Enter this code on your Calendar using the on-screen keyboard.

Sync

Sync Online Calendars

Sync your Skylight Calendar with your existing calendars (i.e. Google, Apple, Cozi, Outlook) using your account credentials or the online calendar's public URL in the mobile app or on app.ourskylight.com. Any changes made on your online calendars will automatically reflect on your Skylight Calendar.

If your Google Calendar is synced with 2-Way Sync, changes made on your Skylight will reflect on your Google Calendar.

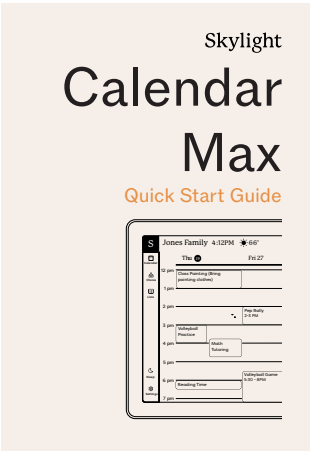

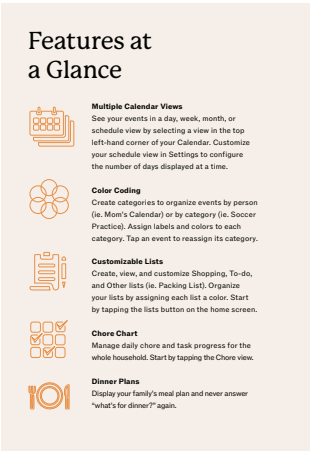

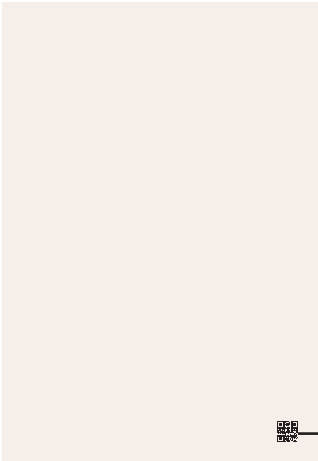
