


This wireless HDMI transmitter and receiver is the perfect solution for seamless connectivity up to 98 feet. Effortlessly stream any video to a larger screen with simple plug-and-play setup. Our 5G technology ensures a smooth streaming experience. 1 receiver can connect up to 8 transmitters.

## WHAT'S IN THE BOX

## When there is a pairing failure or re-pairing, please follow the steps below to pair the device:

1. Connect the transmitter and receiver to the device, and connect the power supply.
2. Press and hold the "Reset" button on the receiver for 3 seconds, the TV will display "Release button to pair with TX".
3. Press and hold the transmitter's "On/Off" button until the indicator light goes out, then release the button, the indicator light will flash rapidly until the pairing is successful.
