① Time and date: displays the current time and date

② Home button: Click to return to the home page

⑧ Car record: click to enter the video recording interface

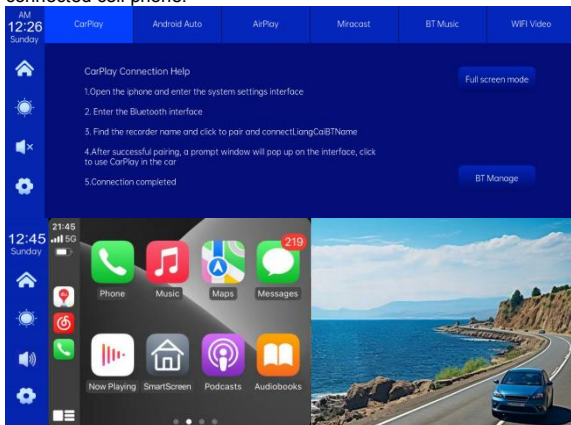

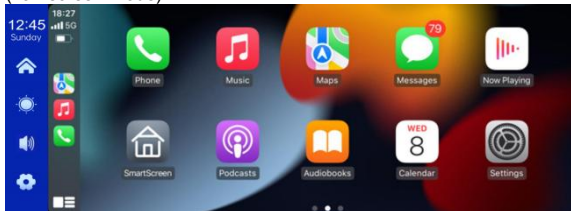
A.CarPlay vs Airplay.



Turn on the Wi-Fi and Bluetooth of your iPhone first, and click the [CarPlay] button to enter the carplay connection. Then select the [CarPlay] option as shown in the picture below, refer to the connection help in the interface, and click the BT Manage in the lower right corner to pair and connect with your phone's Bluetooth to enter the CarPlay CarPlay connection interface. When the machine is powered on, it will automatically connect to the last connected cell phone.

Airplay

For iPhone dedicated mirror casting, tap the Airplay button to enter the interface, refer to the connection help in the interface, and connect your phone to the device's WIFI. after the connection is successful, pull down the phone or tap the hover ball to enter the control center, enter the screen mirroring function, and tap the device name to connect for mirroring casting.

(Note: You can disconnect by turning off the Wi-Fi button on your cell phone, but in cell phone down mode, you need to click on turn off Bluetooth first, then click on turn off WiFi button to disconnect. Carplay, Airplay options only support iPhone, and can not be connected at the same time, you need to choose one of them to connect to use.)

B.Android Auto with Miracast

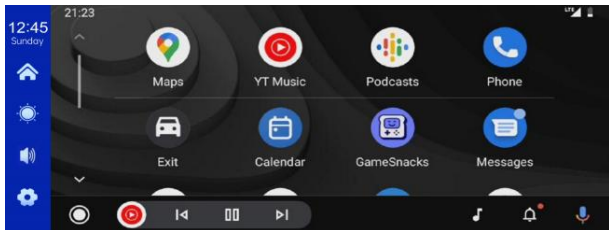


Android Auto

Turn on your Android phone's Wi-Fi and Bluetooth first, then select the Android Auto option to enter the interface for connection help. Tap the BT Manage option on the interface to connect the Bluetooth of the paired phone, and then you can enter the Android Auto Car Connect interface. When you change your phone, the connection data of the previous phone will be cleared.

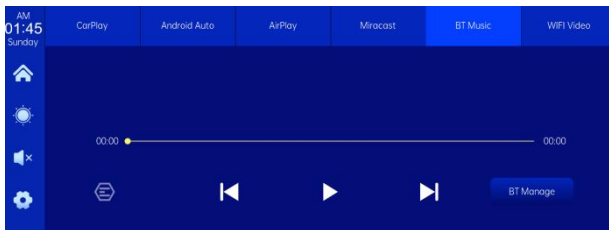


Miracast

For Android dedicated casting, click the Miracast button to enter the interface, check the connection help, and follow the steps to connect your phone to enable mobile casting.

(Note: Turn off your phone's Wi-Fi button to disconnect, Android Auto, Miracast options only support Android phones and can not be connected at the same time, you need to choose one of them to connect to use.)



C.BT music



First turn on your phone's Bluetooth and then select the BT Music option. Click on the BT Manage option on the interface in order to connect your phone's Bluetooth and start playing your phone's Bluetooth music.



The buttons correspond to "Previous", "Play/Pause" and "Next" respectively

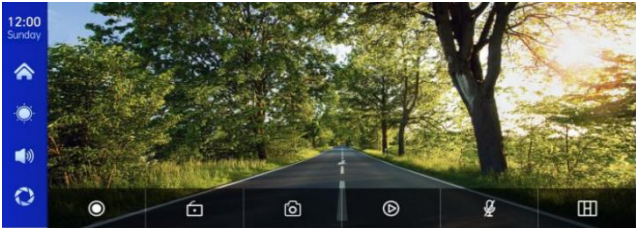
Tap the Lyrics button [] to display the lyrics. Tap [] button to enter the recorder interface.








D. Car record

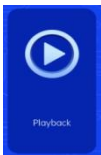


As shown in the picture, click the "Car Record" button to view the camera image. Insert the TF card and start recording normally, "Car Record" will light up red dot.

	<p>Click to lock the video for 1 minute, at this time the video icon turns yellow and the video will not be automatically deleted on a loop.</p>
	<p>Click to take a picture.</p>
	<p>View video replay.</p>
	<p>Turns recording on or off.</p>
	<p>With the rearview camera inserted, click to switch between front and rearview camera distribution.</p>

E. Playback



As shown in the picture, click Playback to enter the video playback interface, you can click the left side to select the desired video file and play the selected video on the right side.

G. WIFI video




Tap WIFI Video to enter the WIFI cell phone interconnection



interface, Scan the QR code of the interface to download the interconnection APP, and check the connection help. When the phone is connected to the device WIFI, the interface pops up a prompt, point to use WIFI. enter APP can be viewed on the phone video preview, recorder files and other operations.

H. Settings



Click the [] button to enter the setting interface

Resolution: 1080P, 2K, 4K optional (different models, options will be slightly different, specific in kind shall prevail)

Recording time: 1 minute, 3 minutes, 5 minutes, video video loop time can be selected.

Recording: You can choose to turn recording off or on.

Auxiliary button: can be turned off or on.

Pull Mirror Back: off (default), on for original image.

Screen saver: The screen saver can be set to: Off (default)/1 minute/2 minutes/3 minutes, the screen will turn off automatically after the time of the saver is selected.

Driving position: left or right hand drive is available

Carplay/Auto screen mode: full screen mode, half screen mode.

Reverse Line Calibration: Adjust the proper reverse line.

Language: SimplifiedChinese/TraditionalChinese/English/Russian/Spanish/French/German/Japanese/Korean.

Time settings: year/month/day/hour/minute, 12H/24H can be set.

Clear Connection History: You can clear the connection history with your cell phone.

Touch Sound Effect: Touch Sound: Off, On (Feedback sound when tapping the screen).

Format : This option will format all the stored data of the TF card, it is recommended to manually format the TFcard when it is first inserted to ensure sufficient card capacity. **(Note: Users are recommended to format the TF card periodically to ensure data security.)**

Restore Factory Settings: Restore to the system default settings.

Firmware Version: Displays the current firmware version.

I. Reverse Line Calibration

Click Reverse Line Calibration to enter settings:

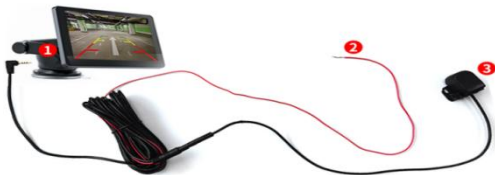


Park the vehicle in the middle of the parking space and manually drag



[] to adjust the position so that the lateral coaxial line and parking line are level with the ground. After adjusting the above lines, click [Return] to confirm.

J.Car HD rear view



- 1、Car Video Player.
- 2、Reverse power cable (connected to the positive pole of the reverse light).
- 3、view head (Recommended to install near the license plate).

Notice

- Please insert the rear view plug into the machine correctly before powering on the machine.
- Do not plug and unplug the rear view head with electricity, or you will lose the signal and even damage the rear view.
- Do not touch the lens with your fingers and clean the lens surface regularly.

unbootable	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Check that the DC power cord is connected correctly and that the plug is not aged or damaged.2. Check if the fuse of the power plug is disconnected or blown.
no response to touch	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Touch is invalid when power on, please wait for normal power on before operation.2. Check if the touch screen is damaged, do not touch the screen with sharp objects, otherwise it will be easily scratched and damaged.
Rearview camera not displaying	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Check that the camera connector is plugged in place.2. Purchase the manufacturer's matching rearview camera before use.
CarPlay won't connect	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. It takes longer to connect for the first time2. Only iPhone supports Carplay.3. Check if your phone's WiFi and Bluetooth function is normal.4. Go to Settings - Clear Connection History, delete all records and reconnect.5. Restart iPhone and reconnect.
Android can't connect	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Only support Android phone.2. Update Auto and related applications on your phone to the latest version.3. Do not enable VPN on your phone.4. Check if your phone's WiFi and Bluetooth functions are normal.5. Restart your Android phone and connect again.
Bluetooth music	Please set the casting mode to Bluetooth music, other modes do not support Bluetooth music.
