01 Connection

a. Open the lid to connect: open the mobile phone or other devices to search for "J13", click on the connection.
b. The left and right earphones can be connected separately.

03 Matching and reset

Take out the headset, touch (L) the left ear under 7 and wait for 3-5 seconds for the pairing of both ears to be successful by flashing the white light (please refer to the following figure for specific operation (L), touch the left and right ear under 8 to reset, turn off the power after the blue light).

a. Headset into the charging compartment headset display light from low to high (L1 to L4 running horse) touch off (said to detect the headset into the compartment), close the lid after the headset long bright blue light and charge, headset fully charged long bright 10 seconds after the white light extinguish light

02 Charge both left and right ears simultaneously

a. Headset into the charging compartment headset display light from low to high (L1 to L4 running horse) touch off (said to detect the headset into the compartment), close the lid after the headset long bright blue light and charge, headset fully charged long bright 10 seconds after the white light extinguish light

03 Charging in the charging compartment

a. Percentage digital display of power level when charging the charging case
b. Percentage digital power display 100 when fully charged

7. Matters needing attention

01 Unilateral headset charging

a. Left headset into charging compartment headset display light from low to high (L1 to L4) is extinguished by touching (indicating that the headset into the charging compartment), the After closing the cover, the headset lights up to indicate that it is charging, indicate charge, headset is fully charged The white light will be on for 10 seconds after the headset is fully charged.

b. Right headset into charging compartment headset display light from low to high (L1 to L4) is extinguished by touching (indicating that the headset into the charging compartment), the After closing the cover, the headset lights up to indicate that it is charging, indicate charge, headset is fully charged The white light will be on for 10 seconds after the headset is fully charged.
