

# JYD-C68 Wireless helmet headphones



## User Manual

### Wireless pairing and search device:



Any changes or modifications not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment. This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:

### Switching Between English and Chinese Voice:

After powering on, when the indicator light is flashing alternately in red and blue, do not connect to your phone. Press the button twice consecutively to switch between Chinese and English voice prompts.

### Simultaneous Connection to Two Phones:

After turning on the JYD-C68 wireless headphones, connect them to phone A first. Then, turn off the Bluetooth on phone A, successfully connecting to B, you can turn on the Bluetooth on phone A again, and the headphones will be connected to both phones simultaneously.

### Product Overview:

JYD-C68 is equipped with the latest 5.4 wireless chip, which uses advanced wireless technology to achieve stereo and powerful performance. It provides excellent transmission, ultra-low power consumption, and compatibility with all wireless devices. The automatic answer function allows you to answer calls without manually picking up the phone, safety and convenience. It also has a 40mm high-quality speaker with a strong magnet, providing excellent audio performance.

### Power On/Off:

Press and hold the power button for two to three seconds to power on. The indicator light will flash alternately in red and blue, indicating the headset is powered on. To power off, press and hold the power button for two to three seconds again. A prompt sound will play, and the light will turn off when the device is powered off.

### Switching automatic answering on/off:

When music is paused, press the button twice. You will hear a "dong" sound, indicating that the setting has been switched.

### Activating the night ambient lighting effect:

After powering on JYD-C68, pressing the button can activate the night ambient light. At this point, the ambient light will stay on constantly, and each press of the button will switch to a different ambient light effect. There are a total of four color modes.

### Answering calls:

Incoming calls will be answered automatically, or you can manually answer by pressing the phone symbol .
