It should beep once to indicate that it is powered on. To power off, hold the same button for at least three seconds. You will hear two beeps to indicate that your Locator is powered off.</p> <p>01.2 Check For Updates: To use the Apple Find My app to locate this item, the latest version of iOS, iPadOS, or macOS is recommended. The Find Items app on Apple Watch requires the latest version of watchOS.</p>	<h3>03 Add your Locator</h3> <p>02.1 Start The App Open Find My app on your supported iPhone.</p> <p>02.2 Connect Your Locator Press the function button around 3 seconds to power on your Locator. Tap+, then "Add Other Item". Once your Locator is located, tap "connect". Enter a name and choose an emoji for your Locator and tap "Continue". Find My will ask for confirmation to add your Locator to your Apple ID. Tap "Agree". Tap "Finish" and your Locator will be set up and ready to be used.</p>	<h3>04 Locate your Locator</h3> <p>03.1 Find Locator When It's Nearby: Open Find My app and select the "Items" tab or open the Find Items app on your Apple Watch. Tap on your Locator from the list. Tap "Play Sound" to make your Locator beep. Tap "Stop Sound" to stop the beeps once you find.</p> <p>03.2 Find Locator Location: Open Find My app and select the "Items" tab or open the Find Items app on your Apple Watch. Tap on your Locator from the list. Your Locator location will appear on the Map with a time stamp of when the item was located. To navigate to the Locator location, tap "Directions" to open Apple Maps.</p>	<h3>05 Notifications</h3> <p>04.1 Enabling "Notify When Left Behind": Open Find My app and select the "Items" tab or open the Find Items app on your Apple Watch. Tap on your Locator from the list. Under "Notifications" enable the "Notify When Left Behind" toggle. You will receive a notification when you leave your Locator behind and it's no longer in range of your device.</p> <p>04.2 Enabling "Notify When Found": Under "Notifications", enable the "Notify When Found" toggle. When your Locator is seen by another Find My network device, you will receive a notification of its location. Note: "Notify When Found" can only be activated when your Locator is out of range.</p>

<h3>05 When your Locator is lost</h3> <p>05.1 Enabling "Lost Mode": Open Find My app and select the "Items" tab or open the Find Items app on your Apple Watch. Tap on your Locator from the list. Under "Lost Mode" tap "Enable". A screen detailing Lost Mode will pop up, tap "Continue". Enter your phone number or email address and tap "Next". You may enter a message that will be shared with the person that finds your item. Tap "Activate" to enable "Lost Mode". Note: When "Lost Mode" is enabled, "Notify When Found" is automatically enabled. Note: When "Lost Mode" is enabled, your Locator is locked and cannot be paired to a new device.</p>	<h3>06 Resetting Locator</h3> <p>06.1 Remove The Locator From Find My App: Open Find My app and select the "Items" tab. Tap on your Locator from the list. Please ensure "Lost Mode" is disabled. Scroll to the bottom of the screen and tap "Remove Item". A summary will open, tap "Remove" to confirm.</p> <p>06.2 Factory Reset Your Locator: After successfully removing the Locator from Find My app, press the Locator function button four times rapidly and then hold it a fifth time until you hear a ringing chime. The Locator is now reset and ready to be paired to a new Apple ID.</p>	<h3>07 Extras</h3> <p>07.1 Unwanted tracking: If any Find My network accessory separated from its owner is seen moving with you over time, you'll be notified in one of two ways: 1. If you have an iPhone, iPad, Find My will send a notification to your Apple device. This feature is available on iOS or iPadOS 14.5 or later. 2. If you don't have an iPhone or a smartphone, a Find My network accessory that isn't with its owner for a period of time will emit a sound when it's moved. These features were created specifically to discourage people from trying to track you without your knowledge.</p>	<h3>08 FCC Statement</h3> <p>This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules.
