Kontur, AS (“Kontur”), by and through its undersigned counsel, respectfully submits this letter to notify the Commission that Kontur is the successor-in-interest to the CWCI Waiver<sup>1</sup> and CWCI Modified Waiver<sup>2</sup> previously granted to Curtiss-Wright Controls Inc. (“CWCI”) and its former subsidiary, 3D-Radar, AS (“3D-Radar”). The FCC granted the CWCI Waiver and CWCI Modified Waiver for the benefit of CWCI’s subsidiary it held at the time, 3D-Radar. 3D-Radar has since been sold and changed its name to Kontur. Kontur is now the successor-in-interest to the waivers granted for the benefit of 3D-Radar under the CWCI Waiver and CWCI Modified Waiver.
