
Device Overview





How to use the Smart Scale

- . Place the scale near where you finish packing orders or seal the bag before handing off orders to Dashers.
- 2. Weighing the order should be the last step once it's all packed up.
- 3. Before you seal the bag, select the order on the tablet and weigh the order to confirm it is correct.
- 4. If something is thought to be missing, double-check the contents of the bag and re-weigh the order once you have added the item.
- 5. When the scale has confirmed the weight of the order, the order will be marked as ready for pickup.





Unboxing the Smart Scale


- 1. Remove all the components from the box.
- 2. Place the scale with its flat surface facing down on a stable surface. Plug the right angle Type-C end of the long black cable into the bottom of the scale. Connect the other end of this cord to the tablet in a future step.



3. Place the tablet with the flat side on a clean and stable surface. Open the stand to an upright position to gain access to the hub slot.




4. Slide the hub into the slot available at the back of the tablet in a top-down direction. Once locked in place, use the L-Key provided to tighten the captive fastener and secure the hub.





5. Turn the tablet and stand over such that "This side up, Insert this way" is facing you. Now, slowly slide the stand into the slot available at the bottom of the scale.

Note: You can choose the short side or long side slot based on your requirements.




- 6. Press and hold the power button of the tablet for 4 seconds until the device turns on and vibrates. When you see the lock screen with the time and date, swipe up on the screen.
- 7. The hub has 3 USB Type-C ports:
 - a. Connect the Type-C end of the cable to the bottom of the hub and the Type-A end of the cable into the adapter. Connect the adapter into an available mains outlet. The LED indicator on the hub will turn Green once connected to a power source. For best performance, ensure the device is always plugged in.
 - b. Connect one end of the Type-C black cable to the left USB port of the hub, and the other end into the tablet's USB port. Check the tablet, the charging icon should be visible on the screen.
 - c. Insert the other end of the Type-C cable from Step 2 into the right USB port of the hub.

- 8. Once you have connected all the cables, adjust the tablet to a comfortable viewing angle.
- 9. Place the top plate on the scale to complete the assembly. The scale will automatically update to the latest software. **Note:** While that's happening, make sure that no items are touching the scale, and it's pulled slightly back from any walls to ensure accurate measurements are made.
- 10. Press Calibrate. With that, your smart scale is all set and ready to use
