The thickness of the headphones has been reduced by over 25% compared to the old model, bringing a more comfortable experience.

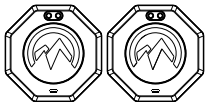
It is equipped with a storage case that can be used as a wireless charging base and has become much more convenient to use. Provide strong protection to the headphones.

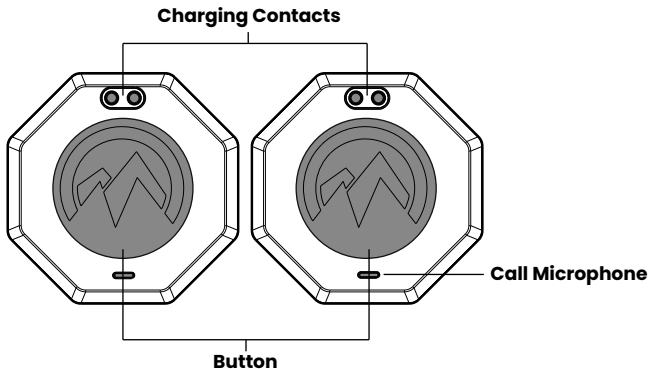
Quick Start

- 1-** Open the storage case cover (the headset can only enter Bluetooth pairing mode when the cover is open).
- 2-** Press and hold the button on the front of the storage case for 5 seconds.
- 3-** The indicator light on the headphones flashes blue quickly and enters Bluetooth pairing mode.
- 4-** Select "OM MZ04m" on your mobile phone or other device you want to use for pairing.
- 5-** The indicator light on the headset slowly flashes blue, indicating successful pairing.
- 6-** Now you can use OM-MZ04m to play music or make calls!

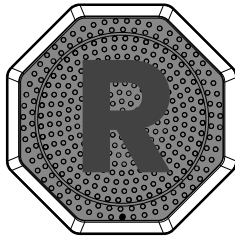
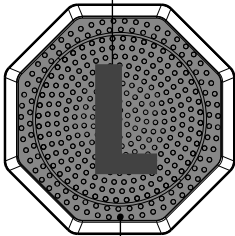

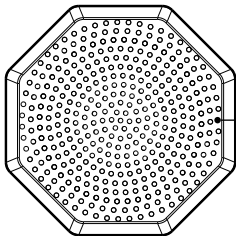


Horn Sounding Surface

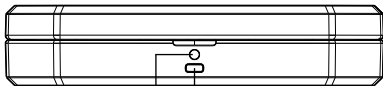

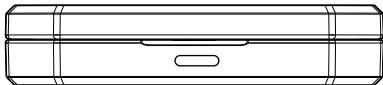

Storage Case Operating Instructions

Short press once and the indicator light when they are placed correctly in the storage case.

Open the cover, long press for 5 seconds, the headphone will be disconnected when paired, and enters the pairing mode. (The headphones need to be placed correctly in the Storage Case)

Storage Case Indicator Description

The indicator light will indicate the battery level of the headphones, and it will work only When the headphones are placed correctly in the storage case. Besides, the indicator light will indicate the battery level of the storage case when the storage case is empty.

Green light	Over 70% of battery level
Orange light	Battery level between 20% and 70%
Red light	Battery level below 20%
