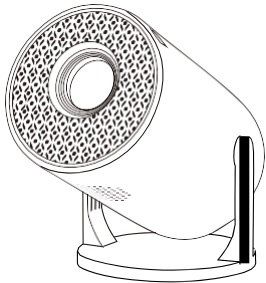
- 1. Blurry Image**

* Do not coverIR receiver.
- 3.Mobile Connection**
Please try to use the original data cable of themobile phone for connection.
- 4.Up Side DownImages**
Enter"Menu" on projector orremote to flip the projection image.

Instructions for simultaneous screen operation:
Android system: Turn on Wi-Fi, turn on wireless screen mirroring to search for signals starting with "HC", click to connect.
iOS system: Connect to Wi-Fi starting with "HCcast", then turn on screen mirroring on your phone.

Instructions screen mirroring:
Regardless of Android or iOS system, you need to connect the projector to Wi-Fi first:
Connect to Wi-Fi starting with "HCcast" then scan the QR code to enter the interface.Click on the Wi-Fi icon, click "SCAN", then select the Wi-Fi you need to connect to enter the password to connect, then exit and connect your phone and projector to the same Wi-Fi.

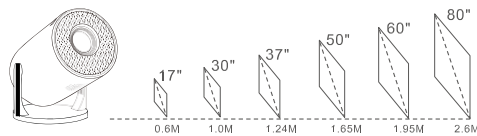
