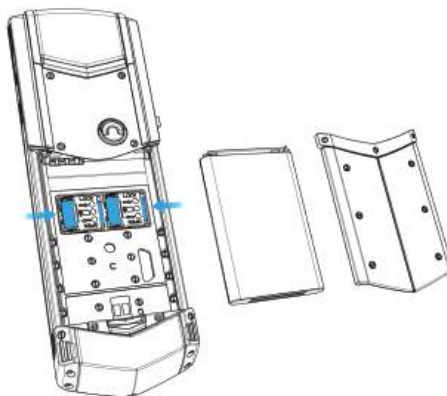
Insert the SIM card

Nano-SIM card is used on the SIGNATURE S+



CAUTION! Do not attempt to insert different sizes of SIM card. Using an incompatible card may damage the card slot and device. Follow these steps below carefully;

1. The back of the phone is designed with a D-shaped ring shaped battery cover switch. Rotate the D-shaped ring upwards to pop out the battery cover, and then remove the battery.



2. According to the card slot markings, open the metal cover of the card slot, insert Nano SIM into the card slot, and finally lock the metal cover of the card slot.

Charge the battery

It is recommended to charge the battery before use since the battery pack is not fully charged.



CAUTION! Only use the charger, cable and accessories of SIGNATURE S+ device. If your device shows low battery, follow these steps below:

1. Connect the USB Type-C cable that comes with your device to Type-C port on the side of your device. Then connect the other end of the cable to the USB port in the SIGNATURE S+ charger.



2. After the battery is fully charged, disconnect the Type-C cable from the device, then unplug the charger from the outlet.

Notes: | It is not recommended to use your device while charging.

| If your device does not respond when you press the power key, it indicates the battery is exhausted. Use the original charger to charge your device for at least 10 minutes before starting.

| For a lower battery, you will be prompted to charge soon. To prevent your phone from powering off automatically due to insufficient battery, charge your device as soon as possible.

Battery Saver

If the battery is low and you are unable to charge your device soon, you can use "Battery Saver". Battery Saver limits power use to improve battery life. App activities in background will be limited when using Battery Saver.

To activate Battery Saver, please select Settings > Battery > Battery saver.

Turn Your Device On/Off

Power On: Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to activate the restart interface.

Power Off: Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to activate the shutdown interface.

If your phone stops responding, please restart it. To restart, press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to force the phone to shut down, then press and hold the power button again for 3 seconds to restart.

Note: Before removing and installing your SIM card, power off your device. This makes sure your cards stay safe and network connection recovers soon.

Unlock Your Screen

To unlock your screen, press the power key. You can press the power key to lock screen. The screen locks itself after a while.

Input method

Enter content

When the blue cursor is flashing in the input field

1. Please confirm if the icon shows in the status bar is for the language you want to use.
2. If language is selected properly, you can enter directly with the key; If the current language is not what you want, please press * to switch to the language or number you want to use; If the required language is not within the scope of current selection, please press and hold # key > select Input method settings > select Multilingual support, check the language you need to use in the language list, then get back to the enter box page for input.
3. If the selected language supports case switching, please press # key to switch between all upper case, all lower case or first letter capitalization.

Enter symbols

When the blue cursor is flashing in the input field, then symbols can be entered.

1. If you need to enter symbols or special punctuations, please press and hold # key.
2. After selecting the symbols you want to use in the symbol box, press OK to enter.
3. You can also press 1 on the keypad, and in the resulting symbol box, press 4 way navi key to select the needed symbol, press OK to enter.

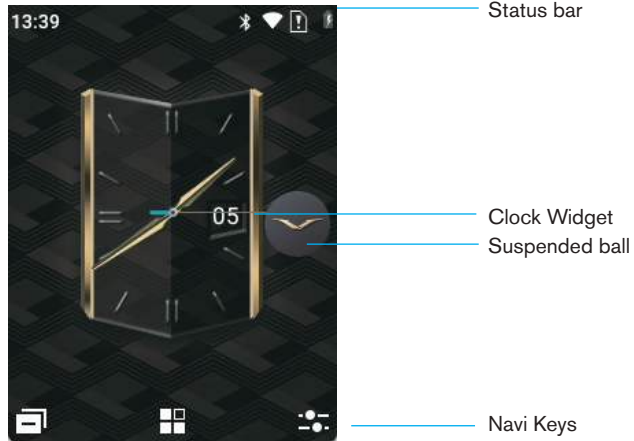

Home Screen

About Home Screen

Home Screen is the starting point for many applications and features. It allows you access new messages:



Notification bar and status bar

Battery level identification displays at the top right of the screen.

Cell signal displays at the top right of the screen.

Time displays at the top left of the screen.

To view Notifications, please press Send key to select notification to open it.

To make a quick change to the Aeroplane mode, Ring, Battery Saver and Bluetooth status, please press End key to open the Shortcut.

Shortcut

Aeroplane mode

To open quickly, please enter shortcut key and choose Aeroplane mode, then it can turned on or turned off quickly.

Ring

To modify the sound status, please enter shortcut key and ring, vibration or mute can be selected quickly.
On the home screen, long press # key to quickly enable vibrate on, mute on or mute off.

Battery Saver

To open quickly, please enter shortcut key and choose Battery Saver, then it can turned on or turned off quickly.

Bluetooth

To open quickly, please enter shortcut key and choose Bluetooth, then it can turned on or turned off quickly.

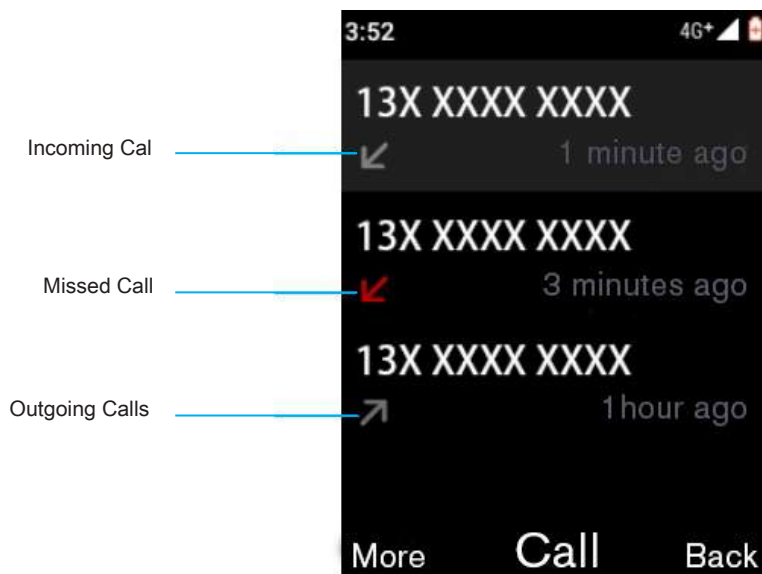

Take phone number as an example



Make and answer a phone call

To make a call:

1. After unlocking, on the home screen or app list page, press numeric keys to enter the mobile number you want call; or on any page, you can also press call key to enter the call history page, select the number you want to call back.
2. To dial the number, please press call or Call key.
Note that if you want to type + symbol to make an International call, press the * key.
3. To end a call, press Hang up key.
4. To make a call to the VIP hotline, double-click the power button.

To answer the incoming call, please press Answer or call key.

To reject the incoming call, please press End or Hang up key.

To make Message Reply to the caller, tap the message and choose one of text messages.

To mute an incoming call, press the volume keys.

Dial the Recent Calls

Call back the recent caller: press call key and choose the contact to call back directly.

To clear call history list, press More > Settings > Clear call history.

Call Blocking

You can block mobile numbers and text messages that you do not want to receive.

1. Press call key > More > Settings > Call Blocking.
2. ADD A NUMBER and press Block, then you can block calls or texts from this number.

AI voice assistant

AI Suspended ball

Open the AI floating ball suspended on the right side of the phone screen, click the voice icon to have a voice call with the AI, click the conversation icon to have a conversation and interaction with the AI, and click the screenshot icon Can perform screenshot image analysis with AI.

AI Phone

To set up AI call translation, you can click to switch languages. During AI calls, you can expand the call details pop-up window to display real-time translation. If the other party uses English during the call, it can be done through Enable this feature to translate the other party's voice into Chinese in real-time.

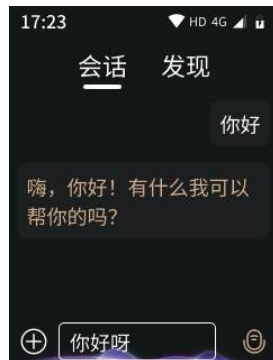

2. View satellite signals in the status bar;

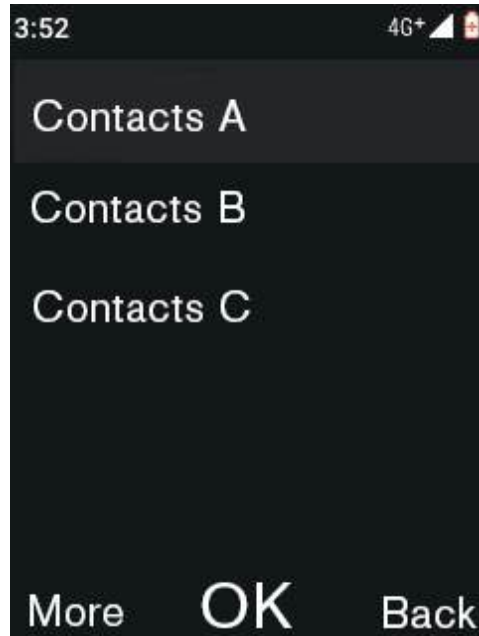


3. When the signal strength is confirmed to be good, enter the dial pad to make a call;

About contacts



Calling, sending text messages to contacts

To call a contact, please select the contact and tap Confirm > Call.

To send text messages to the contact, please select the contact and then tap Confirm > More > Send message.

Create contact

1. Select More > New Contact.
2. Enter contact details, then select More > Save.



Tips: select More > Favorite Contacts to add the contact to the Favorite.

Edit or delete contacts

There are two ways to edit a contact:

- | Select the contact you want to edit, and then select More > Edit.

To delete a contact:

- | Select the contact you want to delete, and then select More > Delete.

Saving a Mobile Number from a Received Call or Message

If you receive a call or message from an unsaved number, you may add the number to contacts. To save a mobile number from a received call:

1. Press call key.
2. Select the number you want to save, and then press More.
3. Select Add to contacts.

To save a message number:

1. Open the message interface.
2. Select the messages you want to save.
3. Select More > Add to contacts.

Messages

Send and Read Messages

To send a message:

1. Select More > New. Enter a recipient and type your message.

Note: If you want to send a message to more than one recipient, add more than one contact in the recipient.

2. Select More > Send.

To open text message and previous conversations, please select this conversion.

To reply to a text message, open it and type your reply in the text-entry field and select More > Send.

Manage Messages

To delete messages, please select the message you want to delete, and then select More > Delete.

To Edit Message Signature, add or modify the Message Templates, please select More > Settings.

Music

Getting music

Transfer the music or other audio contents to the phone, to immerse yourself in music.

Playing music

Select the music you want to play, then select Play to start playing music.

Music player controlling

- | Select Play or Pause to control music.
- | Select previous or next song: press the left or right Navi key briefly. Fast forward or fast backward: press and hold the left or right Navi key.
- | Select play mode: select More to set Sequential play, Random play or Single cycle.
- | Adjust volume: press on the volume key on the side of phone.
- | Delete songs: In music library, select the song you want delete, then select More > Delete, then select Delete.

Clear all

Select Clear all to release phone's running memory, making your device running in best status.

On the Home screen, press and hold * key to launch Clear all, making your device optimized in one button.

Settings

Internet connection

Wi-Fi

A Wi-Fi network connection provides you with faster Internet connections and smoother web browsing.

To connect to Wi-Fi:

1. Settings > Internet connection.
2. Select Wi-Fi, move the Wi-Fi slider to right to turn it on.
3. Select the network in the list, and then select the network you want to connect to. You may need to enter the network password.

When your phone is connected to the Internet, Wi-Fi connected icon displays in the status bar  .

Hotspot & tethering

Settings > Internet connection > Hotspot & tethering.

To turn on Wi-Fi hotspot, please go to Wi-Fi hotspot, move the Wi-Fi hotspot slider to right.

Go to Wi-Fi hotspot to make detailed settings to Hotspot name, Security, Hotspot password and Turn off hotspot automatically.

You can also set USB tethering, Bluetooth tethering in the Hotspot & tethering.

You can also turn on or turn off Aeroplane and OTG features in Internet connection.

Bluetooth

Bluetooth allows you to connect wirelessly to other compatible devices, for example mobile phone, computer, headset and car kits. With Bluetooth, you can transfer contents from your device, or transfer files from a compatible computer. To connect to a new Bluetooth-enabled device:

1. Make sure the Bluetooth device to pair discoverable.
2. Settings > Bluetooth.
3. Move the Bluetooth slider to right to turn it on.
4. Select pair with the new device to connect to the device you want to pair, you will need the pairing code to make connection. When the Bluetooth is on, the Bluetooth icon  displays in the status bar.



Tips: Turn the Bluetooth off to save power when you are not using it.



Caution! Obey all local laws and regulations. Both hands shall always remain free in driving, in order to operate the vehicle. Road safety always comes first.

To change the device name:

1. Settings > Bluetooth. Move the Bluetooth slider to right to turn it on.
2. Select Pair new device > Device name.
3. Enter the new name and select Rename.

You can select received files in the Bluetooth interface to view the files received by Bluetooth. Select the files you want delete, and then select More > Delete to delete them from list.

Sound

Settings > Sound.

Select Volume, then you can move the sound slider to left or right to adjust Media volume, Call volume, Ring volume and Alarm volume.

To set Also vibrate for calls, swipe the slider of Also vibrate for calls right to turn it on. You can also set Ringtone, Screen-locking sounds, Key tone.

Display

Settings > Display.

Brightness level

You can move the brightness slider with the left or right key to adjust the screen brightness.

Sleep

You can set the duration of inactivity after which the screen will lock automatically.

Themes

You can set the style of the system display.

Wallpaper

You can set Home Screen Wallpaper and Screen Lock Wallpaper.

Dual clock

You can set the Time zone for home, so you can see two clocks on the home screen when roaming.

Buttons

Settings > Buttons

You can set the shortcuts of the Right function key and 4 way Navi key based on your own use preference.

Battery

Settings > Battery

You can view Remaining battery, Last full charge and Screen usage since full charge.

You can also open battery saver in Battery Saver or set it to open automatically.

Storage

Setting > Storage

You can view the usage of storage and memory.

Security

Settings > Security

You can lock the screen when it is in hibernation. It is recommended that you set a screen lock password to protect your phone and data.

You can set a PIN code to unlock the screen in the screen locking, and also set if you want to lock the SIM card in SIM card locking.

Location

Settings > Location

When Use location is enabled, it will allow access to your phone's geographic location via Wi-Fi or mobile data.

System

Settings > System.

You can set Languages & input, Date & time.

You can reset network, applications and device in the Reset options.

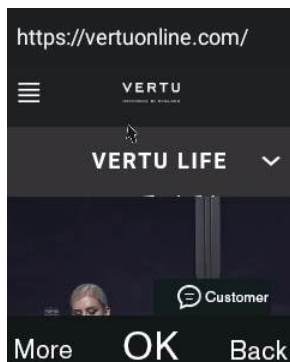
You can view Device name, All parameters, Status, Legal information, Supervision information in About phone.

To check for the update of the phone, please Check for Updates in System updates. You can also set system updates, view update tips and current version.

Browser

About browser

To browser web page via phone, you need connect your phone to the mobile data or Wi-Fi network.



To visit website, please select More > Enter URL > Ok.

Connect to the Internet

Your phone will use mobile data or Wi-Fi network connection to access the Internet.

Note: Please confirm with your network service supplier for data pan. Connecting to the Internet or downloading data via mobile data may be charged.

To enjoy faster network access experience via Wi-Fi network, please go to Settings > Network connection > Wi-Fi, and then select the network you want to connect to.

To exit from browser, please select Back.

Note: if you can't access the Internet, please contact the network service supplier.

Tips: when browsing the website from browser, please move the mouse cursor on the web page to make selection and clicking operations. The display of web page will be equally scaling according to the screen size. You may not get the best browsing experience on some websites due to the limit of screen display. Contents downloaded from browser need to be viewed under the relevant directory of file management app.

Privacy and Security

To adjust your privacy and security settings, please select More > Settings > Privacy & security.

To clear cache, please tap to select More > Settings > Privacy & security, then select Clear cache.

Accessibility

To set the text scaling factor and lower limit of text size, please select More > Settings > Accessibility.

Bandwidth management

To set search result preloading and load images, please select More > Settings > Bandwidth management, you can set it to Never, Only on Wi-Fi, Always.

Frequently Used Tools

Calculator

Press standard 12 numeric keys and 4 way Navi key to use calculator.

Sound Recorder

This device offers long-time recording function, please ensure that there is enough storage space in your phone.
To record sound, please go to Recorder.

Select Start to start recording.

Select Pause to pause recording.

Select Stop to save or discard recording.

Select More to view the recording list, select to open recording files to play.

On the page of recording list, select More to rename or delete the recording files.

Calendar

To create new event:

1. Select More > New event.
2. Enter the event name, then set the start date, start time, repetition, add reminder.
3. Select Save.

To delete event:

You can delete event in the following way: select the event you want to delete, and then select More > Delete.

Alarm

To activate the alarm clock, swipe the switch button to right.

To add an alarm, please select More > Add Alarm, then enter the alarm details, and you can also set Repeat, Alarm Ringtone, Vibrate of the alarm.

Select any alarm in the Alarms list, then select More > Edit Alarm to enter the Edit alarm interface, to change the alarm ringtone or other settings.

To change settings that affect all alarms, please select More > Settings to change Silence after or Snooze length.

When the alarm sounds, select Off to close the alarm clock; or select Pause to delay alarm clock.

File manager

File manager is like a private assistant that you can carry with you, with which you can manage the files and folders, view the documents stored in the phone. Or you can view different types of menu files per the way of browsing by category.

All Files

To view all files, please select All files to view all kinds of files that have been categorized.

To rename files, please select All Files, and then select the file you want to rename. Then select More > Rename, enter the new name and select OK.

How to extend the battery life of mobile phone?

- | Lower the brightness of screen option. Select Settings > Display.
- | Turn off Wi-Fi and data transferring in the background. Select Settings > Network connection, then move the sliders in the mobile data enabling and Wi-Fi enabling to the left to close them.
- | Turn off the option for connecting Bluetooth. To make a quick adjustment to the settings, please enter shortcuts and select Bluetooth.
- | Whenever possible, use Wi-Fi to process data, rather than mobile phone services.
- | Extend the battery life by limiting the power consumption of mobile phone. Enter Shortcut > Battery Saver. Once enabled, phone performance will be degraded slightly and app activities in the background will be limited.

How to transfer the music in computer to mobile phone?

When connecting the mobile phone to computer for the first time, the computer may prompt that you are installing the driver.

1. Connect the Type-C port on the mobile to USB port on computer, using Type-C data cable.
2. Press Send key on the home screen to select notifications, select Charging this device via USB in the notification list, then enter the page of Connection Type. Remember to choose (MTP) connection.
3. In the computer, find "SIGNATURE S+" which is on behalf of phone storage and open it.
4. Copy files between your computer and Music folder.
5. After finished, disconnect USB connection.

How to check for latest system updates in mobile phone?

To check if your mobile phone has installed the latest system, please connect your phone to mobile network (Connecting to the Wi-Fi is recommended) and then select Settings > System > System Updates > Check for Updates.

Why is there no network connection for mobile phone?

If you lost the network connection, check the network's signal strength at top right corner of phone screen. You are probably located in weak network coverage. If this question persists, please contact network service supplier.

If you lost Wi-Fi connection, check the Wi-Fi status identification at top of phone screen, to check the strength of connection. You are probably out of the range of network coverage. To scan Wi-Fi network, please select Settings > network connection > Wi-Fi. Move the Wi-Fi slider to right to turn it on. Select the network in the list, and then select OK. You may need to type in the password. For details, contact the network manager.

After the mobile phone is connected, the status bar will show Wi-Fi indicating identification.

Why is the storage space in my phone less than that mentioned in the advertising?

This is probably due to the size of system files in mobile phone. To view the details of storage, please select Settings > Storage.

How to find the IMEI number of my phone?

IMEI number is the only identification of mobile phone. You might offer this number to Vertu customer service. To view IMEI number, please select Settings > System > About phone > All parameters to see your IMEI number.

Why is my mobile phone hot?

If the phone has been used for a long time or exposed under extreme hot conditions, the phone is probably hot. The hot condition of mobile phone depends on circumstances. If the phone is very hot (such as burning), you can power off the phone; If the phone is normal hot, you can lower the standby temperature of phone by turning off high power consumption app and turning off the screen.

Accessories

Data cable

Type-C data cable enables you to transfer data between SIGNATURE S+ mobile phone and compatible computer.

1. Connect the USB data cable to Type-C port for SIGNATURE S+ mobile phone, ensure the data cable is inserted properly.



2. Connect the data cable to USB port on computer, then the mobile phone begins to charge. You can select USB connect modes:

File transfer (MTP) – transfer the media files (MTP) and any other files between mobile phone and computer.

Transfer photo (PTP) – transfer the photos between mobile phone and computer.

Battery charger

Always check if the AC voltage is matched with charger before connecting the power.

Other charging selections

You can also charge the battery by the following methods:

- | PC with USB port.

- | It shall be avoided to expose in a strong-light and high-temperature humid environment, in order to avoid contact with objects and materials which may pollute or scratch the surface.
- | Vertu suggests keeping your mobile phone in the mobile phone bag when not in use.

Leather

All leathers used by Vertu craftsmen are unique, and the natural stripe on the leather is deemed to be one of individual characteristics of high-quality leather. All leather sheaths are liable to damage, so they should be properly maintained.

The following circumstances shall be avoided:

- | Exposure to water and humid environment.
- | Contact, friction or strike with the surface of a hard object.
- | Exposure to extreme temperature environment.
- | Exposure to oils, cosmetics, and solvents.

Non-precious Metal

Vertu's metal part is manufactured as per high standards, and must be properly maintained to protect its appearance.

The following circumstances shall be avoided:

- | Exposure to oils, cosmetics, and solvents.Exposure to chemicals, such as solvents, alkaline and acid solutions, carbonate beverages and saline water. In case of accidental contact, wipe in time with clean soft cloth.
- | Exposure to oils, cosmetics, and solvents.Contact with sharp objects.
- | Exposure to oils, cosmetics, and solvents.Falling or hitting against the surface of a hard object.
- | Exposure to oils, cosmetics, and solvents.Metal polishing.

Precious Metal

The synthetic material of precious metals, such as gold and platinum, has a lower hardness, therefore, you must be extremely careful when treating Vertu products containing such materials.

Gemstone

Gemstones are very solid and durable, but they can be damaged if not handled properly. For example, a severe impact on a hard surface can break a gemstone or damage the bezel of the gemstone, resulting in the gemstone becoming bare or disjointed.

Be careful when in contact with other jewelry, such as diamond rings and diamond earrings, as they can cause breakage or damage to the diamond or bezel. Please be careful and not allow silk threads (especially rayon threads) to trap the bezel, as the threads may bend the bezel and loosen the diamond.

It is recommended to store the Vertu mobile phone in a leather case when not using it, especially putting it in the handbags and other luggages.

If the diamond seems to be dimmed by use, please use a Vertu microfiber polishing cloth to gently wipe the product.

Sapphire and ceramics

Sapphires and ceramics are very solid materials, but they are also fragile or easily scratched by other hard materials or objects. They may also be damaged if fallen.

The following circumstances shall be avoided:

- | Contact with hard materials, such as diamond jewelry, nail file, abrasives and mineral crystals.
- | Falling or hitting against the surface of a hard object.
- | Rub against a hard surface repeatedly.

Security and Assurance

Security Text

The sales package may include multiple kinds of different products and parts (hereinafter jointly referred to as "product"), for example, mobile phone with various chargers. The following suggested guiding principles can apply to all products and parts. In cases that the mobile phone is not allowed or interference or danger may be caused, turn off the mobile phone in places which are near to the medical device, fuel, chemicals or explosion areas.

Use of Flight Mode in a Travel

Unless otherwise expressly stated to turn off your mobile phone, you may select the flight (offline) mode, i.e., you cannot make or answer a call, or use other functions covered by cellular networks, Wi-Fi or Bluetooth. However, you can still make an emergency call.

After-sales Service

Only the service personnel authorized by Vertu can install or repair the product.

Battery, Charger and Other Accessories

After two to three complete charging and discharging cycles, the new battery can reach the maximum efficiency. The battery in any device can be charged and discharged for hundreds of times, but it will be drained up at last. If you think the performance of the device has degraded (for example, the call and stand-by durations of mobile phone are obviously lower than the normal level), please replace it with the original battery authenticated by Vertu (if the battery can be removed) or deliver the associated device to the nearest service company authorized by Vertu (if the battery cannot be removed).

The battery must be used according to its predetermined purpose. Never use any damaged charger or battery. Only use Vertu authenticated battery, and only use Vertu authenticated charger designated for the device for charging.

If the unauthenticated battery or charger is used, fire, explosion, leakage or other dangers may be caused. Please do not connect other incompatible devices to the charger.

In case of not using charger, please pull it out of the power plug or other devices. Please do not connect the fully charged battery to the charger, because overcharging may shorten the battery life and result in other safety problems.

Do not change, transform the battery, do not try to insert foreign objects into the battery, and do not immerse or expose it into water or other liquids. Improper use of battery may result in fire, explosion or other dangers. SIGNATURE S+ is designed to work with Nano-SIM card. The mobile phone does not support other types of SIM cards. Use of incompatible SIM card may damage your mobile phone or SIM card jack.

IMEI Number and Compliance Number

If you want to look up IMEI number, please dial the serial number *#06# with mobile phone. Later display 15-digit IMEI code corresponding to the mobile phone at once. Record this code and properly keep it, so as to find out this code when the mobile phone is lost or stolen. You can also find the IMEI number on the compliance label (see reference manual of the mobile phone for position of the label).

Protect Your Mobile Phone from Harmful Content

Your mobile phone may be exposed to virus or other harmful contents. Please take the following precautions:

- | Be careful when opening a message. It may contain malicious software or other contents that are harmful to your mobile phone or computer.
