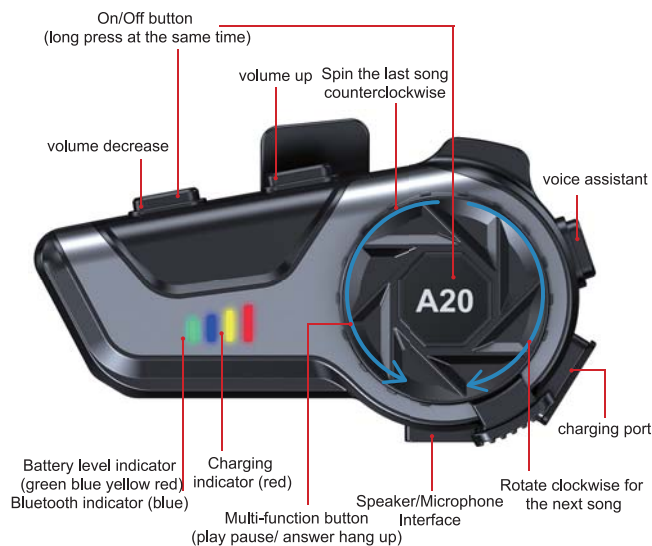

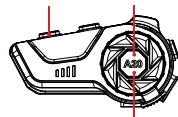

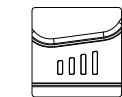
Important Reminder:
Before installing the headset, please connect your cell phone according to the quick manual guide to test the sound effect and volume.
If there is a big difference in sound effect and volume after installing into the helmet, please adjust the position of the speaker inside the helmet.

Power on/off

Simultaneously long press the multi-function key + volume up key for 3 seconds to turn on/off the phone



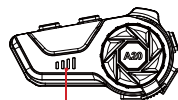
When powering on, the LED light will show the current battery level for 3 seconds. After that, it will resume the indication function status



Blue LED flash

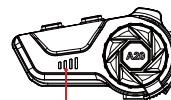
Double-tap to switch between English and Spanish voices (Disconnect wireless connection)

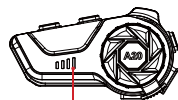
Bluetooth waiting for pairing status: Blue LED blinking fast

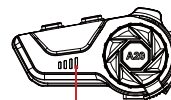

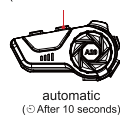

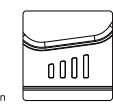
Encender/apagar

Pulsación larga simultánea de la tecla multifunción + la tecla para bajar el volumen durante 3 segundos para encender o apagar el teléfono.



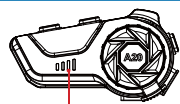
Doble clic para cambiar entre inglés/español (Desconectar Bluetooth)

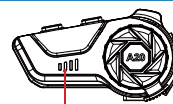

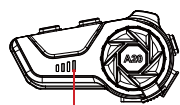

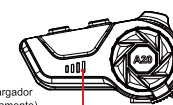
