



Icon and function description



1. Power ON/OFF
2. AUX Port(Plug in the AUX cable then it will enter the AUX mode automatically)
3. TF Card
4. USB charging (Plug the USB charging cable into the DC5V USB charging port)
5. USB Disk
6. "Pause"/"Play" or Bluetooth call
7. Short press to reduce the volume. Press long to return to the previous song.
8. Short press to increase the volume. Press the next song long.
9. Press "M" to switch lighting mode. Long-press to switch between AUX mode and Bluetooth mode

How to Use the Bluetooth Mode

- A. Turn on the power, the speaker will enter the bluetooth mode automatically. while not connected to An AUX port
- B. Open the bluetooth device, then search and find the bluetooth name "Kraylay".
Pairing code is "0000" if it If Needed .
- C. After pairing successfully, your Bluetooth device will connect automatically the next time you use the device.

Common problems and solutions:

1. The speaker may turn off automatically because of the low battery power. If you use it for a long time. Plug the device in with a compatible USB charging cord to continue charging or to continue playing.
2. The music will freeze if the speaker is beyond the effective bluetooth connection distance or there is an obstacle between the speaker and the Bluetooth device.
3. Unsuccessful pairing:
 - a. Check the speaker is turned on.
 - b. Make sure the speaker is within the bluetooth connection distance.
- C. There are too many Bluetooth devices surrounding, which makes the bluetooth searching difficult. Turn off other Bluetooth devices.

Attention:

1. Please place and use this product in normal temperature environment.
2. Do not expose this product to rain or humidity. 3. Avoid damaging the speaker by falling.
4. Do not disassemble, repair or modify this product by yourself.
5. The product has a built-in lithium battery. Do not throw it away. Don't place it in fire to avoid danger!
