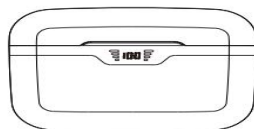


Introduction

This product is a smart wireless microphone that provides professional-grade recording output. Plug and play, no app required. Multiple uses: It can be used in online live broadcast, video Vlog shooting, program interview, recording, video teaching and other occasions.

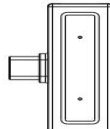
This product consists of three parts: charging box, microphone transmitter and receiver
(as shown in the figure below, some models have no charging box, Based on the actual object)

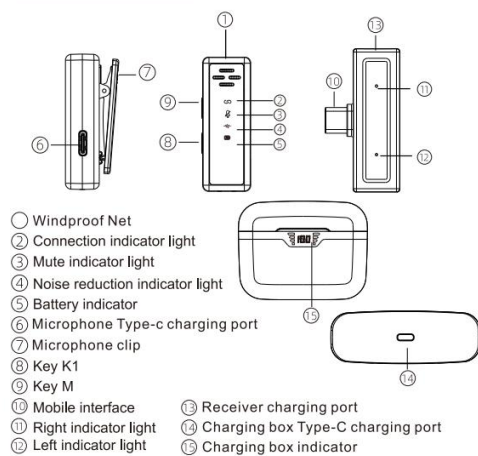
--Connect the equipment into an outlet on a circuit different from that to which the receiver is connected.

NOTE: This device and its antenna(s) must not be co-located or operation in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter

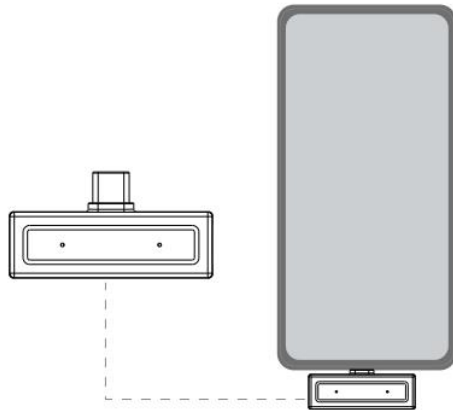
The device has been evaluated to meet general RF exposure requirement. The device can be used in portable exposure condition without restriction.

ID Diagram



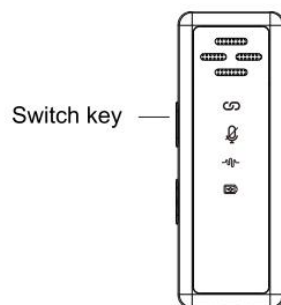
How to use

Step 1: Connect the receiver to phone with port.

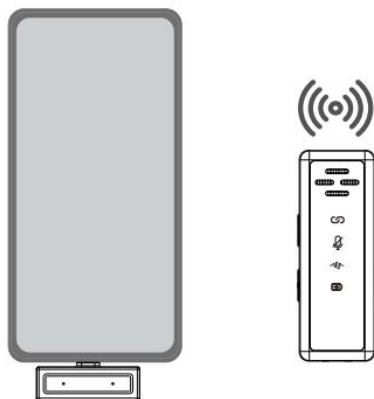


Note: oppo / vivo / iqoo / realm brand mobile phones can be used normally only when they go to the settings (search "OTG" - turn on OTG power supply)

Step 2: Long press button K1 for 3 seconds, or remove it from the box. The connection indicator light will slowly flash , indicating successful startup.

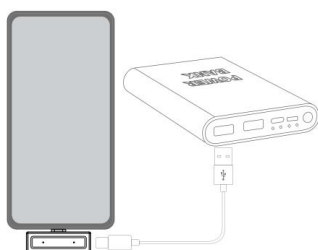


Step 3: The indicator lights of the receiver and transmitter are always on, and the mobile phone turns on the camera for live broadcast Video and other APP can use microphone to pick up sound.



Special Note:

For the use of port: there is no battery in receiver, and no need to recharge during live. If the phone is low power during Live, it can be recharged directly through port.

Function	Button	LED
Power on	Long press the 3S button K1	Connection indicator light flashing slowly
Power off	Long press the 3S button K1	All the lights went out
Unconnected		Connection indicator light flashing slowly
Connected	Automatic pairing pairing name: N9125	The connection indicator light remains on
Noise reduction/ acoustic switching	Click button M to turn off/on noise reduction	Off: Noise reduction indicator light off On: Noise reduction indicator light on
Reverberation	Double click button M to turn reverb on/off	Off: The noise reduction indicator light flashes slowly once On: The noise reduction indicator light slowly flashes three times
Silent mode	Double click button K1 to pause/resume recording	Off: Mute indicator light off On: Mute indicator light on
Power display		40% -100% battery: The battery indicator light is green and always on 20% -40% battery level: The battery indicator light is yellow and constantly on 10% -20% battery level: The battery indicator light is red and always on Below 10%: The battery indicator light flashes red once every 10 seconds
Charging		Charging: 10% -20% battery indicator light, red light always on Charging: 20% -99% battery indicator light, yellow light always on Charging: 100% battery indicator light, all lights off

Note: Remove from the charging compartment and automatically start the machine. Automatically shut down if there is no connection for more than three minutes.

By default, the noise reduction and reverb functions are turned on when turned on.

Function	Operate	LED
Power on	Plug in the device and start it	Both the left and right lights flash simultaneously
Connect a transmitter		Left light remains on, right light 2 flashes
Connect two transmitters		Both the left and right lights are constantly on at the same time
