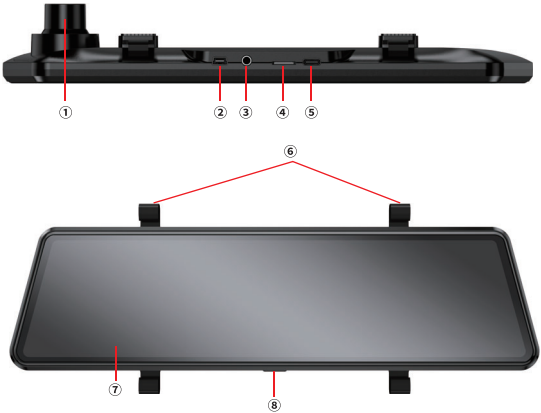

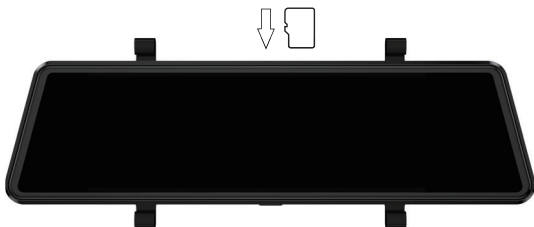

# ABOUT MEMORY CARD

## 1. Installation

Make sure the product is turned off or disconnected from the power supply, prevent incorrect insertion. If there is obstruction when inserting the card, please switch the direction of the Memory card.



## 2. Remove

To remove the Memory card, gently push its edges inward until a clicking sound is heard, then eject and pull it out of the slot.

### NOTE

- The Memory card cannot be removed or inserted when the product is turned on, which can easily cause product malfunctions.
- Regularly format Memory card once a month to extend its lifespan.
- Formatting the Memory card will delete all data inside the card. Please **save important video files in advance.**



# INSTALLATION

## ■ Mount the Main Body

Step 1: Attach the upper end of the straps to the retaining hooks on the top of the rear-view mirror.



Step 2: Pull out the front lens of the JOMISE C810 to match the rearview mirror of the vehicle.



Step 3: Extend the straps around the back of the rear-view mirror and attach them to the bottom retaining hooks.



# INSTALLATION

## ■ Selection of mounting brackets

### Interior mounting

Please use the interior bracket on the picture



Mounted on the rear glass. Attach to the camera's mounting bracket with double-sided tape.

### Outside mounting

Please use the outside bracket on the picture



Install it above the license plate or in the upper middle of the rear glass

# INSTALLATION

## ■ How to install the rear camera

We recommend installing the rear camera above the license plate.

1. Fix the rear camera with adhesive  
Find the best location, tear off the adhesive on the rear camera, and fix the rear camera near by the car license plate lamp (If you need to adjust the angle, please attach the rear camera bracket to the rear camera first and tighten it with screws).



### 2. Remove the Panel

Remove your trunk's interior panel to expose the car's rear wiring chambers. Pop open your trunk and look for a solid interior panel covering the opposite side of your license plate mounting area. Then, insert a trim removal tool or other slender tools behind the panel and pry it off.



### 3. Snake the cable

Use a trim removal tool to pop out the tailgate trim, then run the cable from the outside of the car into the trunk of your car.



\* The red wire on the rear camera cable does not need to be connected (It is designed for another model of our products).

# INSTALLATION

4. Connect the rear camera's power cable to the extension cable

After snaking your rear camera extension cable, connect the power cable to your rear camera's extension cord.



5. Route your rear camera's extension cable to the front of the car

If you'd like, use a trim removal to pop out the headlining panel directly above your windshield. Then run your cable through the exposed chamber.



6. Power on the C810 with box included car charger, don't charge it with your own chargers.

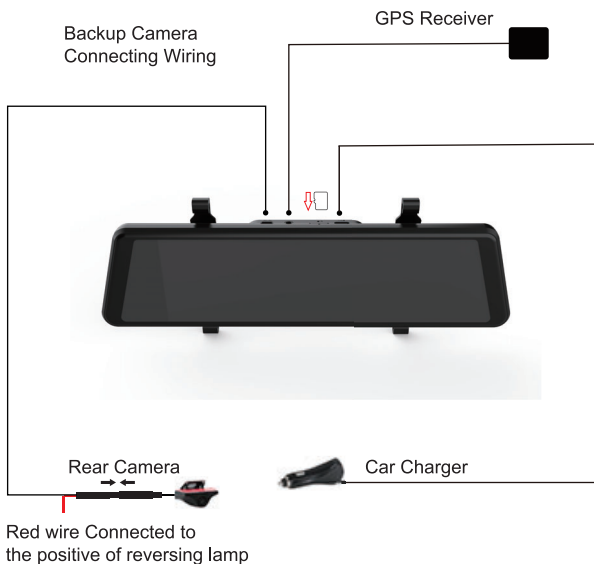


## NOTE

- Make sure to remove the Plastic Lens Screen Protector from the lens before recording videos. Otherwise, your videos will look blurry and blocked.
- Do not remove the Memory Card while the C810 is TURNED ON. Otherwise, it may cause the Memory Card to be write-protected and possibly lose data or damage your Memory Card.
- Always remove/insert the Memory Card while the product is POWERED OFF.
- Do not use a socket distributor.
- Do not connect or disconnect the rear camera cable while the power is ON. It will be the cause of the product failure.
- The rear camera has a 180° Flip Function, you can flip the rear camera according to your needs.

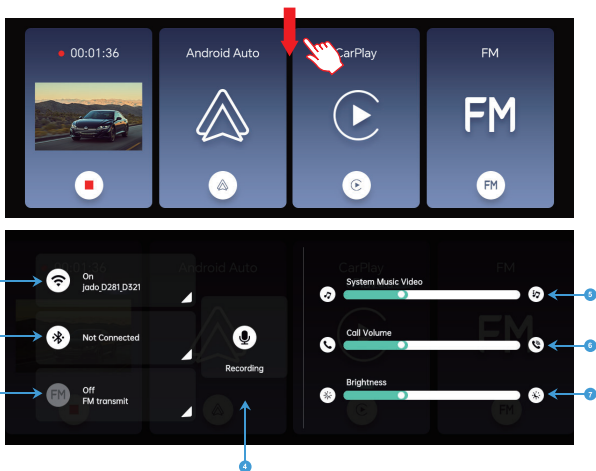

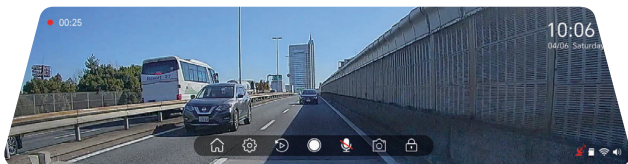

## 5. Lock Video Function Description:

The number of videos that can be locked depends on the capacity of the Memory Card.

The Memory Card supports a minimum of 32GB and a maximum of 256GB.

General video files will automatically be overwritten in a circular manner, favoring the oldest files first. Locked videos cannot be overwritten automatically. It is advisable to periodically format the memory card to ensure the device operates smoothly.




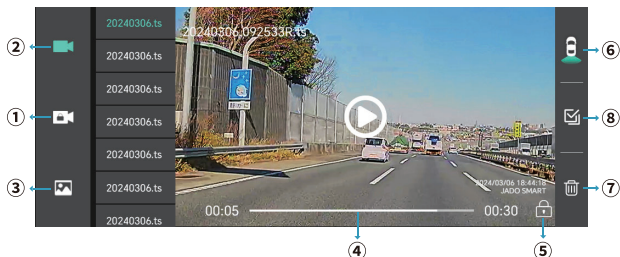
▲ While recording, swiping the screen up and down adjusts the angle of view.

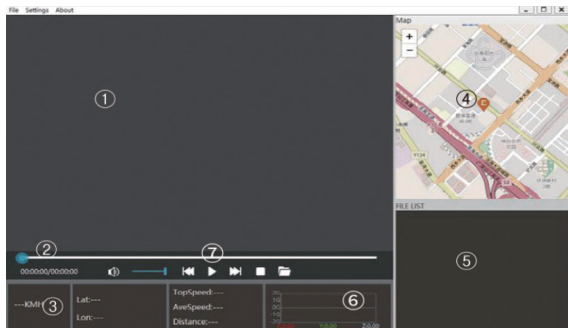

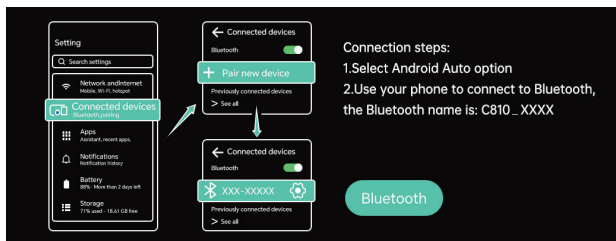

C810 supports Android Auto, please follow the instructions on the host screen to connect your Android phone. After the first successful connection of Android Auto, the host will automatically connect to the phone every time it starts, no need to set it up again.



1. Click on the [  ] icon on the Homepage to enter the Android Auto option and confirm your selection.
2. Keep your Android phone' Wi-Fi on.
3. Turn on the Connection steps: of your Android phone and connect based on the device name(when searching for the first time, it will be displayed in "Other Devices").
4. The Android phone pops up the pairing information, click "Pair". In the pop-up pairing interface, you can allow your phone to access your contacts and call history according to your needs. 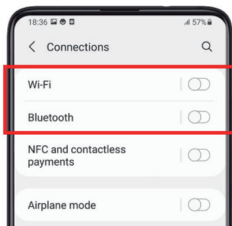

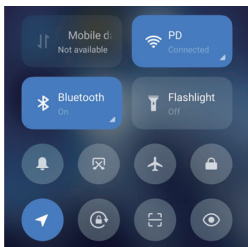
## NOTE

- Android Auto only supports Android phones.
- Wireless Android Auto screen projection requires smartphone version Android 11 and above, and the smartphone supports 5G Wi-Fi.
- Wired Android Auto screen projection requires smartphone version Android 6.0 and above.
- When the host is powered on, it will try to connect to the last connected Android phone device automatically. If you use a new Android phone to connect to the host, you need to turn off the Wi-Fi and BT of the relevant Android phone that was last connected to the host, or the new Android phone will not be connected successfully. If you need to disconnect Android Auto, please turn off both Wi-Fi and
- BT on your Android phone to disconnect. Turning off Wi-Fi only or BT only, the Android phone will keep trying to reconnect to the host.

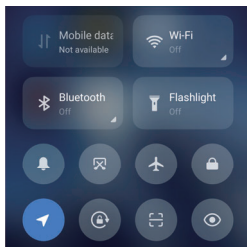

# FAQ

## 1. For a Frozen or Unresponsive Device?

- ① Attempt a reboot to see if the device can be restarted.
- ② If a reboot doesn't work, perform a system reset.
- ③ If the issue persists, contact the manufacturer's customer support or after-sales service for assistance.

## 2. The rear camera has no image?

- ① Please use the rear camera provided by the manufacturer.
- ② Whether the AvIN interface is inserted to the bottom.
- ③ Check if the camera format matches.

## 3. FM does not receive the radio station?

Search channel, on the FM menu page, perform a channel scan search.

## 4. Apple CarPlay cannot connect?

- ① The first connection takes a long time, expect 1-3 minutes.
- ② Only iPhones can use CarPlay function.
- ③ The iPhone is required to be iPhone 5 and above, and IOS system version is required to be IOS13 and above.
- ④ Check whether the Wi-Fi and Bluetooth functions of the iPhone are normal and open.
- ⑤ Enter the Settings-General-CarPlay interface of the iPhone, delete all the records in this interface and reconnect.
- ⑥ Restart the iPhone and device and reconnect.

# FAQ

## 5. Android Auto cannot connect?

- ① The first connection takes a long time, expect 1-3 minutes.
- ② Only Android phones can use Android Auto function.
- ③ Update Auto and relevant Apps on your Android phone to the latest version.
- ④ Do not enable VPN on your Android phone.
- ⑤ Check whether the Wi-Fi and Bluetooth functions of the Android phone are normal and turned on.
- ⑥ Restart the Android phone and device and reconnect

## 6. Unable to start?

(Player supports 7V-32V car use, high voltage cannot be used)

- ① Check whether the DC head of the cigarette lighter power cord is damaged or aging
- ② Check whether the fuse of the power plug is disconnected or burned

## 7. The Bluetooth music cannot use?

Please set the player mode to Bluetooth music. Other modes do not support Bluetooth music.
