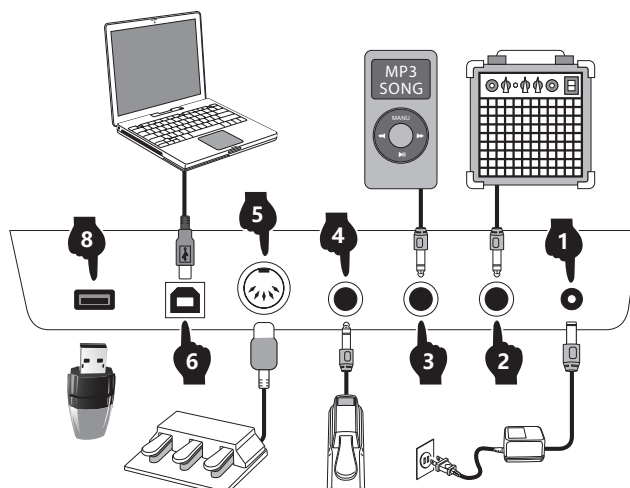
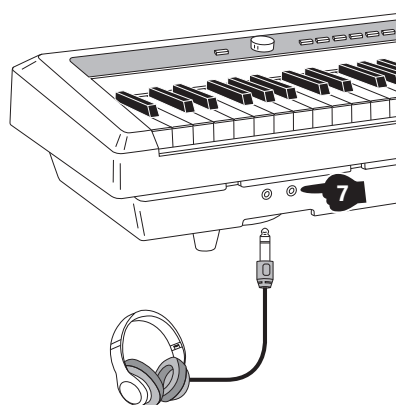
- This product is an electro-acoustic instrument product. It is normal that there is a little current sound in the speaker or earphone after power-on.

## TERMINAL DIAGRAM



### 1 POWER TERMINAL CONNECTION

Connect the power cord as shown in the figure, one end is inserted into the DC socket, and the other end is inserted into the 100-240V household power socket. (Fig. 1)

### 2 AUDIO OUTPUT SOCKET

The audio output port can be connected with external active speaker and power amplifier equipment. (Fig. 2)

### 3 AUDIO INPUT SOCKET

The audio input port can be connected to external audio source (such as MP3, mobile phone and other linear audio signal input) for play. (Fig. 3)

### 4 SUSTAIN PEDAL SOCKET

Connect the sustain pedal, and hold the pedal to control the effect of sound extension. (Fig. 4)

### 5 THREE PEDAL SOCKET

Connect the three pedals, and the sound control sequence of pressing the three pedals is: weak tone / delayed tone / sustained tone. (Fig. 5)

### 6 USB MIDI SOCKET

Using the USB MIDI port, you can interact with the music device with midi. Through the pre installed Music software on the computer, tablet and mobile phone, you can learn or play the keyboard, perform, compose, store and other functions. (Fig. 6)

### 7 DUAL HEADPHONE SOCKET

Connect the earphone to monitor the sound details, and automatically cut off the built-in speaker, so that no one will be disturbed when playing the piano. (Fig. 7)

### 8 MP3 PLAY FUNCTION

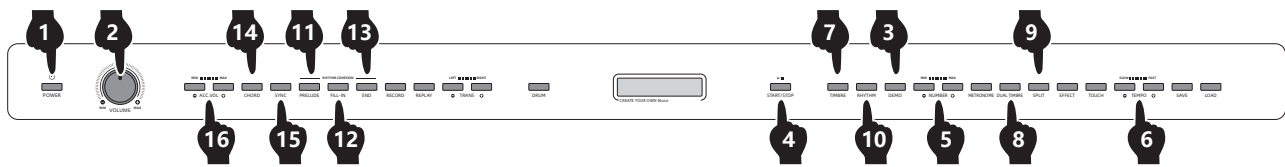
Insert the USB flash disk and directly enter the playback state. Rotate the volume knob to adjust the volume.

## REMARK!

- to prevent failure and damage to the device, please make sure that all devices are turned off and turn down the volume before inserting any port.
- Speakers, earphones and external audio equipment are accessories purchased separately, not standard!



## OPERATION GUIDE



### 1 POWER ON/OFF

Press the "POWER" button, the indicator lights up, start the working mode, and press again to close. (Fig. 1)

- Processor chips of this product are complex, similar to computer systems. Sometimes they can not respond. Please turn off the power switch and then turn it on to work properly.

### 2 MAIN VOLUME

Turn the "VOLUME" knob to adjust the main volume to a satisfactory position. (Fig. 2)

### 3 DEMO PLAYING

1. Press the "DEMO" button to enter the music playing mode. (Fig. 3)
  2. Press the "START / STOP" button to start or stop the music playing. (Fig. 4)
  3. Press the "NUMBER + -" button to select the music to be played, and the screen will display the code and name of the selected music. (Fig. 5)
  4. Press "TEMPO + -" button to change the playing speed of music. (Fig. 6)
- There are 100 songs in total. Please refer to the attached demo table for the name of the songs.

### 4 TIMBRE

#### SELECT TIMBRE:

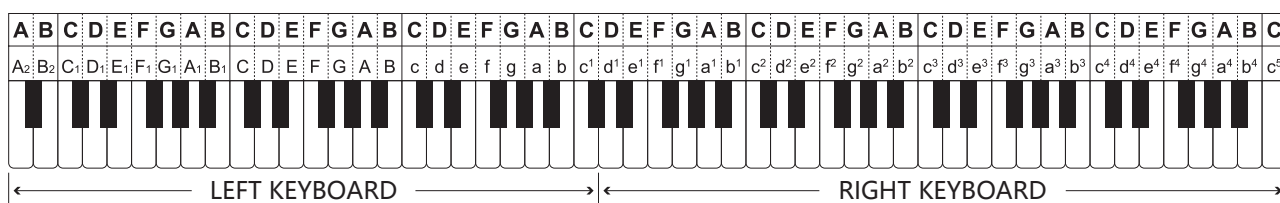
1. Press the "TIMBRE" button to enter the timbre selection mode. (Fig. 7)
  2. Press the "NUMBER + -" button to select the timbre of the instrument, and the selected timbre code and name will be displayed on the screen. (Fig. 5)
- there are 239 timbres in total. Please refer to the appendix tone table for the timbre name of the musical instrument.

#### SET DUAL TIMBRE:

1. In tone mode, first select a tone as the main tone .
2. Press the "DUAL TIMBRE" button to start the dual tone mixing mode. (Fig. 8)
3. Press the "NUMBER + -" button to select another tone as the superimposed timbre. (Fig. 5)
4. Playing on the "KEYBOARD" can produce a mixed sound of two musical tone.
5. Press the "DUAL TIMBRE" button again to exit the function.

#### SET KEYBOARD SPLIT:

1. In tone mode, first select one as the right keyboard instrument timbre.
2. Press the "SPLIT" button to enter the left and right keyboard instrument timbre segmentation mode. (Fig. 9)
3. Press the "NUMBER + -" button to select another tone as the timbre of the instrument on the left keyboard. (Fig. 5)
4. Play on the "KEYBOARD". At this time, the left and right sides of the keyboard emit different instrument sounds.
5. Press the "SPLIT" button again to exit the function.



## 5 ACCOMPANIMENT

**SELECT RHYTHM:**

1. Press the "RHYTHM" button to enter the rhythm selection mode. (Fig. 10)
  2. Press the "NUMBER + -" button to select the rhythm style, and the selected rhythm code and name will be displayed on the screen. (Fig. 5)
  3. Press the "START / STOP" button to start playing the selected rhythm. Press again to stop playing. (Fig. 4)
- there are 200 rhythms in total. Please refer to the rhythm table in the appendix for the rhythm name.

## PRELUDE:

First select the rhythm to be played, then press the "prelude" button to start playing the prelude of the selected rhythm, and then play the selected rhythm. (Figure 11)

**INSERT INTERLUDE:**

In the process of rhythm playing, press the "FILL-IN" button to insert a transitional interlude for the rhythm being played. (Fig. 12)

## CODA:

During rhythm playback, press the "END" button to insert an coda for the rhythm being played. After the coda is finished, the rhythm playback will stop. (Fig. 13)

### CHORDS:

Press the "CHORD" button, the left keyboard will switch to the chord keyboard area (1-34 keys from the left). Press the start/stop button. play the left keyboard, and automatically recognize and play the chord according to the single finger or multi finger method. Press again to exit this function. (Fig. 14)

### SYNCHRONOUS START:

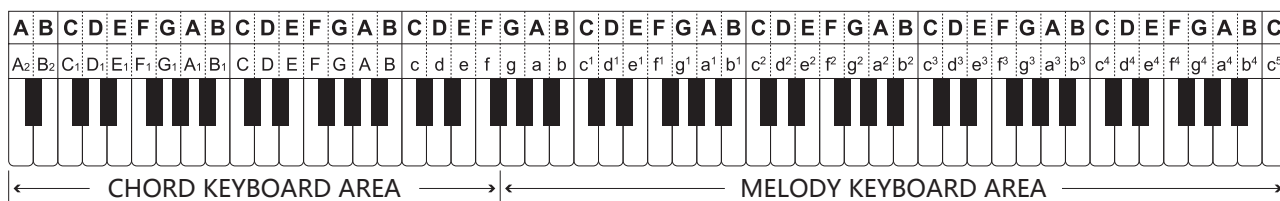
1. First select the rhythm to be played, and then press the "SYNC" button to enter the rhythm synchronization playing state. (Fig. 15)
2. Press the piano key in the "CHORD KEYBOARD AREA" to trigger the rhythm to play synchronously.
  - if "CHORD" is on, the chord and the selected rhythm will be played synchronously.

### RHYTHM PLAYBACK SPEED:

Press the "TEPMO + -" button to change the rhythm playing speed. (Fig. 6)

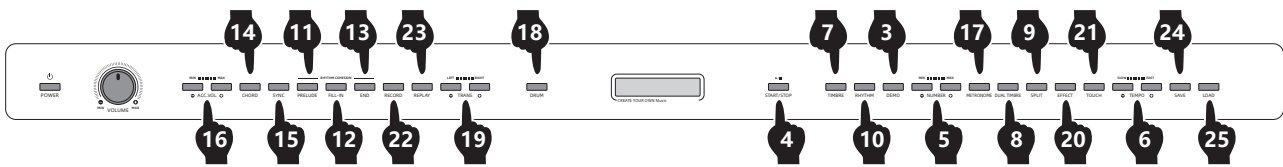
**ACCOMPANIMENT VOLUME:**

Press the "ACC.VOL + -" button to adjust the relevant accompaniment volume. (Fig. 16)





## OPERATION GUIDE



### 6 METRONOME

1. Press the "metronome" button, the metronome function starts, and you can play the piano with the beat sound. (Fig. 17)
2. There are 4 types of metro, which can be switched by pressing the "Metro" button repeatedly.
  - switching sequence: 1 / 4, 2 / 4, 3 / 4, 4 / 4, close, and cycle accordingly.
3. Press the "tempo + -" button to change the beat speed. (Fig. 6)

### 7 KEYBOARD DRUM

Press the "DRUM" button to switch the scale keyboard to the percussion keyboard, and then press it again to turn off the function. (Fig. 18)

### 8 TRANSPOSITION

Press the "TRANS + -" button to adjust the keyboard pitch. This function allows you to adjust the range of the whole keyboard in half a scale without changing the keyboard position. (Fig. 19)

- adjustment range: 12 semitones.

### 9 SOUND EFFECT

Press the "EFFECT" button to turn on reverberation. At this time, the sound of playing the piano has the sound wave reflection effect in the building. Press again to turn off this function. (Fig. 20)

### 10 KEYBOARD TOUCH

There are three kinds of strength: normal \ hard \ soft Press the "force" button. This function can be selected or turned off (Fig. 21)

### 11 RECORDING

1. Press the "RECORD" button to start the recording mode. At the same time, the metronome starts automatically. Press the metronome button to adjust and close it. (Fig. 22)
2. Play the piano to record, when finish, press the "RECORD" button again to close it.
3. Press the "REPLAY" button to play the recorded music. (Fig. 23)
  - during recording, the timbre of the instrument can be changed for recording.

### 12 SAVE SETTINGS

1. Press the "SAVE" button to save the modified parameter setting, which is convenient for calling user-defined parameters. (Fig. 24)
  - parameters that can be saved: TIMBRE / RHYTHM / DEMO / TEMPO / TRANS / EFFECT.
2. Press the "LOAD" button to load the previously modified parameter settings. (Fig. 25)

### 13 BLUETOOTH AUDIO CONNECTION

Turn on the mobile phone settings, turn on Bluetooth, find the new device "Piano Audio" and connect the Bluetooth audio. After the connection is successful, the Bluetooth light on the smart piano panel lights up, the smart piano becomes a Bluetooth speaker, and the songs or other audio sounds played by the mobile phone will be sent out through the smart piano.

### 14 BLUETOOTH MIDI SOFTWARE CONNECTION

Pre install MIDI music software on computers, tablets, mobile phones and other smart devices with Bluetooth transmission, and then pair and connect with Bluetooth through music software. After successful connection, you can operate functions such as learning or composition according to the functions of their music software.

### **4 DO NOT SHAKE, AVOID COLLISION**

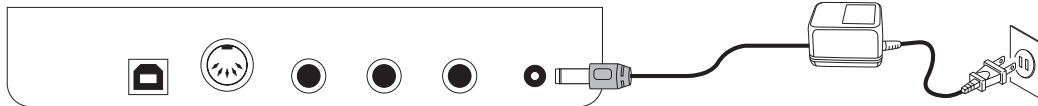
When moving, the product should be handled carefully and lightly. Violent vibration and collision are strictly prohibited in order to avoid damage to the shell or internal electronic components.
