- b) This device will only associate and connect with an indoor Access Point (AP) or indoor Subordinate.
- c) This device will always be under the control of an indoor AP. However, there may exist situations where the client may transmit brief messages, prior to being under the control of an AP, to join an AP network. But these brief messages will only occur if the client has detected a signal confirming that an AP is operating on a particular channel. These brief messages will have a time-out mechanism if the client does not receive a response from an AP.
