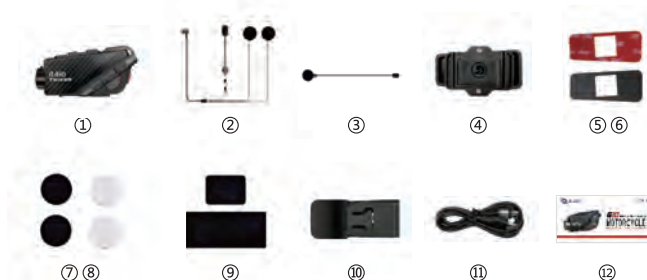

3. Two Ways of Installation

a) Use Double-sided Tape



- 1** Wipe the surface of the helmet where the device will be mounted with the alcohol prep pad.



- 2** Peel off the sticker of double-sided pad and stick it on the rotatable cradle.



- 3** Attach the rotatable cradle with double-sided pad to the helmet.



- 4** Push the device toward the bottom of the helmet and snap it into the rotating cradle, the installation is complete.

b) Use Metal Clip



- 1** Peel off the sticker of single-sided pad and stick it on the rotatable cradle.



- 2** Snap the metal clip into the rotatable cradle.

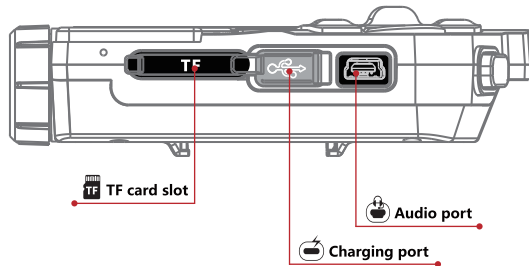
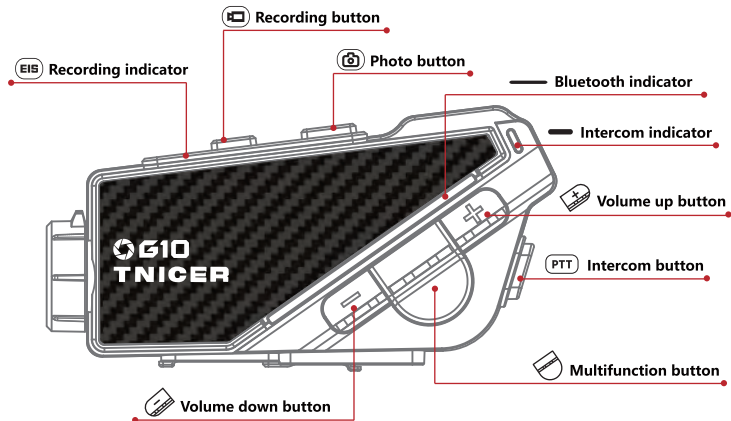


- 3** Snap the rotatable cradle with the metal clip in place into the bottom of the helmet.





- 4** Push the device toward the bottom of the helmet and snap it into the rotating cradle, the installation is complete.

4. Function Keys Introduction



***NOTE:**















" " is the power button for the camera section.
" + (PTT) " is the power button for the Bluetooth intercom section.

The intercom section and the camera section are part of different modules and require different power buttons to turn them on separately.

Tip: The Bluetooth indicator light will flash green slowly while the device is charging, and the green light is always on when fully charged.



2) Bluetooth Pairing with Different Devices

Note: Make sure the G10 is powered on and within 1 meter of the Bluetooth device you are about to pair with.

	Tips: 1. Please follow the pairing method in the instructions for the third party device to make the third party device enter the pairing mode before performing the above operation. 2. When connecting a third-party headset as described above, G10 has the main control. The party that passively accepts the connection has no control: it can not hang up or actively connect to the other party.

4) Music Function

Note: Before using the music function, please make sure that G10 has been successfully connected to the Bluetooth of your cell phone.

5)Intercom Pairing and Using Methods

Pairing between 2 or more G10 devices		Step 1: When all devices are in standby mode long press [multifunction button] of all devices for 4 seconds, now they enter the passive pairing state.	Pairing	The Bluetooth indicator flashing in purple
		Step2: Select one of the devices and short press once its [intercom button], then this device enters the active pairing state.	Searching	Bluetooth indicator light flashing red and blue alternately and slowly
		Step3: Pairing succeeds. The all devices can start talking now.	Device connected	Intercom indicator light flashing slowly in blue
Disconnect /Resume the intercom		When the devices in intercom mode, short press the [intercom button] to disconnect the intercom, and press again to go back to the intercom mode.	Intercom connected /disconnected	Intercom indicator flashing in blue

**Note:**

- 1.The G10 can only pair with a maximum of one third-party intercom device.
- 2.If there is an incoming call during intercom call, the device will disconnect the intercom call automatically, and resume the intercom state after hanging up the phone call.
- 3.During the intercom call, when the intercom with other devices is disconnected due to factors such as distance or environment, you can short press the [intercom button] once to return to the intercom state.
- 4.When the device is in the intercom mode, short press the [intercom button] to disconnect the intercom, and press again to go back to intercom mode.Short press [volume up / down] to adjust the intercom volume
5. Intercom quality will be affected by environmental factors, it is recommended that the group intercom within 1000 meters, too long a distance will increase the interference factors to affect the call experience.

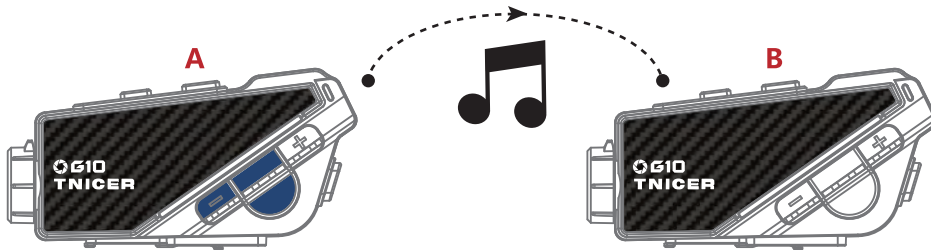
Music Sharing

Turn on music sharing:

When both devices are turned on, music must be shared from the party initiating the intercom to the other party. For example, you can specify that music be shared from Device A to Device B. The procedure is as follows.

1. Ensure that devices A and B retain only each other's pairing information (you can clear all pairing history for both devices)
2. Connect A to your phone's Bluetooth (make sure B is not connected to the same phone as A)
3. Open the Music app on your phone and put the song on pause.
4. Pairing the devices A and B. (Refer to the steps on the previous page to complete the pairing).
5. Short press the [Intercom Button] of A once to pause the intercom.
6. Long press A's **[multifunction button + volume down button]** for 2 seconds, then short press A's [multifunction button] to start music playback.

The music sharing is successful.

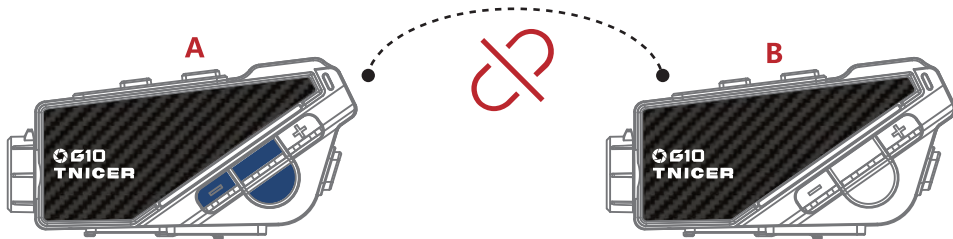


Turn off music sharing:

Long press [multifunction button+ volume down button] on device A for 2 seconds to turn off music sharing.

Note:

1. When device A shares music with B, A must be connected to the Bluetooth of the cell phone.
2. The prerequisite for sharing music between A and B is that A and B are successfully paired.
3. Under the music sharing status, the device A can pause/start sharing by short press [multifunction button].

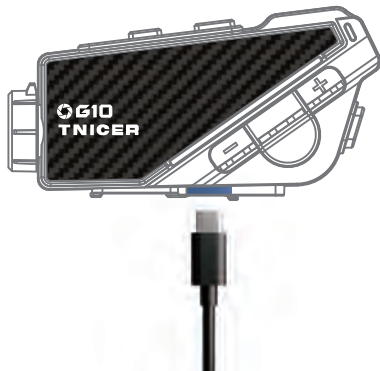


Note:

- 1.The videos and pictures opened on SD card in APP are preview files with blurred images, you need to download them to view HD files. Downloaded videos and pictures can be viewed and deleted by clicking on "Local".
- 2.Connect one end of the cable to the USB port of the device, and the other end to the computer (you can also pull out the memory card and connect it to the computer with a card reader), find the USB flash drive in my computer, and then open the video or photo inside to play the high-definition file (Note: the device can only be read when the device is turned on).

Product Charging Precautions:

- 1.Please fully charge the device before using it.
- 2.Please use the charging head with 5V2A power or less with the charging cable.
- 3.Don't put the product in too high or too low temperature environment, the best use environment is 0 to 40 degrees, otherwise it will shorten the product life.
- 4.Keep away from fire source.
- 5.Keep away from sharp objects, otherwise the product may be scratched or damaged.
- 6.Do not disassemble the device.
- 7.When not in use for a long time, please place the device in a dry environment and make sure to charge it once a month to ensure its performance.
