



- The account can only be distributed by dxT.





Note:


- You must choose at least one brand.




ADMIN- COLOR ADJUSTMENT



- Click “→” button .



- Click the “Privacy agreement” button.




- click “↑” to open the hidden panel.

ADMIN- COLOR ADJUSTMENT



- 1) Choose the brand first.
- 2) Choose the shade which you want to edit.

- Change the six parameters to change the effect of hair dying.

- Save the final value.

Note:

- S(strength)- Most shades are set to 100.
- L(highlight)- Depending on the shade.
- M(midtone)- Depending on the shade

ADMIN- COLOR RESET



- When you click “Reset button ” the value will be back to the original.



- Please click “Back ”button to go back home after adjustment.



- Log out your admin account.

- Do not forget to log out your admin account to avoid others to use it.


BUSINESS- LOG IN

- Brand configuration.




- Choose the brand which you will show in the event.

- Click "→" to start the journey.


- Agree the privacy agreement.

END USER- TAKE PHOTO




- Click “Effect” to add stickers and border to your photo.
