

## Music Boxing Target Instruction Manual





### Charging Instructions

Use a mobile phone charger (5v1A-2A) to charge through the provided power cord connection, and when charging, it will light up in red, the light turns green when fully charged. When installing a music player, consideration should be given to a location close to the socket.

### Operating Instructions:




On/off : Long press to turn on/off, tap to adjust the volume, there are three levels: high, medium, and low.

Bluetooth : Turn on your phone, turn on Bluetooth, and connect to Bluetooth by searching for Bluetooth devices. The Bluetooth name is QJP.

Speed : H01-H15, 15 speed ranges. The default mode for startup is H09.

Mode : Mode adjustment button, P01-P15, 15 automatic programs. Each mode corresponds to a training area division, and the difficulty gradually increases.

### Installation Instructions:



1. Peel off the Velcro surface of the accessory and stick the sticker directly onto the back of the machine. When pasting, pay attention to the parallel direction of the machine. (As shown in Figure 1)
2. The other Velcro sticker with the fur surface is directly attached to the back of the machine, making sure that the two Velcro stickers are parallel to each side of the machine (As shown in Figure 2)
3. Glue the Velcro needle surface and hair surface together to locate the corresponding wall position, and ensure that the charging port is not more than 1.2 meters away from the socket (As shown in Figure 3)
4. Determine the position, tear off the sticker behind the needle surface, and stick it to the wall. (As shown in Figure 4)

1	No light or sound	The product is not turned on	Press the bottom switch key
2	No light or sound	Battery loss	Please charge
3	Flashing lights	Low battery level	Please charge
4	Short press of the switch cannot start the machine	Long term failure to power on leads to the drawback of main chip capacity expansion	Please charge
5	Internal collision sound of equipment	Emitted by internal activities and structures	Normal phenomenon
