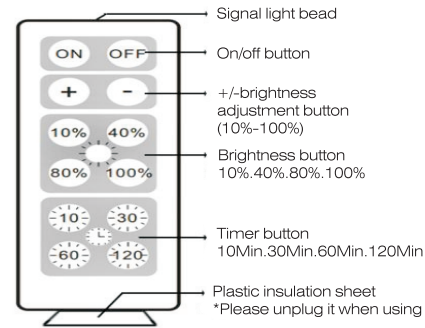
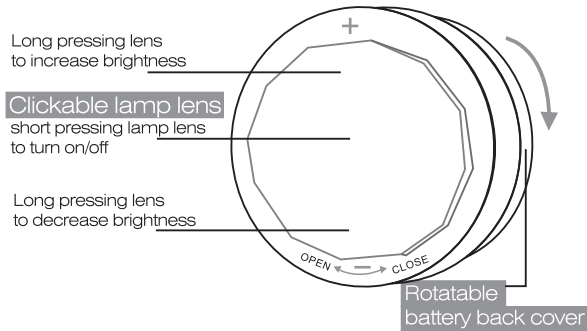


# PUCK LIGHT INSTRUCTION MANUAL



## Product Feature:

- 1 Battery powered under cabinet lights with remote controls
- 2 Two control modes: Tap control or remote control. You can turn lights on/off individually by pressing on the lamp lens or using remote control. When using the remote control, please aim the LED signal light of the remote control at the puck light you need to operate.
- 3 Dimmable function: Press the button on remote(10%, 40%, 80%, 100%), or long press lamp lens to increase/ decrease brightness(10%-100%). You can freely adjust according to your lighting needs.
- 4 Timing function: You can set different timing(10min, 30min, 60min, 120min) with the remote control, in case of forgetting turn off the lights. To save battery power, the lamp will turn off automatically within 30min without any operation.
- 5 Easy to install: Each light is powered by 3\* AAA batteries(Not included). Coming with adhesive tape, You just need to stick lights on the wall with stick tape instead of installing troublesome electrical wires.
- 6 Multi-purpose: Mini portable light can be placed anywhere you want, such as kitchen cabinet, stair, cupboard, locker, wardrobe, showcase, any dark corner or decoration.

## How to install the light/ replace batteries?

- 1 Rotate the battery back cover counterclockwise and install 3\* AAA batteries (not included)



- 2 Paste double-side adhesive tape (included) on the back cover of lights. Tear off the tape backing and stick the lamp where needed



- 3 Rotate light counterclockwise to separate it from back cover, leaving the cover on the wall, replace the battery, and then re-install it



## Package Included:

- 6 x LED Puck Light;
- 2 x Remote Control;
- 6 x Adhesive Tape

## Tips:

- 1 Each light is powered by 3\* AAA batteries. The batteries are not included and need to be purchased separately.
- 2 Before using the remote, please unplug the plastic insulation sheet from the remote.
- 3 In order to save battery power, the light won't be set to stay on. It will automatically turn off in 30min without any operation.
- 4 Please use it on smooth and flat surface. Before installing, please wipe the surface to make sure it is clean, dry, free from dust and oil.
- 5 Since the tape is very sticky, if you need to remove the tape from the wall, please wipe it with alcohol first.
