- 3.1: Instructions for indicator light machine buttons
- A. Reset key: When there is no response when pressing any key, use the reset key to press the key for 3 seconds to reset.
- B. On/Off button: Long press to turn on, long press to turn off.
- C. Bluetooth indicator light: The Bluetooth indicator light remains on when turned on, after pressing FN+F2 to activate Bluetooth and enter pairing mode, the Bluetooth indicator light flashes.



3.2 Energy saving sleep mode

1. When there is no operation on the keyboard for 15 minutes, all LED lights will turn off. If needed, tap any key on the keyboard, and the keyboard will be awakened and automatically connected back to Bluetooth. It will work normally in about 3 seconds.

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3.4 Connection steps

1. Change power on button for about 3 seconds to power on
2. Press FN+F2 (1) to pair and the Bluetooth indicator light will flash.
3. Complete the connection on the Surface tablet, and the Bluetooth indicator light is constantly on at this time.
