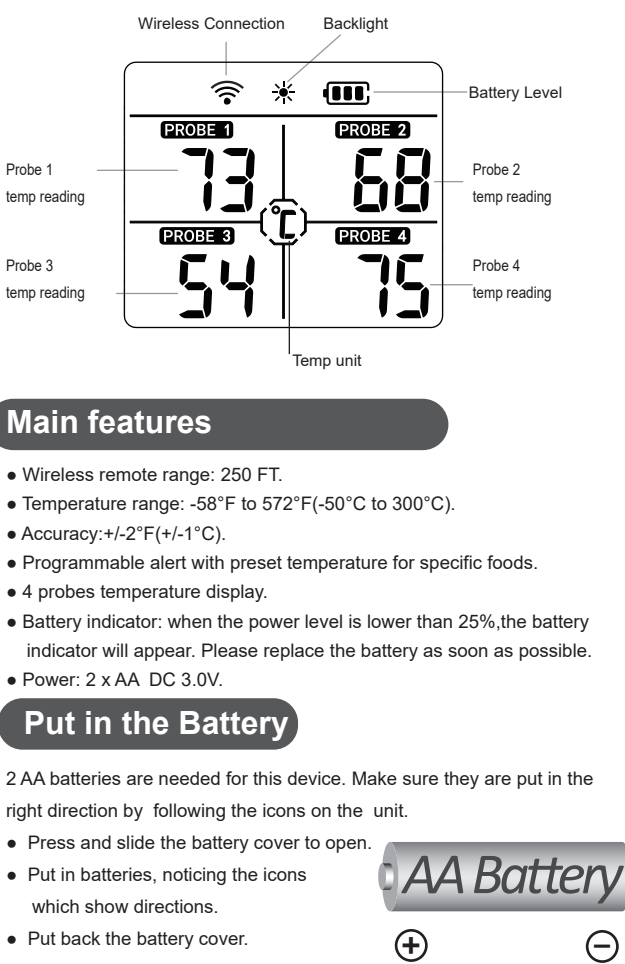
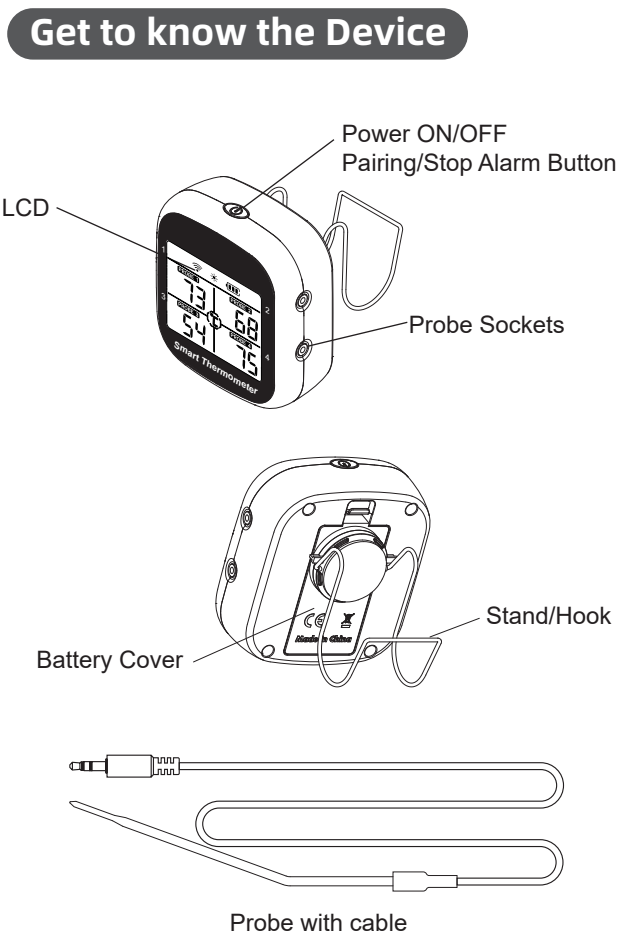

Insert the probes

The device will keep scanning the sockets when its power is switched on. When the sensor is inserted, the LCD will display the temperature value at the corresponding position.

Then insert the probes into the food, make sure the tip of the probe is at the center of the food to get accurate temperature.

Download the APP

Search the keyword "Smart Life" in App Store and various Android app stores.

Or scan the following QR code with your phone.

Download and install the APP for free.

Make sure your phone meets the requirements:

- Apple devices running iOS 10.0 (or watchOS 2.2) and later,
- Compatible device: iPhone iPad iPod touch iWatch.
- Android devices running version 6.0 or later



Power ON/OFF

Press and hold the button for more than 3 seconds when it is in OFF mode. It will be powered on and the LCD display will show "ON" with a beep sound. If you do the same when the device is in ON mode, it will be powered off.

When the probe is not inserted into the device, it will power off automatically.

Pair with your phone

Switch on your device and keep the Bluetooth switch of your phone on.

Launch the app and follow the instructions in the app to pair and activate the device:

- Press the Pairing/Stop Alarm Button (in the top of the device).
- Connected successfully.
- Once paired the device with your phone successfully, you don't need to do the above steps again, unless you change to other phones.

NOTES:

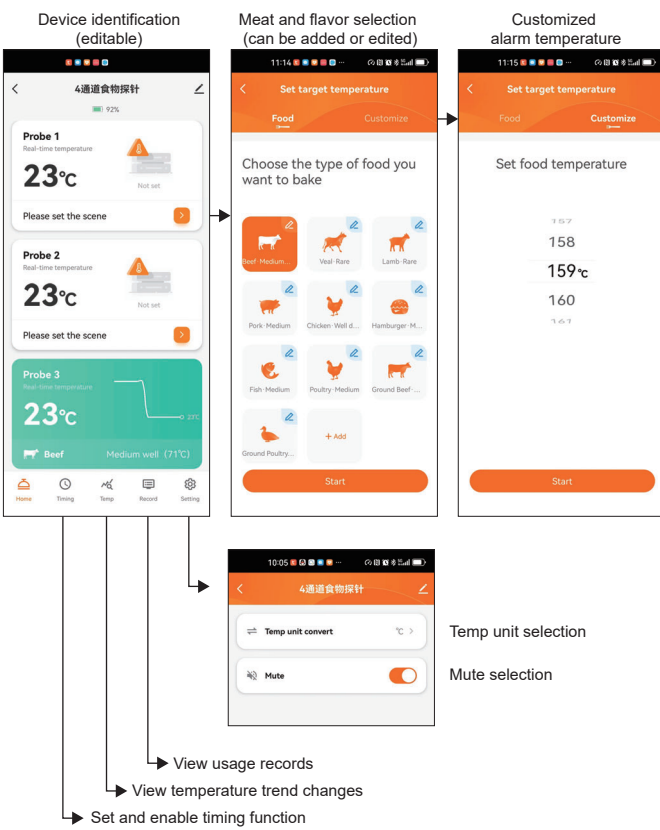
The product automatically configures Bluetooth upon startup and prioritizes connecting to the last memory device. If you want to change devices, it's best to delete them on the app and then pair them again.

Choose food and preference for the food where the probe is inserted the app and the device will display its current and target temperature.

When the food is ready, the app and device will alarm.



The user interface of the app may be changed when upgrade. Please follow the instructions in the app.
