Search name: D1 . Long press three seconds to turn on . Not connected . Double click to switch in English and Chinese, Default English . Short click PlayPause Accept Shut Down . Long click Voice Assistant . Double click Back Call . Three click Next Track . Four click Next Track ? Long click Reject Call . Call Number . Press When the headphones are paired with the device When they are turned on, At this point, turn on the phone and the headset for pairing, the name of the headset is D1, the headset and the phone pairing success after the headset lights off, the headset can be used normally!
